 - California has 5.7 million registered Republicans.
 - California has nearly 7 million people who refuse to name a party.
 - California Democrats make up 45% of voters.
 - California Democrats make up 82% of seats.

How do California Democrats (who make up 45% of registered voters) control 82% of the congressional seats and all of the state government? – Massive gerrymandering.

- Now, Governor Gavin Newsom is proposing to take the Democrats from controlling a mere 82% of congressional seats to controlling 94% of congressional seats.

In the National People’s Congress, only 86% of the delegates belong to the Chinese Communist Party – while the others belong to organizations controlled by the Communist Party.

Even Vladimir Putin settled for 88% of the vote.

Talk of Republicans gerrymandering Texas to create more Republican seats serves as the pretext, but Texas has 25 Republican seats and 12 Democrat seats.

If Republican redistricting plans go through, then Democrats would have as many seats in Texas as Republicans do in California.

Newsom isn’t protesting unfairness – He’s protesting the idea of Democrats in Texas being treated the way that Republicans are in California.

Republican strategist Scott Jennings Tuesday recited a list of states where Democrats dominated redistricting after Democrats complained about a special session of the Texas Legislature.

Democrats in the Texas state Legislature fled to Illinois and New York to thwart a special session of the body to consider redistricting that could net Republicans up to five seats in the United States House of Representatives.

After former Obama administration official Xochitl Hinojosa claimed California had a fair redistricting process Jennings pounced.

Jennings asked some questions of Hinojosa.

- “Regarding California, Republicans get about 40% of the vote, and they have 17% of the congressional seats. So, not a great example.”
- “If it’s rigging the election (that’s your words) in Texas, is it going to be rigging the election (when all these Democrats who say they’re going to gerrymander in the other state) – are you also going to argue that they’re rigging the election or just in Texas?”
- “And have the elections been rigged in Massachusetts, Connecticut, New York, New Jersey, Maryland, New Mexico, Hawaii, Oregon, Washington and Rhode Island? Have they been rigged there as well? Because there the proportion of Republican vote comes nowhere near what they have in Congress.”

New York redrew its congressional districts after the 2022 midterm elections, creating a map that endangered as many as 6 out of the 11 Republicans elected to the House of Representatives.

Illinois Democrats redrew their congressional districts to take out two Republicans (including then-Republican Rep. Adam Kinzinger, a prominent outspoken critic of President Donald Trump) prior to the 2022 midterm elections.

Hinojosa began a statement: “They did a normal redistricting process. If the states end up” – before Jennings cut in saying: “Like gerrymandering?”

Hinojosa continued: “If states end up going and calling special sessions and doing all of these things to try to gain seats, I agree. I don’t agree with that. Do I think they need to do it? Absolutely. Because if Republicans aren’t going to play fair, the Democrats aren’t going to play fair. And that’s the fight that we have to have right now.”

Republican strategist Shermichael Singleton responded: “But Democrats aren’t playing fair in some of the states we listed.”

Former ABC News Senior Correspondent Terry Moran admitted in a July 29 Substack post that his previous employer is “almost inadvertently” a biased organization.

ABC News fired Moran in June over his tirade against White House deputy chief of staff for policy Stephen Miller – whom he accused of being a “world-class hater” in a deleted X post. Moran wrote on his personal Substack that ABC News has fallen into the trap of lacking “viewpoint diversity,” particularly when it came to Trump.

Moran wrote: “Were we biased? Yes. Almost inadvertently, I’d say. ABC News has the same problem so many leading cultural institutions do in America: A lack of viewpoint diversity.”

Moran said that while ABC News made an effort to hire people from various backgrounds, there were hardly any staffers who supported Trump or understood his base. The lack of Trump supporters at ABC News inevitably caused “weirdly anthropological and inaccurate” reporting from ABC journalists who covered Trump or attended his rallies, Moran added.

Moran said: “It is no secret. There are hardly any people who supported Donald Trump at ABC News or the other corporate/legacy/mainstream news networks. And this is bound to impact coverage, not so much out of malevolent bias (that’s the cartoon version peddled by Trump, Brenden Carr and online MAGA), but more out of what is a kind of deafness.”

Moran continued: “The old news divisions don’t hear many of the voices of the country, because those voices aren’t in the newsroom. Yes, news teams go out with a microphone and a camera and accost people at Trump rallies; but to me that often comes off as weirdly anthropological and inaccurate – kind of like trying to understand nature by visiting a zoo. You don’t really see a tiger at the zoo, just a version of a tiger.”

- ABC News paid \$15 million to settle Trump’s defamation lawsuit against the network in December after “This Week” host George Stephanopoulos falsely claimed in March 2024 that the then-president-elect was found liable of rape.
- CBS News and Paramount agreed to pay \$36 million in total to settle a separate lawsuit brought against Trump – which alleged that the network deceptively edited a “60 Minutes” interview with former Vice President Kamala Harris to bolster her chances in the 2024 election.

The “Governors Action Alliance” is a project of the “Global Impact Social Welfare Fund” – a left-leaning advocacy group that has given grants to liberal groups advocating for gun control and stronger environmental regulations.

No! It's not! This idea has failed, again and again!

Socialism (in various degrees) was tried and abandoned in the USSR, China, Vietnam, Mongolia, Cambodia, Afghanistan, South Yemen, Myanmar, Angola, Mozambique, Benin, Congo, Ethiopia, Somalia, Tanzania, Zambia, Ghana, Madagascar, Nicaragua, Guyana, Chile, Israel, Sweden and India.

Countries that didn't abandon socialism (like Cuba, Bolivia and North Korea) stay poor.

Venezuela was once the richest country in Latin America. Now, it's the poorest.

Venezuelan-born economist Daniel Di Martino said: “Socialism destroyed Venezuela. No government has the capacity to run thousands of businesses.”

People need capitalism – a profit motive – to do that.

Yes, China and Vietnam have done well economically, but that only happened because they mostly gave up on “owning the means of production.” Only then did they begin to prosper.

Leftists claim Scandinavia is an example of “successful socialism.”

Senator Bernie Sanders shouts: “Look to countries like Denmark, like Sweden and Norway, and learn from what they have accomplished for their working people.”

But Scandinavia is not socialists! Today, Denmark, Sweden and Norway are capitalist countries with big welfare systems.

Denmark's prime minister was so annoyed by the ignorance of American politicians that he traveled to say: “Denmark is far from a socialist planned economy! Denmark is a market

economy.”

Yet Mamdani says he'll “create a network of city-owned grocery stores . . . whose mission is lower prices, not price-gouging . . . we'll pass on those savings to you.”

“No profit motive” appeals to people. But the profit motive is exactly what keeps stores stocked and groceries relatively cheap. It's why Americans spend much less on food than we did 100 years ago.

Capitalism works because businesses must compete to get your dollars.

Compare your experience at profit-seeking stores to waiting in line at your state's DMV.

Even if Mamdani's state-run groceries work well, they'll still consume tax dollars while taking customers from businesses that pay taxes.

Mamdani says he'll cover those losses by raising taxes on the rich even more. But that's never worked either!

Economist Art Laffer is known for illustrating that at a certain level, higher taxes stop bringing in more money. That's because people work hard to escape high taxes.

Laffer said: “They'll change where they earn their income. Change how much they earn, when they receive the income. They'll change all those things to minimize taxes.”

Maryland found out he was right. Democrats raised taxes on the rich. They expected to bring in \$106 million. The state lost \$257 million.

Europe axed its wealth taxes for the same reason. Millionaires just left.

Even NPR called it an “exodus.”

In America, it's even easier to escape high-tax states and cities. Millions have already left California, New York and Illinois.

Mamdani once acknowledged this: “Our tax base is growing smaller and smaller each day with New Yorkers leaving.”

He doesn't talk about that now.

Mamdani has so many bad ideas, I can't fit them in this column. Next week, I'll write about his other feel-good ideas – like raising the minimum wage to \$30, rent control and free buses.

This was always obvious, but Hollywood played dumb through mutual agreement and the studios ignored us.

That \$612 million gross broke the blacklist and ever since we've received a steady supply of Christian content over the last 20 years – culminating in another worldwide success.

The Chosen is a legitimate phenomenon that is already five seasons into its expected seven-season run – telling the story of Jesus Christ through the eyes of His 12 Apostles.

What I'm waiting for is for someone to bring the *Acts of the Apostles* to life. That particular book of the Bible follows the 11 surviving Apostles as they spread the Gospel throughout the known world. All but two or three (depending on which history you read) were executed for doing so, and knowing that no one dies for a lie makes these stories all the more remarkable.

Between *The Passion* and *The Chosen*, Christians are blessed with exceptional and faithful retelling of the greatest story ever told.
