An article by Tom DiChristopher titled "Saudi Arabia's Massive Oil Reserves Total 268.5 Billion Barrels, Even Bigger Than Previously Known" was posted at cnbc.com on Jan. 9, 2019. Following is the article.

Saudi Arabia's massive oil and gas reserves are even bigger than previously reported, according to an outside assessment commissioned by the kingdom.

The independent audit not only revised Saudi reserves higher, but may help put to rest skepticism over the nation's oil and gas wealth, which has persisted in some corners of the market for years. It also shows national oil giant Saudi Aramco is taking strides towards transparency as it continues to consider a stock market debut.

On Wednesday, Saudi Energy Minister and Aramco Chairman Khalid al-Falih said the kingdom expects the initial public offering for Aramco to take place in 2021, following a delay.

State-controlled Aramco had 263.1 billion barrels of oil waiting to be tapped at the end of 2017, according to Dallas-based petroleum consulting firm DeGolyer and MacNaughton. That is 2.2 billion barrels more than Aramco reported in its last annual review.

Aramco's natural gas reserves total 319.5 trillion cubic feet, according to the audit. The company, which is not a major player in the gas market, previously reported 302.3 trillion cubic feet of gas reserves.

Saudi Arabia has additional reserves in an area along the border with Kuwait that has sat idle due to a dispute between the neighbors. Including this so-called Neutral Zone, Saudi oil reserves total 268.5 billion barrels, DeGolyer and MacNaughton concluded. That compares with an earlier estimate of 266.3 billion barrels.

The Saudis commissioned the audit as part of their plan to publicly list shares of Aramco, the world's largest energy company. The kingdom hoped to attract a \$2 trillion valuation and raise \$100 billion to underwrite Crown Prince Mohammed bin Salman's economic transformation plan, Vision 2030.

The initial public offering has at least temporarily been shelved while Aramco pursues a deal to purchase Saudi petrochemicals company SABIC. Indecision over key aspects of the offering have also caused delays, according to news reports.

Falih, the Saudi energy minister, on Wednesday highlighted what the audit means for Aramco's valuation.

"This certification underscores why every barrel we produce is the most profitable in the world, and why we believe Saudi Aramco is the world's most valuable company and indeed the world's most important," Falih said in a statement.

The revision is "not an insignificant amount of oil," says global energy policy analyst, Ellen Wald. But in her view, the bigger news is that the audit confirms what the Saudis have long communicated to the market: that they control more than 260 billion barrels of reserves.

The figures have long faced skepticism for several reasons. Saudi Arabia has historically eschewed independent audits, and its reserves have remained roughly unchanged for decades despite the Saudis pumping huge amounts of crude.

The 2005 book "Twilight in the Desert," which claimed Saudi production was peaking and oil prices would soon surge, also fueled suspicion, says Wald, the author of "Saudi Inc: The Arabian Kingdom's Pursuit of Profit and Power."

"Whether they have 260 or 266 billion barrels isn't really the issue," she said. "The point is that they had DeGolyer and MacNaughton, which is a very respected source, do an audit."

"I think it's designed to put to rest the controversy that's always plagued them since the publication of 'Twilight in the Desert."

The smirk by Chuck Schumer spoke volumes, and the full-blown identity politicians showing their true colors remind one of Abraham Lincoln's potent lines when on March 4, 1865 he penned the following:

■ "While the inaugural address was being delivered . . . devoted altogether to saving the Union without war, insurgent agents were in the city seeking to destroy it without war—seeking to dissolve the Union and divide effects by negotiation. Both parties deprecated war, but one of them would make war rather than let the nation survive, and the other would accept war rather than let it perish, and the war came."

We are not in a hot civil war at this time, but, as Charles R. Kelser has written, "cold civil war is better than a hot civil war, but it is not a good situation for a country to be in. Underlying our cold civil war is the fact that America is torn increasingly between two rival constitutions, two cultures, two ways of life."

Consider Nikki Randhawa, a Sikh who represented the very best of America when she was the United States ambassador to the United Nations. Most of us know her as Nikki Haley. Her marriage to Michael Haley was a "measure of respect for their individual backgrounds—the colorful Sikh ritual was followed by the Methodist ceremony." Her husband is an officer in the South Carolina National Guard. She was a governor of South Carolina—clearly two proud Americans who serve their country with distinction.

Reflect now on the newly elected Democratic Muslim women who embody the creeping sharia that is enveloping the world. Ilhan Omar (Minnesota) used American immigration law to her advantage by marrying her brother in 2009. The "motivation for the marriage points to possible immigration fraud and student loan fraud. What's more she swore to apparent falsehoods in court."

Tashida Tlaib (Michigan) has vociferously called for the impeachment of Donald Trump. According to Tlaib "President Donald Trump is a direct and serious threat to our country." Tlaib was the Arab-American coordinator for Obama's 2008 campaign in Michigan. In addition, she has ties to the Hamas-linked Council on American-Islamic Relations (CAIR).

Then, "in 2013-14, she received numerous financial donations from individuals affiliated with CAIR, the Islamic Society of North America, the Muslim Students Association (MSA), and the Muslim Public Affairs Council (MPAC)."

Moreover, "in an October 2015 tweet, Tlaib linked to an article in The Nation lauding Black Lives Matter activists in Chicago for supporting 'a Palestinian woman threatened with deportation.' The woman in question was Rasmea Odeh, a Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine terrorist who had played a central role in a deadly 1969 terrorist bombing in Jerusalem, and had committed felonious immigration fraud in the U.S. years later."

Tlaib and Omar have insinuated themselves into American politics. They personify the anti-freedom, Jew-hatred, sharia intolerance that is integral to the tenets of the Quran, the very book that Tlaib rested her hand on when she was sworn in!

Tlaib and Omar are symptomatic of the leftist-Islamic (Red-Green) anti-American connection that keeps gaining traction in the country. The left (Progressives) believe in the notion of a "living Constitution" and work to create "administrative agencies" that circumvent the limitations that the original Constitution set in place.

Hats have "been banned from the House chamber of the Capitol [but] . . . under a new proposal from Democrats, the rule would be relaxed to allow religious headwear, like a hijab[.] The change was proposed jointly by Democratic leader Nancy Pelosi, Incoming Rules Chairman Jim McGovern and member-elect Ilhan Omar as part of a larger overhaul package."

Leftists—now known as the Democratic Party—count on people's ignorance of what these two women actually believe and want to enact. It is how Americans will be duped.

The Muslim Brotherhood has made the Islamic cause abundantly clear. Consequently, America is in the throes of "an even more toxic danger than jihad warfare—a stealthy and pre-violent form of warfare aimed at destroying our constitutional form of democratic government and free society.

But "unfortunately, many in the Western media have been acceding to such demands, either because they agree that being critical of radical Muslims constitutes 'Islamophobia,' or out of fear of being accused of it. The social media giant, Facebook, for example, often uses a selective definition of 'hate speech' to justify censoring certain pages and posts."

Once again, the left partners with the Islamic world to effectively criminalize the most cherished of American freedoms: the freedom of speech and press.

Connecting the dots, remember that Tlaib has cultivated noteworthy ties to a number of Islamist organizations such as the Hamas-linked Council on American Islamic Relations, praising its "invaluable and vital advocacy."

Who would be so naïve as to think she does not advocate the silencing of critics?

In Gaza (emphasis mine), "the freedom of expression is unacceptable . . . as Hamas intimidates and imprisons writers." Now recall that "in 2015, Tlaib noted approvingly that the head of Islamic Relief USA—a branch of Islamic Relief Worldwide, . . . designated as a terrorist organization by the United Arab Emirates—had come to Detroit to discuss 'water relief from Gaza to Detroit."

Brigitte Gabriel, speaking of Muslim Saba Ahmed, who ran for Congress in 2012, stated, "We must recognize figures like Ahmed for what they are: Islamists who spout patriotic platitudes, but who justify acts of Islamic terrorism, and whose intent is nothing less than a worldwide caliphate that would undo America from within, with Sharia formally established as the standard for Muslims."

An aide for Sen. Elizabeth Warren (D-MA), the latest prominent Democrat to announce plans to form a presidential exploratory committee, says Warren supports Rep. Alexandria Ocasio-Cortez's (D-NY) "Green New Deal," further elevating the status of the plan at the highest levels of the Democratic Party.

In expressing her support for the plan, Warren joins Sens. Bernie Sanders (D-VT) and Cory Booker (D-NJ), both of whom have expressed interest in running for president in 2020.

The Green New Deal has been hailed by Democrats and liberal pundits as one of the most important proposals to tackle global warming in decades, but don't be fooled.

- Many supporters of the Green New Deal know it will do absolutely nothing to reduce global temperature or prevent future temperature rises—the primary purpose of the proposal, according to Ocasio-Cortez.
- The real goal of the Green New Deal is to impose a series of radical, socialistic programs—policies that would dramatically increase the size and power of the federal government, cause immense harm to the U.S. economy, and run up the national debt by trillions of dollars.

In a proposed draft resolution to form a House committee to create legislation for the Green New Deal, Ocasio-Cortez provided important details for her plan.

- One of the most important elements of the plan is a mandated transition away from fossil fuels in virtually all aspects of American life and the creation of a huge new renewable energy industry.
- Ocasio-Cortez proposes ending the use of fossil fuels in nearly every industry, including on farms and in all manufacturing, in just 10 years, from 2020 to 2030.
- Additionally, all power in the United States would need to be produced using renewables, which have been proven on countless occasions to increase the cost of electricity.

Ocasio-Cortez doesn't stop there, however. In addition to forcing everyone to use renewable energy, thereby closing entire existing energy industries and taking away the jobs of tens of thousands of people, she also proposes "upgrading" every single home and business building in the country, to make them more energy efficient and for "comfort," a policy that would likely cost trillions of dollars on its own.

- Ocasio-Cortez says the Green New Deal would create a federal jobs guarantee that would "assure a living wage job to every person who wants one," as well as a single-payer health care program that would put the federal government in charge of the entire health care industry—a plan the Mercatus Center says will cost at least \$32 trillion in its first 10 years.
- The Green New Deal would also form "basic income programs" and impose all sorts of new workplace requirements, including new "wage standards."

Ocasio-Cortez wants the federal government to lead the charge in this effort, but she also says the legislation should "deeply involve national and local labor unions to take a leadership role in the process of job training and worker deployment."

How would the government pay for these multiple trillion-dollar programs? By raising taxes and, most importantly, printing money.

According to the Green New Deal's own "Frequently Asked Questions" section (in Ocasio-Cortez's draft resolution), "Many will say, 'Massive government investment! How in the world can we pay for this?' The answer is: in the same ways that we paid for the 2008 bank bailout and extended quantitative easing programs, the same ways we paid for World War II and many other wars. The Federal Reserve can extend credit to power these projects and invest-

ments, new public banks can be created (as in WWII) to extend credit and a combination of various taxation tools (including taxes on carbon and other emissions and progressive wealth taxes) can be employed."

Ocasio-Cortez and other Green New Deal advocates say these proposals are necessary to stop human-caused global warming, but the truth is the Green New Deal would do absolutely nothing to avert future global temperature increases, even if we assume that humans' carbon-dioxide emissions are the primary cause of climate change and that moderately warmer temperatures would create more harm than good.

Both of these assumptions have been challenged by many highly prominent scientists and economists. For more, see The Heartland Institute's Climate Change Reconsidered series.)

The reason the Green New Deal wouldn't have the impact its supporters say it will is because the rest of the world is increasing its CO2 emissions at a rate so high that whatever reductions occur in America would be more than offset by increases in other countries, especially China and India.

- Ocasio-Cortez and others know the Green New Deal won't stop climate change, but this plan isn't really about global warming.
- It's about creating massive new government programs that will increase the power of government and move the country closer than ever to socialism.

Those of us who support free markets and individual liberty must stop the Green New Deal, or else America as we know it will disappear entirely.

Analyzing Mattis

While Warren, Harris, Booker, and Biden are bruited as potential Democratic candidates in 2020, there may be a surprise candidate being groomed right now. Barack Obama's trajectory from the Illinois state Senate to the Oval Office in four years is instructive.

In March of 2000, Obama was a state senator in Illinois, a post he had since 1996 with virtually no political recognition. What he did have is a sterling résumé.

- An eight-year scholarship to Occidental College.
- A transfer into Columbia University.
- A post-college job as a "community organizer."
- Acceptance into Harvard Law School, and editorship of its law review. (The actual academic records remain secret. There is no essay from college and no single article from the law review where he was editor.)

In his first foray for national office, he attempted to unseat popular Illinois representative Bobby Rush (Illinois-District 2) in the 2000 Democratic primary. He lost.

But he gained the interest of David Axelrod, a cunning political strategist.

In 2002, he tested the political waters with a carefully scripted speech opposing the Iraq war, calling it "a dumb war . . . a rash war . . . [a] cynical attempt to shove ideological agendas down our throats."

He was careful to avoid the pratfalls of radical pacifism: "I don't oppose all wars. My grandfather signed up for a war the day after Pearl Harbor was bombed, fought in Patton's army. He saw the dead and dying across the fields of Europe; he heard the stories of fellow troops who first entered Auschwitz and Treblinka. He fought in the name of a larger freedom, part of that arsenal of democracy that triumphed over evil, and he did not fight in vain. I don't oppose all wars."

He often revisited that speech in his campaigns. [Editor's note: Obama repeatedly botched the location of the camp his grandfather—or was it a great uncle?—allegedly helped liberate. It was the Soviets who "first entered" Auschwitz.]

A new opportunity presented itself in 2004, when incumbent Illinois Republican U.S. senator Peter Fitzgerald decided to retire, and Obama entered the primary race for the Democrats. His only real challenger was Blair Hull, a businessman and philanthropist.

David Axelrod's former employer, the *Chicago Tribune*, leaked a court-sealed divorce story that Hull's wife had sought an order of protection against him. Hull's campaign tanked, and Obama won.

That summer, he was chosen to give a keynote speech in support of the presidential candidacy of John Kerry and John Edwards on July 27, 2004.

It was a pedestrian speech: "There's not a black America and white America and Latino America and Asian America; there's the United States of America. The pundits, the pundits like to slice and dice our country into red states and blue states: red states for Republicans, blue states for Democrats. But I've got news for them, too. We worship an awesome God in the blue states, and we don't like federal agents poking around our libraries in the red states. We coach little league in the blue states and, yes, we've got some gay friends in the red states."

It was a speech of platitudes, but the prime-time messenger was an articulate young black American state senator from Illinois, and the audience and media swooned. A star was born. He was ready for prime time.

He returned to Chicago to oppose Jack Ryan, the Republican candidate for the Senate seat. Ryan also had a sterling résumé: Dartmouth College, Harvard Law School, and Harvard Business School, and after earning millions on Wall Street, he retired to teach high school in the low-income inner city.

However, Ryan's divorce custody sealed records were leaked by the *Chicago Tribune*, with lurid allegations of sex clubs and infidelity. Ryan denied all allegations, but the media ran with the sordid tale, and Ryan resigned.

Obama easily bested Alan Keyes, who stepped into the campaign to replace Ryan, and became the junior senator from Illinois.

By mid-2006, New York Democratic senator Hillary Clinton had prepared her campaign to make history as America's first female president. Her victory seemed inevitable, but former senator Harry Reid (R-Nev., 1987-2017) had other thoughts and persuaded Barack Obama to enter the primary race for the White House. Obama formally announced his candidacy on February 10, 2007.

The fixers went to work, airbrushing his radical-left proclivities and the mentoring of radical communist Frank Marshall Davis and his association with terrorists and a viciously racist minister, Jeremiah Wright.

Five months later, on June 7, 2008, Obama became the Democratic presidential nominee when Clinton dropped out of the race. In the final count, he garnered 2,275 delegates, and Clinton had 1,978.

His challenger was Republican senator John McCain, who led in early polls, but on September 28, 2008, the Dow Jones Industrial Average fell 777.68 points in one day. Until 2018, it was the largest one-day point drop in history.

It was not (repeat, not) orchestrated by David Axelrod, who had been busy trying to find damning evidence on John McCain and Sarah Palin.

Six weeks later, Barack Obama became America's first black president, with Senator Joseph Biden as his vice president. He won 365 delegates and 69,456,89 popular votes.

How did a man of such meager achievements win the highest office in the land in four years?

One short answer is that he was carefully groomed with a carefully scripted biographical narrative that was in the works long before his announcement in 2007.
