Over the past three years, we reporters learned there were certain things that we weren't allowed to say. Not long ago, in fact, my new video may have been censored.

#### **Covid origin**

One dangerous idea, we were told, was that covid-19 might have been created in a lab at the Wuhan Institute of Virology. That seems very possible, since the institute studied corona viruses in bats, and America's National Institutes of Health gave the lab money to perform "gain-of-function" research, experiments where scientists try to make a virus more virulent or transmissible.

A Washington Post writer worried the lab leak theory "could increase racist attacks against Chinese people and further fuel anti-Asian hate."

The establishment media fell in line, insisting that covid most likely came from a local market that sold animals.

Left-wing TV mocked the lab theory as a "fringe idea" that came from "a certain corner of the right."

"This coronavirus was not manmade," said MSNBC's Chris Hayes, confidently. "That is not a possibility."

Not even a possibility?

Debate about it, we were told, posed a new threat: misinformation.

Facebook banned the lap leak theory, calling it a "false claim."

But now the U.S. Department of Energy says the pandemic most likely came from a lab leak. FBI director Christopher Wray now says the origin of the pandemic is "most likely a potential lab incident in Wuhan."

For two years, the most likely explanation was censored.

Do the media gatekeepers apologize for their censorship? No.

The closest to an admission of guilt I found was from Chris Hayes, who eventually said, "There's a kernel of truth to the idea that some folks were too quick to shut down the lab leak theory."

There was more than "a kernal of truth." Again and again, politically correct media silenced people who spoke the truth.

#### Masks not effective

Facebook throttled the reach of science journalist John Tierney's articles simply because he reported, accurately, that requiring masks can hurt kids.

YouTube suspended Sen. Rand Paul (R-Ky.) for saying, "Most of the masks you get over the counter don't work."

But what they said is true. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention updated its guidance to say cloth masks are not very effective. And now a big study failed to find evidence that wearing even good masks stops the spread of viruses.

# **Hunter Biden laptop**

Probably the most blatant censorship was Twitter's shutting down the New York Post's reporting about Hunter Biden's laptop.

Twitter wouldn't let users decide for themselves. The company just called the Post's report "potentially harmful" and blocked users from sharing it.

Facebook, as usual, was sneakier, suppressing the story instead of banning it outright. That's what they do to my climate change reporting.

Today, the media admit the Post story is true. But they don't admit they were wrong. Now they just say things like, "Nobody cares about Hunter Biden's laptop."

#### Government worse than media

Bad as the media are, what's worse is that government wanted to censor.

Sen. Mark Warner (D-Va.) complained, "We've done nothing in terms of content regulation!"

Fortunately, his colleagues were not as irresponsible as he; no censorship legislation passed. But government did apply lots of pressure.

The White House asked Facebook to kill what they called "disinformation," even urging them to censor private WhatsApp messages.

Now that Elon Musk owns Twitter and opened up the company's internal files, we know that censorship requests came from "every corner" of government, as journalist Matt Taibbi put it.

Even individual politicians tried to censor.

Sen. Angus King's (I-Maine) staff complained about Twitter accounts that they considered "anti-

King." Rep. Adam Schiff's (D-Calif.) office asked Twitter to suppress search results.

Fortunately, Twitter refused.

But the sad truth is that lots of government agencies and media tyrants want to limit what you read and hear

Did you survive the budget cuts from the last debt ceiling fight?

President Joe Biden called them "draconian," while Republicans praised the deal's "historic reductions in spending."

But both parties conned us.

What they call "cuts" were just a reduction in their planned spending increase. Instead of raising spending by 7.8 percent, they increased it by "only" 3.9 percent. Only politicians get to call an increase a cut.

Biden praised the deal, saying, "We're cutting spending and bringing the deficits down at the same time!"

But they didn't. And now they are using tricks to spend even more.

"Call it an emergency-done," says Cato Institute budge specialist Romina Boccia. "Spend the money on whatever you want."

Boccia reports how the Senate is moving to increase spending beyond the agreed-upon caps simply by calling it "emergency" spending.

"They gave \$296 million to NASA for 'emergency infrastructure.' What's 'emergency infrastructure?' "I asked.

"That's not really a thing," she replied. "It's just a way to plus up the NASA budget . . . a huge slush fund."

"How do they justify this?"

"They don't even try," Boccia complained. "Unfortunately, Congress has complete discretion over what it calls 'emergency.'

This trick isn't new. Under President Barack Obama, \$150 million for fisheries got added by calling it "emergency funding."

In the current budget, even useless agencies that should be eliminated (like the Education Department) get more money. It will now spend 300 percent more than it spent 10 years ago.

"By then end of this decade, spending will be about \$10 trillion," says Boccia. "Who will be willing to lend that money to the U.S. government?"

Good question.

Boccia and the Cato Institute propose a solution: Congress should create an independent commission to do the cutting. That way politicians can say, "Don't blame me, the commission made the cuts!"

That worked once with military bases.

The military actually wanted to close some bases. But selfish members of Congress fought any closure in their states.

By ignoring the self-serving politicians, the Base Realignment and Closure Commission got 350 bases closed.

It was quite successful until Congress turned it off," said Boccia.

Since Congress won't cut, and Biden definitely won't, an independent commission may be our only hope.

We need to do something before our debt explodes, mauling our future.

In this season of giving, I'll donate to the Doe Fund, a charity that helps drug abusers and excons find purpose in life through work. Doe's approach doesn't include many handouts. It's mostly about encouraging people to work. Most Doe Fund workers don't go back to jail.

Yet some on the left say giving time and money to charity is a mistake. Their trust in government leads them to think that government programs are much better at lifting people out of poverty.

"Charity can distract from permanent solutions," claims an article in the *Harvard Political Review*. "Time, effort and funding that are funneled into charitable acts could be redirected to actual solutions spearheaded by the government, which has the resources to implement concrete change."

#### Yikes!

Yes, government has "resources," all of which are taken from taxpayers by force. "Concrete is fitting because government's "solutions" are rigid and immovable.

But as far as promoting change that's actually useful, government has a terrible track record.

Before President Lyndon Johnson launched his "war on poverty," Americans were lifting themselves out of poverty. Every year, the poverty rate dropped.

When welfare checks began, progress continued for about seven years. But then progress stopped! Progress stopped even as America spent \$27 trillion on its "war."

## What happened?

Government handouts changed people's thinking. They taught millions of Americans: You are entitled to a check.

No longer was it individuals' responsibility to help families, neighbors, and ourselves; now it was clearly the government's job.

The result is that people became dependent on handouts. Government rarely teaches people to be self-sufficient; handouts encourage you to be helpless.

Welfare created something never seen before in America: a near-permanent "underclass."

Welfare told parents.

- Don't get married, you'll lose benefits.
- Don't work, your check will be reduced.
- Above all, make sure the father isn't home when a welfare worker comes.

(If he is, your check may be reduced or eliminated.)

This changed incentives that motivated parents for generations. The result has been ruinous for millions of children.

Charities aren't perfect, but they are much more efficient than clumsy government.

Charities have the freedom to be selective. They can help people who truly need aid, but also refuse charity to people who need "a kick in the butt." Government's one-size-fits-all rules prohibit that.

Charity is not guaranteed forever. People don't know how long they can expect to receive assistance. They have an incentive to become self-sufficient.

In addition, while charities actually give most of their money to the needy, government doesn't. America's constantly growing welfare workforce today is so bloated that 70 percent of welfare money now goes to the bureaucrats!

As ususal, big government is the problem rather than a solution.

Americans are generous. Most of us donate to charities, many of which will provide more permanent help to the needy than government ever will.

Ideally, America would shrink government and lower taxes so more of us would have money to spend how we want. For most, that means giving to those in need.

To help people, we need more rich people.

If only there was a system that made people richer.

Oh, right! There is – capitalism!

Over the past 30 years, more than a billion people climbed out of extreme poverty – thanks to free markets.

As capitalism makes us richer, we each have more opportunity to help others in need.
