

2010 Feast of Tabernacles Church of God Big Sandy ALASKA CRUISE

The Church of God Big Sandy invites you to an Alaska cruise for the 2010 Feast of Tabernacles.

- The cruise sets sail on the afternoon of the second day of the Feast (Friday, Sept. 24). The first two days will be celebrated with services in the Edgewater Hotel in downtown Seattle. (In April we changed the location of our planned church services to the Edgewater Hotel, which we believe is a better location. If you made your reservation at the previously announced establishment but would prefer to stay at the new hotel, please contact Kathy Summers.)
- The Feast will get started with a Get-Acquainted Reception the evening of Wednesday, Sept. 22. Services at the hotel will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Thursday, Sept. 23, and Friday, Sept. 24.
- We will board the ship (Holland America Cruise Lines' M.S. *Zaandam*) on the 24th, setting sail at 4:00 p.m. The weekly Sabbath will be spent at sea, headed for the first port of call, in Juneau, arriving Sunday morning. Stops will also include Glacier Bay, Sitka and Ketchikan.
- Services aboard the ship will be from 8:00 until 9:00 a.m. daily, except Wednesday, Sept. 29, when services are not planned. The Last Great Day will be on board the ship, with an arrival in the beautiful city of Victoria, B.C., Canada, about sunset for a post-Feast evening on your own.
- The ship will return to Seattle about 7:00 a.m. on Friday, Oct. 1, allowing you to plan your flight home or stay an extra weekend in the beautiful Seattle area.
