An article by Julia Ainsley and Abigail Williams titled "Honduran Migrant Caravan Grows to 4,000 Amid Spike in U.S. Border Crossings" was posted at nbcnews.com on Oct. 17, 2018. Following is the article.

A caravan of migrants fleeing Honduras has grown to 4,000, and the Mexican government has sent 500 additional federal police to its border with Guatemala in anticipation of their arrival, according to U.S. government documents obtained by NBC News.

Part of the caravan, which has split into two groups, is approaching the Mexico-Guatemala border amid a surge in border crossings on the U.S.-Mexico border.

In September, U.S. Border Patrol agents apprehended more than 41,400 undocumented immigrants, up from 37,544 in August, according to numbers not yet released publicly but obtained by NBC News.

The Washington Post reported Wednesday that the numbers of families and children traveling on their own surged to record levels in September.

Shelters and churches along the border have been flooded as a result of the surge as U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement agents have been releasing hundreds of migrants from detention at a time.

Many of the Hondurans traveling in the caravan are children, some traveling with their parents and some without, according to the documents.

Because children are afforded special protections in the United States, their arrival is creating anxiety within the Trump administration, which has pledged to decrease illegal immigration. President Donald Trump said last week that he would consider separating migrant families at the border once again, after reversing his controversial "zero tolerance" policy in June.

U.S. Customs and Border Protection is tracking the caravan as the Hondurans make their way north toward the U.S. border. Meanwhile, the State Department is trying to stave off that possibility by compelling the Mexican government to stop them at its border with Guatemala.

Secretary of State Mike Pompeo will travel to Mexico to meet with his counterparts on Friday, and plans to stop the caravan will be a "prominent" topic of discussion, a senior State Department official told reporters on Wednesday.

"I am certain that there will be conversations in Mexico about how we can work together on this issue," the official said about the caravan. "We are certainly looking for concrete results and for solutions that work for both countries."

Trump has threatened to cut aid to Honduras and Guatemala if their governments do not stop the caravan. It remains to be seen what pressure the United States will put on Mexico, but a senior Homeland Security official said border agents were hopeful that State Department negotiations would significantly curb the numbers that reach the United States.

The deputy chief of mission at the U.S. Embassy in Guatemala, David Hodge, arrived on Wednesday at Casa del Migrante, where hundreds of Honduran migrants continue to arrive. He told them not to continue traveling to the north.

Hodge said in an interview that he was there to tell the migrants "that President Trump's message was clear—that anyone who enters the United States illegally will be arrested before being deported."

"The United States government is very aware of the security and prosperity problems in the countries of the Northern Triangle, but we are investing hundreds of millions of dollars every year to improve situations," he said, referring to Guatemala, Honduras and El Salvador.

"People need their future in their country, and they must return to their country," he said.

Police have been sent in part to quell protesters in the state of Chiapas, which borders Guatemala, who are advocating for the safe treatment of the immigrants, according to the documents.

Cooperating with the United States on strict border policies has been met with a serious backlash in Mexico, and it contributed to the election of President-elect Andrés Manuel López Obrador.

López Obrador said Wednesday that when he takes office on Dec. 1, his administration will "give jobs to Central Americans. It is a plan that we have, that anyone who wants to work in Mexico will have a work visa."

He said he had told Trump that he wanted to emphasize options besides deportation, including work, for Central Americans.

An article by Patrick Goodenough titled "Snubbing the US, UN Empowers Palestinian Observer Mission to Lead Major Bloc" was posted at cnsnews.com on Oct. 17, 2018. Following is the article.

In another move unlikely to endear the Trump administration to the United Nations, the General Assembly has endorsed, by an overwhelming margin, an "enabling" resolution giving the Palestinian observer mission powers of a member-state, albeit for a limited amount of time.

The Egypt-sponsored resolution, designed to facilitate the Palestinian mission's presidency next year of the biggest bloc of developing nations at the U.N.—the G77 and China—passed on Tuesday with 146 votes to three, with 15 countries abstaining.

It gives the "state of Palestine," acting on behalf of the G77 and China, the right to introduce and make statements, submit and co-sponsor proposals and amendments, and raise procedural motions, among others.

The "no" votes came from the United States—which urged all delegations to oppose the measure—joined by Israel and Australia.

Abstaining were mostly European countries—Andorra, Austria, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Monaco, Poland and Slovakia—joined by Canada, Honduras and the Pacific island nation of Tuvalu.

(Britain, Germany and the Netherlands stressed in statements their support should not be construed as constituting recognition of Palestinian statehood.)

Hillel Neuer, executive director of the non-governmental organization UN Watch, tweeted in response, "The UN leaves the world of reality behind by voting 146-3 for 'State of Palestine' (which has no effective control & therefore cannot be a state) to pretend to be a state & chair the 134-member G-77 group of UN states."

There is no sovereign state of Palestine, but the self-rule Palestinian Authority chaired by Mahmoud Abbas has since 2012 been given the status of "observer state" in the General Assembly.

Although still called the G77, the group today has 134 members, including seven of the world's ten most populous nations. It accounts for 80 percent of the global population, and more than two-thirds of the membership of the General Assembly.

The group's decision over the summer to confer its rotating chairmanship in 2019 on the Palestinian observer mission was widely seen as a response to the Trump administration's active pro-Israel stand at the U.N., particularly the recognition of Jerusalem as Israel's capital and the relocation of the U.S. Embassy to that city.

Before the vote, U.S. deputy ambassador Jonathan Cohen said the U.S. opposes both the Palestinians chairing the G77 next year, and the resolution facilitating it.

"The United States does not recognize that there is a Palestinian state and notes that no such state has been admitted as a U.N. member-state," he said.

"Only U.N. member-states should be entitled to speak and act on behalf of major groups of states at the United Nations, such as the Group of 77 and China," Cohen said. "It is entirely inappropriate for an observer to play the role of representing a group of states in the General Assembly or elsewhere in the United Nations system."

He said the initiative is the opposite of what is required for peace in the Middle East—"the courage to sit down at the table, and make compromises."

The G77 was established in the 1960s, with 77 original members, to allow developing countries to promote their collective economic interests.

Israel's deputy ambassador, Noa Furman, told the assembly all members should be concerned "if the group is exploited for non-development issues, and is used to advance the political interests of one delegation."

"Constant attempts to keep changing the rules of procedure to accommodate one observer delegation—in a manner that would not be tolerated for any of the member-states—only weakens this institution," she argued.

After the vote Palestinian delegate Riyad Mansour hailed a decision he described as representing "multilateralism at its best."

His delegation would work to "advance cooperation and mutually beneficial agreements for the common good of humanity," he said.

U.S. Ambassador to the U.N. Nikki Haley in a later statement echoed Cohen's words about the U.S. non-recognition of Palestinian statehood, and added that the U.S. also "does not believe that the Palestinians are eligible to be admitted as a U.N. member-state."

"The Palestinians are not a U.N. member-state or any state at all. The United States will continually point that out in our remarks at U.N. events led by the Palestinians," Haley said.

"Today's U.N. mistake undermines the prospects for peace by encouraging the illusion held by some Palestinian leaders that they can advance their goals without direct peace negotiations. In fact, today's vote does nothing to help the Palestinian people."

Gillian Bird, the ambassador of Australia—the only other country to vote against the measure—said afterwards the vote reflected her government's "longstanding position that Palestinian attempts to seek recognition as a state in international fora are deeply unhelpful to efforts towards a two-state solution."

Australia's decision to oppose the measure was signaled in an earlier statement by new Prime Minister Scott Morrison, who said it "seeks to confer an official status on the Palestinian Authority it does not have, and therefore has the potential to undermine efforts to bring parties together to work towards a peaceful settlement."

Morrison in the same statement said his government would examine the question of moving Australia's embassy from Tel Aviv to Jerusalem.

Should Australia take the step, it would be only the second country to follow Trump's lead, after Guatemala moved its embassy to Israel's capital two days after the U.S. Embassy move. (Paraguay also did so, but a new government reversed the decision last month.)

An article by Bhuvan Bagga titled "Clashes As Hindu Hardliners Block Women From Indian Temple" was posted at yahoo.com on Oct. 17, 2018. Following are excerpts of the article.

Clashes erupted on Wednesday as Hindu hardliners prevented women visiting one of India's most sacred temples, with baton-waving police charging stone-throwing protesters.

Ugly scenes erupted as mobs surrounded and attacked the cars of female journalists. Other reporters including a female AFP journalist were intimidated.

The situation remained tense after nightfall, with police reinforcing the 500 officers already present ahead of likely another dramatic day on Thursday on the road to the Lord Ayyappa temple at Sabarimala.

Last month India's Supreme Court overturned a ban on females of menstruating age—judged between 10 and 50 years—entering and praying at the hilltop temple in the southern state of Kerala.

This enraged traditionalists, including supporters of Prime Minister Narendra Modi's Hindu nationalist Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP), with thousands protesting in the days before the scheduled opening on Wednesday afternoon.

Kerala's state government insisted it would enforce the court ruling and ensure free access to the remote complex, reached by an uphill trek that takes several hours.

At Nilackal, a base camp below the temple, police cleared protesters early Wednesday morning and arrested seven people who were stopping vehicles.

"Stern action will be taken against anyone who prevents devotees from going to Sabarimala," Kerala's Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan said on Tuesday.

But later police struggled to control the situation, fighting running battles that left five devotees and 15 policemen injured, according to EP Jayarajan, a minister in the Kerala government.

News channels CNN News 18 and Republic TV both showed footage of their reporters' cars being vandalised. Online publication The News Minute said its reporter was kicked in the spine.

One 45-year old woman identified as Madhavi who wanted to enter the temple abandoned her attempt after activists prevented her climbing the hill, the Press Trust of India reported.

Even though police gave the woman and her family protection and allowed them to move further, they gave up as irate activists surrounded them, PTI reported.

Biju S. Pillai, a local man in his 30s, was one of those opposed to the court ruling, telling AFP that he returned from working in Dubai to "protect the sanctity of the templech."

"No one should be able to change the way this temple has functioned for centuries," he said. "If any change is made they will have to kill us and go over our bodies."

"I am here to protest the Supreme Court decision," said engineer Anisha S., 23, one of a group chanting religious slogans. "We want to save our traditions. Ayyappa needs to be respected."

Jayarajan blamed the violence on "goons" from the Rashtriya Swayamsevak Sangh (RSS), a hardline Hindu group seen as close to Modi's BJP, which is an opposition party in Kerala.

Women are permitted to enter most Hindu temples but female devotees are still barred from entry by some.

Two years ago, activists successfully campaigned to end a ban on women entering the Shani Shingnapur temple in Maharashtra state.

Women were also permitted to enter Mumbai's Haji Ali Dargah mausoleum, a Muslim place of worship, after the Supreme Court scrapped a ban in 2016.

The entry of women at Sabarimala was long taboo but was formalised by the Kerala High Court in 1991, a ruling overturned by India's Supreme Court last month.

The restriction reflected an old but still prevalent belief among many that menstruating women are impure, and the fact that the deity Ayyappa was reputed to have been celibate.

The Sabarimala chief priest, Kandararu Maheshwararu Tantri, 25, warned this week that "anger could easily escalate into violence if a few egotistical women try to enter" the temple.

This week, Sen. Elizabeth Warren, D-Mass., in preparation for a 2020 presidential run, decided to fight back against President Trump's brutal nickname for her: Pocahontas. Trump, you'll recall, labeled her Pocahontas because for years she has claimed Native American ancestry.

Not only that, she claimed repeatedly that her mother's Native American ancestry drove her parents to elope after her father's family refused to welcome her mother with open arms thanks to their bigotry.

As it turns out, Warren could never provide any evidence of Native American ancestry—even though she spent years labeling herself Native American while at the University of Pennsylvania Law School as well as Harvard Law School.

On Monday, Warren decided she'd had enough. She released a video of her family members discussing her claims of Native American background. "Native communities have faced discrimination, neglect and violence for generations," Warren intoned. "And Trump can say whatever he wants about me,

but mocking Native Americans or any group in order to try to get at me? That's not what America stands for."

She accompanied that video with her supposed proof of Native American background: an analysis by professor Carlos Bustamante of Stanford University in which he explains that it is possible that Warren had a Native American ancestor anywhere from six to 10 generations ago. That would have made her anywhere from 1/64 to 1/1,024 Native American.

The study was based not on Native American DNA but on Mexican, Peruvian and Colombian DNA.

In fact, not even Cherokees were happy with Warren. In a stunning rebuke, the Cherokee Nation released a statement saying, "Senator Warren is undermining tribal interests with her continued claims of tribal heritage," and that Warren's DNA test "makes a mockery out of DNA tests and its legitimate uses while also dishonoring legitimate tribal governments and their citizens, whose ancestors are well documented and whose heritage is proven."

All of this should have been foreseeable by anyone with half a brain. Falsely claiming you are Native American for years is bad enough. But releasing a study demonstrating that you are 99.9 percent white—and then claiming that such a study justifies your false claims?

What made Warren, an intelligent human being, think such a thing?

Only one simple fact: Warren knows, as everyone in politics knows, that the media will cover for nearly any instance of leftist political manipulation.

They'll cover for Warren fibbing about her ancestry. They'll cover for Texas Senate candidate Beto O'Rourke driving drunk, plowing into a truck and then attempting to flee the scene of the crime.

They'll cover for Arizona Senate candidate Rep. Kyrsten Sinema saying that she didn't care if Americans joined the Taliban (CNN's headline: "Kyrsten Sinema's Anti-War Activist Past Under Scrutiny as She Runs for Senate").

Democrats have the enviable advantage of being able to trot out nearly any story and be given credibility by most of the mainstream media.

Non-Democrats, however, see this game. And every time the media simply parrot Democratic talking points on issues like Warren's ancestry, they undercut their credibility.

Large media institutions have done more than anyone, including President Trump, to destroy their reputations with the American people. Their pathetic behavior over the past few weeks, in the approach to the 2018 elections, shows that they're doubling down on stupid.

Democratic socialist Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez, seeking to represent New York's 14th Congressional District, has called for the abolition of the Electoral College.

Her argument came on the heels of the Senate's confirming Brett Kavanaugh to the Supreme Court. She was lamenting the fact that Chief Justice John Roberts and Justice Samuel Alito, nominated by George W. Bush, and Justices Neil Gorsuch and Kavanaugh, nominated by Donald Trump, were court appointments made by presidents who lost the popular vote but won the Electoral College vote.

Hillary Clinton has long been a critic of the Electoral College. Just recently, she wrote in The Atlantic, "You won't be surprised to hear that I passionately believe it's time to abolish the Electoral College."

Subjecting presidential elections to the popular vote sounds eminently fair to Americans who have been miseducated by public schools and universities.

Worse yet, the call to eliminate the Electoral College reflects an underlying contempt for our Constitution and its protections for personal liberty.

Regarding miseducation, the founder of the Russian Communist Party, Vladimir Lenin, said, "Give me four years to teach the children and the seed I have sown will never be uprooted." His immediate successor, Josef Stalin, added, "Education is a weapon whose effect depends on who holds it in his hands and at whom it is aimed."

A large part of Americans' miseducation is the often heard claim that we are a democracy. The word "democracy" appears nowhere in the two most fundamental documents of our nation—the Declaration of Independence and the U.S. Constitution. In fact, our Constitution—in Article 4, Section 4—guarantees "to every State in this Union a Republican Form of Government."

The Founding Fathers had utter contempt for democracy.

James Madison, in Federalist Paper No. 10, said that in a pure democracy, "there is nothing to check the inducements to sacrifice the weaker party or an obnoxious individual."

At the 1787 Constitutional Convention, Virginia Gov. Edmund Randolph said that "in tracing these evils to their origin, every man had found it in the turbulence and follies of democracy."

John Adams wrote: "Remember Democracy never lasts long. It soon wastes, exhausts and murders itself. There never was a Democracy Yet, that did not commit suicide."

At the Constitutional Convention, Alexander Hamilton said: "We are now forming a republican government. Real liberty" is found not in "the extremes of democracy but in moderate governments . . . If we incline too much to democracy, we shall soon shoot into a monarchy."

For those too dense to understand these arguments, ask yourselves the following questions.

Does the Pledge of Allegiance say "to the democracy for which it stands" or "to the republic for which it stands"?

■ Did Julia Ward Howe make a mistake in titling her Civil War song "Battle Hymn of the Republic"? Should she have titled it "Battle Hymn of the Democracy"?

The Founders saw our nation as being composed of sovereign states that voluntarily sought to join a union under the condition that each state admitted would be coequal with every other state.

The Electoral College method of choosing the president and vice president guarantees that each state, whether large or small in area or population, has some voice in selecting the nation's leaders.

Were we to choose the president and vice president under a popular vote, the outcome of presidential races would always be decided by a few highly populated states. They would be states such as California, Texas, Florida, New York, Illinois and Pennsylvania, which contain 134.3 million people, or 41 percent of our population.

Presidential candidates could safely ignore the interests of the citizens of Wyoming, Alaska, Vermont, North Dakota, South Dakota, Montana and Delaware. Why?

They have only 5.58 million Americans, or 1.7 percent of the U.S. population. We would no longer be a government "of the people"; instead, our government would be put in power by and accountable to the leaders and citizens of a few highly populated states.

Political satirist H.L. Mencken said, "The kind of man who wants the government to adopt and enforce his ideas is always the kind of man whose ideas are idiotic."

His platform, after all, would call for free college tuition, Social Security expansion, paid family leave, Medicaid for all and student debt relief.

The Manhattan Institute projects such a program would run \$42.5 trillion dollars for the first 10 years and then escalate to an additional \$175.5 trillion over the next couple of decades.

Because I know that numbers confuse people, I'll explain that whereas a billion is a thousand million, a trillion is a thousand billion. That should also explain why when leftists talk about taxing billionaires in order to wipe out the national debt, they're merely displaying their usual ignorance.

The national debt today stands at \$21.48 trillion. If you confiscated every dollar, including those they have stuffed in their mattresses and the loose change under their sofa's cushions, the 560 of them would only be able to cough up \$2.8 trillion.

Some people felt that it wasn't fair that Dukakis was smeared because he hadn't initiated the program. A previous governor had. But it was Dukakis who prevented the state legislature from denying furloughs to those serving time for first degree murder, arguing: "It would cut the heart out of inmate rehabilitation."

Only a true left-wing blockhead would have seen any reason to even try to rehabilitate someone who had been sentenced to spend the rest of his life behind bars.
