1 Cor. 13:13	three things abide – faith, hope and love
	Faith
Rom. 4:19	Abraham was not weak in faith – he looked past his old body – he looked past Sarah's menopause
20	he did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief – strengthened in faith, giving glory to God
21 Heb. 11:1	fully convinced that what God had promised, He was also able to deliver faith is the substance of things hoped for – the evidence of things not seen

Acts 24:14	this I confess to you – I worship the God of my fathers – believing the things which are written in the Law and in the Prophets
15	I have hope in God (which they themselves also accept) that there will be a resurrection of the dead (both of the just and the unjust)
16	therefore – I always strive to have a conscience without offense toward God and people
Eph. 1:18-20	the eyes of your understanding being enlightened – that you may know the hope of His calling the riches of the glory of His inheritance the exceeding greatness of His power toward us working of His mighty power – which He worked in Christ
20-23	what did He work in Christ? when He raised Him from the dead He seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places He seated Him far above all principality, power, might, dominion and every name He put all things under Christ's feet He gave Christ to be head over all things to the church He gave Christ to be the fullness of all

Job 1:21-22	at that moment – in all this, Job did not sin nor charge God with wrong
Job 2:10	at that moment – Job did not sin with his lips
Job 3:1	later – Job opened his mouth and cursed the day of his birth
Job 9:32-33	the Lord is not a man (like me) that I may answer Him, that we can negotiate together – there is no mediator between us
Job 33:6	Elihu said – I am as your spokesman before God
8-11	Elihu – I have heard you say, that you are innocent and that you have been mistreated
12	Elihu – you are wrong
13	Elihu – why do you contend with God?
Job 40:2	God told Job – "Shall the one who contends with the Almighty correct Him? He who rebukes God, let him answer it"
Job 42:5	now my eye sees you

Rom. 5:1	justified by faith – peace with God (through our Lord Jesus Christ)
2	access by faith – rejoice in hope
5	hope does not disappoint – because of the love of God
