The “AI Apocalypse” scare campaign looks suspiciously like the climate hoax. How convenient that it’s come to a head right as the midterm election season kicks off this week.

The campaign launch was when Jacob Coxon, a low-level 27-year-old AI researcher, trumpeted his resignation from AI company Anthropic in a Wall Street Journal exclusive last week followed by a viral X thread warning AI will “kill us all.”

“The people building AI earnestly believe that it could kill us all by the end of the decade . . . They are gambling with our lives,” he claimed.

His boss, the Democrat-aligned Anthropic founder and CEO Dario Amodei, amplified Coxon’s apocalyptic message with a 3,800-word essay on Saturday, followed by a giddy interview CBS aired Sunday in which he essentially called for a one-world government to regulate AI.

He wants “the right combination of governments” to provide “some kind of joint governance [to] control the technology.

“I’m uncomfortable government didn’t build this technology.”

Bernie Sanders, who announced the “Ban Artificial Superintelligence Act” this month with dark warnings about the existential threat, joined him on the airwaves Sunday: “We don’t have months. We don’t have years. We got to move now.”

‘O,’ of course

Anthropic’s intervention caps a summer in which a top Democrat talking point, parroted by candidates across the country, has been the perils of AI data centers. It’s a topic that, seemingly out of nowhere, now polls as a significant issue for voters, probably helped by a Chinese social media influence campaign discovered by X to stir up hostility against data centers.

Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent told the G20 this month that America would have 80 percent of the world’s computing power by 2028, so it stands to reason China wants to slow us down.

No wonder David Sacks, chairman of the President’s Council of Advisors on Science and Technology, suggests the latest Anthropic doom-fest is an “election season psy-op.”

Of course Barack Obama is involved. The former president and back-room Machiavelli “has taken a special interest in AI in recent years, and has offered himself as a sounding board to industry leaders, including [Open AI’s Sam] Altman and Mr. Amodei,” says *The New York Times*.

During a closed-door midterm fundraiser in Manhattan on Thursday with House Minority Leader Hakeem Jeffries, Obama urged party donors and Democrat House members to make AI regulation the center of their agenda. He told them AI was even more “dangerous,” than nukes.

“You don’t need a bunch of highly enriched uranium” to build powerful AI, he said according to a transcript provided to the Times.

Obama’s sly argument that AI Armageddon is way worse than a nuclear apocalypse may successfully blunt Donald Trump’s argument that he’s intervening in Iran to stop the regime developing nukes.

The uncanny coordination of messages sure smells like an “election season psyop” designed to scare the electorate into voting Democrat. All that’s needed is an anti-AI Greta Thunberg.

The top four stories on the Times homepage over the weekend were Anthropic’s AI alarmism, plus a cover story of Sunday’s print edition.

It’s the same media game we’ve seen time and again, with the same deep-state bad actors who were behind the anti-Trump dirty tricks from the Russia hoax to the Dirty 51 letter that falsely claimed Hunter Biden’s laptop was Russian disinformation.

Anthropic's Dems

But Anthropic is the last entity you would trust on AI safety.

For one thing, its supposedly “bipartisan” National Security and Public Sector Advisory Council is stacked with former Biden and Obama intelligence officials who are closely connected to anti-Trump hoaxers like former CIA director John Brennan and Michael Morell, the former acting CIA chief who coordinated the Dirty 51 letter before the 2020 election at the behest of Anthony Blinken, Biden’s future secretary of state.

One Anthropic council member is David Cohen, who was CIA Deputy Director under Brennan and involved in cooking up the bogus Intelligence Community Assessment commissioned by Obama in December 2016 that used the debunked Steele Dossier to claim Russia interfered in the 2016 election to help Donald Trump. Cohen was also Biden’s CIA deputy director and signed a public letter with Morell supporting Brennan after Trump revoked his security clearance. Cohen was an early member of Blinken’s consultancy WestExec Advisors and co-authored a 2020 Foreign Policy article on the “politicization of intelligence” with Morell.

Another member of Anthropic’s council is Christopher Fonzone, Obama’s Deputy White House Counsel, and NSC legal adviser who later served as Office of the Director of National Intelligence General Counsel under Biden.

Another Anthropic council member is Richard Fontaine, who succeeded Victoria Nuland as CEO of DC think tank the Center for a New American Security, where Cohen was a senior fellow.

Chuck Schumer’s former national-security adviser Mike Kuiken is yet another council member.

Anthropic is like Pfizer before the 2020 election, when it delayed announcing the COVID jab: a captured industry leader pressed into service by Democrats before a crucial election.

Vance must push back

Nvidia CEO Jensen Huang dismisses AI fear-mongering as “complete nonsense.” He told a Goldman Sachs conference Thursday that the latest Anthropic scare is just a ruse for the industry to gin up business for new cybersecurity products.

“What better way to create demand than to create a problem?”

In any case, as Sacks tweeted Saturday, nothing is stopping Amodei and Altman from policing the AI frontier themselves.

“You guys are the frontier. [You] have a duopoly on frontier intelligence . . . Stop pretending you need anyone else’s permission. Stop pretending antitrust law has to be suspended so you can

form a cartel. Stop pretending you need a regulatory approval process that supersedes product liability . . . Stop pretending the motivation to slow down is purely altruistic . . . “The easiest way not to build superintelligence is for you to agree not to build it . . . “If you don’t, we’ll know this was just another bid for regulatory capture — or an election-season psyop.”

It sure looks that way. But history shows that even the most transparent hoax can succeed in the short term.

The AI fear campaign could mean the difference for Republicans at the midterms if they aren’t careful. It also helps Dems toxify the Republican spending advantage by tying it to AI — Elon Musk is reportedly dumping a big bucket of cash in Michigan to stop Abdul El-Sayed, for instance.

The administration needs to nip this in the bud, and JD Vance should be leading the charge. With his Silicon Valley background, gift of the gab and pet reporters at the Times, he’s in an ideal position to grab hold of the narrative and bend it toward reality. After all, his own political prospects will suffer if Trump is rebuked this November.

President Trump announced Friday that his administration had concluded a deal with Denmark to take over security for the island of Greenland, raising hopes that one of the major points of contention between the US and Europe would be settled.

“I am pleased to announce that the United States of America has entered into an Agreement with The Kingdom of Denmark, and Greenland, that gives the United States permanent control over security, and all other needs, in Greenland, completely addressing ALL of our many U.S. concerns,” Trump wrote on Truth Social. “There will be NO COST to the United States!”

The three governments are expected to sign the agreement next week at the United Nations General Assembly in New York, according to Denmark, which had reacted angrily to repeated suggestions by the president that the US might annex the territory.

“I am glad that we are about to make a great agreement for Greenland, the Kingdom of Denmark, and the United States,” Danish Prime Minister Mette Frederiksen said in a statement.

Frederiksen said the agreement “strengthens our common security in the Arctic and the North Atlantic Area and therefore is great for NATO and Europe as well.”

He noted that the deal also “recognizes the sovereignty and territorial integrity of the Kingdom and the Greenlandic people’s right to self-determination.”

Jens-Frederik Nielsen, the Premier of Greenland, said the agreement “recognizes Greenland’s interests and our place in the international cooperation. It is to the benefit of us all,” Nielsen said in a statement.

There was no immediate response from Denmark, which had reacted angrily to repeated suggestions by the president that the US might annex the territory.

The deal announced by Trump Friday keeps the world’s largest island in Copenhagen’s hands — but gives Washington veto power over which countries can have a military presence there.

The US has kept a military presence on Greenland under the auspices of NATO since 1951 and currently operates the Pituffik Space Base, about 750 miles above the Arctic Circle.

“[T]he United States will FOREVER have the complete ability to do what is necessary in Greenland in order to secure and defend the security of Greenland, and the United States of America,” the president’s post continued. “Additionally, from now on, no U.S. adversary can EVER have a base in Greenland, have a military presence in Greenland, or make sensitive investments in Greenland, without our express written approval.”

Trump added that the US will “immediately begin the process of developing a large Military presence in the appropriate part of Greenland, of which there are many. We will work with the people of Greenland in its development and construction.

“This solution is a great one for the United States of America, Denmark, Greenland, and all of our Allies. We look forward to working with the wonderful people of Denmark and Greenland toward a magnificent future with respect to this large, and highly strategic, parcel of land. We will be very protective of it!”

Additional details of the announced deal — as well as an official text — were not immediately available.

“This historic deal is a huge win for the United States and the American people,” Secretary of State Marco Rubio told Fox News Digital in a statement. “Thanks to President Trump’s vision and leadership, this historic agreement permanently guarantees US security interests in the Arctic at zero cost to the US taxpayer.”

“Greenland will forever be part of the strategic defense area of North America and exclude any adversary from it and the surrounding area,” Rubio said. “This deal permanently and completely addresses our national security concerns in Greenland.”

Ahead of Trump’s announcement, Reuters had reported, citing two sources familiar with the talks, that an agreement was close and Greenlandic territory could be used to house components of the Golden Dome — the massive, space-focused missile defense system that officials hope to start bringing online in 2028.

Soon after returning to the White House in January 2025, Trump called on Denmark to sell Greenland to the US, citing the importance of the island to national security. He then aggravated tensions with Europe by pointedly refusing to rule out taking over the island by force.

Leaders of both Denmark and Greenland repeatedly said the island was not for sale and condemned reports of US intelligence gathering on Greenlandic territory.

“For over 100 years, Presidents have known the strategic importance of Greenland, but NONE of them were able to do anything about it,” Trump said Friday. “I am proud to be the President that permanently and conclusively addressed this very important situation. This is an ‘Infinite Life’ Agreement, there is no end! We are very honored and proud of what has just taken place, and everything agreed to today will be cherished by the American People.”

“He couldn’t get over the fact that Clancy viciously killed her children.”

Those are the words of one of the insufferably condescending female jurors from the Lindsay Clancy mistrial who have gone public with their disdain for the lone male juror who refused to go along with their not guilty verdict.

Good for him.

The children, Cora, 5, Dawson, 3, and Callan, 8 months, have been the forgotten victims in this case.

The Massachusetts nurse does not dispute that she strangled her children one by one on Jan. 24, 2023, with exercise bands around their necks after she sent her husband, Patrick, out on an errand.

Patrick returned to his kids dead and his wife bleeding on the snow-covered yard after she cut her wrists and throat and leaped out a bedroom window 12 feet above the ground, rendering herself paralyzed from the waist down. Rather than accepting blame, Lindsay, 36, pleaded not guilty, claiming she could not tell right from wrong at the time because she was suffering from postpartum psychosis, even though evidence for that was thin.

Withstood pressure

A mistrial was called last Friday because the jury of nine women and three men could not agree on a verdict after more than seven days of deliberations so contentious that yelling reportedly could be heard outside the room.

Now that several of the jurors have come out and exposed themselves, we can see the immense pressure that the lone holdout juror was under day after day in that jury room, being harangued and browbeaten by women infuriated that he refused to be persuaded by their self-proclaimed superior wisdom.

Jury forewoman Roni Carlson, a former elementary school teacher, Kellie Farina, a chef for a senior center, and Paula Devlin, who does work for a defense contractor, were interviewed on camera by NBC10 Boston, and it's hard to imagine a more smug group lacking in self-awareness or any humility. They revealed that there were a number of nurses and teachers on the jury.

"He was very arrogant," Devlin said of the holdout. "He did not take anything that anybody said."

She complained there were multiple nurses on the jury who took it on themselves to explain the toxicology reports to the holdout juror.

"He tried to ask a question about the medications," said Devlin. "We had the toxicology report. We could see exactly the amounts. The nurses in the room spoke to that. And talked to that.

"And they spoke to that . . . And he just completely disregarded the information that they gave him." As was his right.

Carlson, the forewoman, said she thought they'd won the argument at one point. "He admitted he had reasonable doubt and I started filling out the forms, I was so excited . . . And then he said, 'But I'm still not going to say that she's not guilty by reason of insanity.' "

As was his right.

Another woman, Juror No. 5, spoke to CBS Boston anonymously in defense of the holdout: "The majority of people . . . was very firm in their stance and their beliefs from the beginning . . . The standalone juror was not the only one who refused to see things from the other side so I'm going to defend [him]. There were some big personalities in that room."

Originally, she thought Lindsay" was guilty and she was criminally responsible for it, and maybe I still believe that in a certain way." Several other jurors reportedly felt the same way but over time were persuaded to find Lindsay not guilty — all but the holdout.

Lawyer's big show

The outspoken female jurors absolutely loved Lindsay's attorney, Kevin Reddington, and gushed about how "entertaining" and "compassionate" he was. In their minds he had proved that Lindsay was not a bad mother and she "loved her children" and that was all that mattered. Yet Reddington behaved like an emotional bully, inside and outside the court, especially when he put a target on the holdout juror, whom he blamed for the mistrial in an extended public tantrum outside the court on Friday.

"I hope that guy can sleep well at night," Reddington said. In court he called the same juror a "liar" and said he "stole seven weeks of the life" of the other jurors," which is rich considering that in the entire seven-week trial Reddington barely mentioned the three entire lives stolen from the Clancy children by his client.

Reddington also fueled false internet rumors that Patrick was involved in the killing of his own children by refusing to exonerate him when asked and instead praising the TikTok sleuths who have damned Patrick.

"I certainly don't dismiss them. It's amazing what people on TikTok . . . how they're able to ferret out facts and they do investigations."

Reddington must have realized he went too far because this week he appeared on "CBS Mornings" and recanted, saying, "It's obvious that Patrick was a man who stood by his wife through all of the difficulty. [He] ought to be able to move on with his life."

Despite Reddington's flaws, the outspoken female jurors preferred him to prosecutors Jennifer Sprague and Shanan Buckingham, whom they criticized as lacking "compassion" and being "unprofessional."

For the children

The prosecutors were entirely professional. Did Carlson and pals disdain them because of their plump appearance, because they don't have time to go to Pilates every morning?

Sprague and Buckingham have 50 years of prosecutorial experience between them and children of their own, earning modest salaries for draining work in child protection cases. They did their best, although their speedy four-day jury selection leaves something to be desired.

Their boss, District Attorney Tim Cruz, who has been protecting the 500,000 residents of Plymouth County for the past 25 years, was heckled relentlessly outside the court Friday.

The son of a plumber with children and grandchildren of his own, he is the longest serving DA in Massachusetts, even though he is a Republican in a Democrat-majority area.

Plymouth has street signs declaring it "America's Hometown," since it is where the Pilgrims arrived on the Mayflower in 1620 and founded the first permanent European settlement in New England. The affluent, predominantly white town, which voted for Kamala Harris over Donald Trump by almost 10 points in 2024, also adopted the slogan "No Place for Hate."

Officials abandoned that name last year, but it still appears on some signs around town.

In spite of the heckling, Cruz spoke with understated dignity, saying: "I understand that this has been an emotional trial for everybody . . . But in the end I bring it all back to the child victims in this case, Cora, Dawson, and Callan . . . "Children were murdered, and it's our job to seek justice."

Justice is important, regardless of feelings. The trial was not just about Lindsay and her tragedy. It was about the children and precedents set for child murder. Already there are reports of at least one copycat murder.

For the sake of all the other children yet to be born, we cannot afford to become a society that normalizes mothers killing their babies.

A lesbian minister at James Talarico's longtime Austin church believes the Democrat is playing a political game in an attempt to flip Texas blue as he races to recast his record on transgender issues and his declaration that "God is non-binary," according to undercover footage obtained by *The Daily Wire*.

Rev. Babs Miller, minister to the parish at St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church, was caught making stunning admissions about Talarico's political makeover as he seeks to win over conservative-minded Texas moderates. The newfound shift includes striking new positions, including support for a national ban on gender-transition surgeries for minors and opposition to transgender athletes competing in girls' sports when he believes it threatens safety or fairness.

When an undercover journalist told Miller that Republicans were attacking Talarico over his "God is non-binary" comment, she responded, "Duh," agreeing with the theological assertion before shedding light on his internal political strategy.

"He's getting some advice that I don't think he should be following," Miller said.

Miller then suggested Talarico would revert to his embrace of the LGBT movement's most extreme elements if he wins the race against Texas Republican Attorney General Ken Paxton.

"I can guarantee you that once he gets elected, he'll change his tune back to where he was," she said.

When the undercover journalist suggested Talarico had to "play this game," Miller shook her head and agreed.

"That's what his campaign has convinced him of," Miller said. "The Democratic Party is backing off on their stances on trans and all of this, and so his staff is encouraging him to kind of do the same thing, just for the next 50 weeks, whatever days."

"I think it's bad advice personally, but if it helps him win, okay..." an exasperated Miller added.

Talarico has long attended St. Andrew's Presbyterian Church in Austin, where he has delivered politically charged sermons, including one declaring "God is not a Christian." Miller's church bio says she has been part of the St. Andrew's community since the mid-1990s and was ordained there in 2014 as an "out" lesbian chaplain. She retired shortly before the COVID-19 pandemic but returned in 2022.

The Daily Wire recently obtained additional undercover footage in which Texas Democratic Party organizer Jennifer Miranda described Talarico's shift as a misleading campaign to flip disgruntled conservative Texans not thrilled about Paxton at the top of the ticket.

“I would say right now he’s trying to target a wider net, which unfortunately means being more palatable to Republicans here in Texas,” Miranda, a manager with Texas Together and the Texas Democratic Party, said. “He really needs to win those Texans over.”

The footage was published after Talarico appeared on FOX News to whitewash his most extreme past positions as Republicans flood the airwaves with attacks seeking to define him as a radical in a culturally conservative state.

“Every sport has to be safe and fair. As a former public school teacher, I care a lot about our student athletes. And so, I will oppose trans athletes playing in girls’ sports if it risks safety or fairness,” Talarico told FOX.

In 2021, however, Talarico voted against Senate Bill 29 while serving on the Texas House Public Education Committee. The bill sought to require public-school athletes to compete according to the biological sex listed on their birth certificates.

During the interview, Talarico also pledged to “absolutely” support a national ban on gender-transition surgeries for minors. In reality, Talarico voted against Senate Bill 14, the 2023 Texas legislation restricting sex-change surgeries for minors.

One GOP-sponsored ad is capitalizing on Talarico’s record on the toxic issue, running back a famous 2024-style attack to cast him as a “radical liberal” who is for “they/them” – “not you.”

Beyond his voting record, Talarico’s church in question features books containing sexually explicit content and transgender themes, *The Daily Wire* previously reported. There, children have access to a library stocked with “banned books,” including titles that contain descriptions of anal rape, incest, and oral sex, according to *The Daily Wire*’s review of its offerings.

The latest footage exposes growing tensions over Talarico’s political makeover, with his longtime church and Democratic organizers pushing back against his calculated bid to win over the voters he needs for a six-year Senate term. The Cook Political Report currently rates the Texas Senate race as a toss-up.

Texas Democratic Senate candidate James Talarico’s longtime church gives new members copies of the “Inclusive Bible” — a modern translation designed to remove what its creators describe as “sexist” language — according to undercover footage obtained exclusively by the Daily Caller.

Rev. Jim Rigby, the head pastor at St. Andrew's Presbyterian in Austin for over 35 years and a spiritual mentor to Talarico, tells an undercover journalist that the church "typically" gives people a copy of the Inclusive Bible "when they join," in the undercover footage.

"It's good on the gender stuff," Rigby says in the video. "The more, like, metaphysical stuff, it's not a very good translation, if that makes sense. I think it's really important to have a good translation so you can let go of the stupid stuff."

(Amber Duke wrote on facebook: "NEW: James Talarico's longtime spiritual mentor, Rev. Jim Rigby, says his church provides copies of the 'Inclusive Bible' to new members. The 'Inclusive Bible' strips the Bible of 'gendered language.' It refuses to call Jesus the Son of God.")

The Inclusive Bible's translators say the version goes beyond simply swapping out male pronouns. They describe it as a "re-imagining" of Scripture intended to find "new and non-sexist ways" to express biblical language.

In a section explaining its translation choices, the book states that it avoids using "Son of God" to describe Jesus, instead preferring "Only Begotten," "God's Own," and "Eternally Begotten." It also changes other traditional gendered references to God, including "Lord," which the translators say is "sexist" and "classist."

The undercover footage, captured in August 2026, shows the church putting its policy into practice. During a service, a new member identified as Larry is presented with a copy of the Inclusive Bible.

"And Martha's here to give Larry his Inclusive Bible," an unidentified woman says. "It's the Bible that we use at this church. It's been rewritten so that there is only inclusive language and that it doesn't use the gender-fueled language that the King James Version uses."

Talarico has deep ties to St. Andrew's and Rigby. Talarico was baptized at St. Andrew's and has been attending services there since he was a child. Rigby also married Talarico's parents and delivered the invocation when Talarico was sworn into the Texas House.

A Texas Monthly profile from December 2025 notes that Talarico "took to Rigby at a young age," and reports that the two attended several political protests together in the early 2000s.

"He always told us our love for God has to grow into justice and move us from the sanctuary to the streets," Talarico said in a February 2024 interview with Good Faith Media. The outlet reported that Rigby has "mentored and inspired" Talarico throughout his life. Rigby's theology has repeatedly departed from traditional Christian doctrine and practice. He avoids Christian creeds and prayers in services to avoid being unwelcoming to non-Christians, has described Jesus as closer to a "loving atheist than an indifferent theologian," compared fetal remains to "extracted teeth," and appeared to deny the Virgin Birth and the Resurrection of Jesus.

Talarico has similarly described St. Andrew's as formative to both his faith and politics.

"Politics and religion and causing trouble all was very intertwined and synonymous for me growing up," he told the Texas Tribune.

St. Andrew's approach to gender and theology overlaps with several public statements Talarico has made about his own faith.

Talarico stated in a 2021 Texas House floor debate that "God is non-binary." Asked about the remark in March 2026, he described it as "cringey" and "deliberately provocative," but rejected that it is "controversial theologically" because "God is beyond gender."

In a 2021 appearance on the "Activist Theology" podcast, Talarico described himself as a "Christian who hates Christianity." The state representative also argued in an interview with Joe Rogan that there is "a lot of biblical evidence" that supports being pro-abortion.

Talarico is running for Senate in Texas against Attorney General Ken Paxton; current polling has both candidates within striking distance of each other.

The Daily Caller reached out to Talarico's campaign and St. Andrew's but did not receive a response in time for publication.
