This quote came during an interview on CNN with Mr. Deese after President Biden responded that the American people would have to endure the exorbitantly high fuel prices as long as the conflagration in Ukraine continues.

As the Mayor of Philadelphia asserted, only police should possess firearms. How well did that work out for the helpless children in Uvalde Texas?

The liberal world order is a collection of delusional ideas and policies intent on tearing down the fabric of a civil society. It advances insidious open borders policy that enables a drug, sex, and human trafficking epidemic. It promotes the idea that men can get pregnant and biological males should compete against females...hence ending the achievements of Title IX.

The liberal world order would rather not teach our children reading, writing, math, and science, but about drag queens and gender modification procedures and hormonal therapies.

And most diabolical, is the liberal world order's insatiable thirst for murdering unborn babies.

Vice President Kamala Harris released another volley of pro-abortion platitudes over the weekend, suggesting that the preborn are not "real human beings" and claiming that supporting the legal power to have them killed is fully compatible with religious faith.

Speaking Saturday at a gathering of Democrat lawmakers in Philadelphia, Harris invoked "public recent stories about what [the overturn of *Roe v. Wade*] means to real people, real human beings," a reference to the case in Ohio of a pregnant 10-year-old raped by her mother's illegal-immigrant boyfriend. "Not to mention the stories that have not been told and have yet to be told."

On Monday, Harris addressed the NAACP National Convention, where she claimed that "to support a woman's ability, not her government but her, to make that decision does not require anyone to abandon their faith or their beliefs. It just requires us to agree the government shouldn't be making that decision for her."

There, Harris also compared the banning of abortion to slavery: "we know, NAACP, that our country has a history of claiming ownership over human bodies."

In fact, long-settled biological criteria and mainstream medical textbooks establish that a living human being, structurally and genetically distinct from his or her mother, is created upon fertilization and is present throughout the entirety of pregnancy.

This is not in serious dispute; in 2019, University of Chicago Department of Comparative Human Development graduate Steve Jacobs found that 96% of more than 5,500 biologists he surveyed agreed, despite overwhelmingly identifying as "liberal," "pro-choice," and Democrats, and a majority identifying as "non-religious."

As for abortion's alleged compatibility with religion, there is a fundamental difference between sins of an individual nature, i.e. falling short of a religion's moral standards for how to live one's life, and evils of the sort that inflict harm—in the case of abortion, death—on someone else.

The Bible repeatedly condemns "murder" and "shed[ding] innocent blood" as "detestable to" the Lord, because "in the image of God has God made mankind."

Regarding the vice president's invocation of slavery, the opposite is the case; in fact, the parallels between legal abortion and legal slavery extend well beyond the obvious.

- Both denied the equality and humanity of an entire class of people in order to violate their fundamental rights (slaves on the basis of race; the preborn on the basis of developmental stage).
- Both were sustained by intensely controversial Supreme Court rulings (*Roe*; *Dred Scott v. Sandford*).
- Both even rested on similar arguments about personal freedom, America's founding principles, and human progress.

Roe v. Wade's' overturn sparked the activation of numerous pre-Roe abortion bans that had gone unenforced for decades, as well as more recent pro-life laws that had been blocked by courts, and trigger laws designed not to take effect until Roe was reversed.

Across the country, abortion giant Planned Parenthood has suspended abortions and/or closed locations in reaction to the ruling, and pro-life attorneys general have declared their intentions to enforce their states' duly-enacted abortion prohibitions.

But leftists prosecutors in dozens of localities have vowed not to enforce such laws, ensuring that work and debate will continue over the prospect of banning abortion nationally.

Pro-abortion activists' emphasis on supporting interstate travel for abortion also presents a challenge to pro-life policymakers, though groups such as the Thomas More Society and National Association of Christian Lawmakers are currently exploring potential solutions.

President Joe Biden has called for electing more Democrats to Congress to support codifying a "right" to abortion-on-demand in federal law.

What do you call an economic system where a relative few individuals own all the land and most of the people who live on that land do so at the sufferance of the landowner?

It's feudalism.

This was the economic system in most of Europe during the Middle Ages. The vast majority of the population was born into, lived and died in poverty. There was little hope for upward mobility unless one opted for a career in military service or the clergy. (From time to time, extraordinarily pretty peasant girls might be married off to a lesser lord.)

The rise of mercantilism and the guild system in northern Europe brought major changes to European feudalism. Poor youth could be apprenticed to merchants and artisans where they learned a skill and a trade. After a time, apprentices could establish shops of their own. This system eventually created a middle class, and the economic power achieved by the guilds and their members soon translated to political power as well.

Russia, however, lagged hundreds of years behind the rest of Europe. Tsar Alexander II finally freed the country's serfs in 1861, when the rest of the world had already entered the Industrial Revolution.

The same wealthy Russians who had owned the farms soon owned the factories. The Russian poor went from being feudal peasants on rich farmland to half-starved factory workers in city tenements.

Despair and hopelessness created by centuries of exploitation laid the groundwork for the appeal of Karl Marx's writings. Russia's failure to include its poorest citizens in the advances of industrialization was among the driving forces behind the revolutions that would thrust Russia into communism for the next 70-plus years.

America's trajectory has been quite different.

- Our country was founded by men of faith with knowledge of history, politics and economics. We rejected monarchy and nobility.
- Our founding documents incorporate principles of universal human dignity and individual rights that not only formed the basis for a republican government elected by the people but also supported the notion of free enterprise.

Unlike Russia (and plenty of other countries) where capitalism and the means of production have been controlled by a small group of wealthy people who use their political power to limit access to others, the United States has had a system of *entrepreneurial* capitalism. Anyone—even noncitizens—could come here and start their own business. And millions have.

- America's system of entrepreneurial capitalism has been the breeding ground for the American Dream.
- It has done for this country what the guild system did for northern Europe, and then some.
- It has spawned unprecedented innovation, facilitated the creation and distribution of wealth, transformed the law of business enterprise and the widespread use of corporations, made investment and ownership of property and land accessible to the average person, and launched America's middle, upper-middle and even upper classes.

One would think that this extraordinarily successful system would be sought to be replicated around the globe. But that is not what appears to be happening.

Instead, we have a new class of globalist elites who believe that *they* should control the planet and the lives of everyone on it.

Economically secure and politically independent people are difficult to control, so we find ourselves in a situation where our economic security and our political independence are being threatened by those who have made their fortunes in the system they now seek to undermine.

There is no security without food. Global efforts to control farmland and farming, therefore, are creating worldwide worries.

Protests have erupted in the Netherlands in response to "green" regulations to reduce nitrogen emissions, which come mostly from farmers, by half.

(Similar regulations imposed in Sri Lanka destroyed that country's agricultural output and its economy.)

The Dutch government has stated that "there (will not be) a future for all farmers" to continue to operate, and EU politicians are calling for a certain percentage of farms to be closed or sold. "Solidarity" protests are now taking place in Germany, Poland, Italy and Spain.

China owns more than \$2 billion in U.S. farmland. Microsoft founder and billionaire Bill Gates is now the largest private owner of farmland in the United States, with more than 270,000 acres. Just this month, he acquired another 2,100 acres of farmland in North Dakota. The purchase was originally blocked, but the state's attorney general ultimately permitted the sale to go through because the farmland "will be leased back to farmers."

Owning land is quite different from leasing it. A lease is just a contract. Contract terms can be changed. And contracts can be breached, at which point the nonbreaching party must bring a lawsuit for enforcement—assuming that he or she can even afford to do so. Imagine a tenant farmer going up against the attorneys Gates can afford to pay.

In other words, you're on the land at the sufferance of the landowner. Sound familiar?

Gates is an active member of the World Economic Forum and a zealous advocate of their so-called green policies to avert "climate change" disasters. Gates is pushing for wealthy countries to move to eating "synthetic meat." (And he is, unsurprisingly, a major investor in the companies that would produce it.)

Of course, if plastibeef isn't your thing, his climate change compadres insist that we eat bugs. And this is without mentioning the push to end private ownership of cars and suburbs with their single-family homes and green yards, forcing the public into densely populated concrete high-rises and onto public transportation.

But will Gates & Co. live this way? You're joking. They'll still have their multiple homes, their yachts, their chauffeured limousines, private jets and their meals of Wagyu beef. They will be able to afford everything because they will *own* everything.

Don't take my word for it.

In 2016, the WEF posted a video on Facebook and Twitter, titled "8 Predictions for 2030." The video states, "You'll own nothing and you'll be happy. Whatever you want, you'll rent, and it will be delivered by a drone."

Translation: "We'll own everything, and you'll be a serf."

'Secretary Kerry travels commercially or via military air in his role as Special Presidential Envoy for Climate,' the spokesperson added. Kerry's family jet, a Gulfstream GIV-SP, has made a total of 48 trips lasting more than 60 hours and emitted an estimated 715,886 pounds, or 325 metric tons, of carbon since President Biden was sworn into office, according to federal data obtained by Fox News Digital via FlightAware. The plane belongs to Flying Squirrel LLC., a charter company owned by Kerry's wife Teresa Heinz-Kerry and in which Kerry reported owning a more than \$1 million stake on his most recent financial disclosure."

Fox News interviewed Daniel Turner, executive director of Power the Future about Kerry's rhetoric and behavior.

"The problem with folks like John Kerry and the climate hypocrites who run the green movement is that they want to use the coercive power of government," Daniel Turner, executive director of Power the Future, told Fox News Digital in an interview.

If you skim the front pages of major corporate news outlets, you'll find no mention of the economic protests raging in Spain, Morocco, Greece, and the United Kingdom.

Corporate media has largely glossed over the tens of thousands of farmers in the Netherlands who clogged up roadways and distributions centers by holding Canadian-trucker-convoy-style demonstrations to protest radical climate policies.

According to the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace, which records protests worldwide, 11 countries are currently seeing protests of more than 1,000 people in response to the rising cost of living and other economic woes in 2022. As of July 5, Carnegie listed the following number of protests.

- France—120,000 people
- Spain—100,000
- Greece—10,000
- Kazakhstan—10,000
- Sri Lanka—10,000
- India—10,000
- Iran—5,000
- Peru—5,000
- Argentina—1,000
- Morocco—1,000
- U.K.—1,000

Of these 11 countries, only four made any major headlines. The corporate press oftentimes only highlights these economic protests when they get so loud they can no longer be ignored, as we saw with Kazakhstan's kill order to quell protests and the Sri Lankans' attack on their president's home.

Over the weekend, the biased media finally began covering the Sri Lanka protests that are over 10,000 people strong – but only because footage of demonstrators swarming the president's residence by the thousands on Saturday went viral.

The corporate media only highlight those world protests when they grow too big to ignore or when facts can be skewed toward their preferring narratives.

Cherry-picking which protests to highlight gives media cover to paint them as isolated incidents in non-Western countries--instead of a worldwide trend showing the consequences of embracing left-wing policies.

After all, Biden is making the same blunders in the United States, and corporate media can't have Americans connecting those dots.

"Recently, The Lancet published a study on the effectiveness of covid-19 vaccines and the waning of immunity with time. The study showed that immune function among vaccinated individuals 8 months after the administration of two doses of covid-19 vaccine was lower than that among the unvaccinated individuals. According to European Medicines Agency recommendations, frequent covid-19 booster shots could adversely affect the immune response and may not be feasible," the National Institutes of Health published in response to the study.

"The decrease in immunity can be caused by several factors such as N1-methyl-pseudouridine, the spike protein, lipid nanoparticles, antibody-dependent enhancement, and the original antigenic stimulus. These clinical alterations may explain the association reported between covid-19 vaccination and shingles. As a safety measure, further booster vaccinations should be discontinued," an NIH summary of the study continues.

Organ damage, especially among immunocompromised individuals, is also a concern.

"As the covid-19 pandemic becomes better controlled, vaccine sequelae are likely to become more apparent. It has been hypothesized that there will be an increase in cardiovascular diseases, especially acute coronary syndromes, caused by the spike proteins in genetic vaccines," an assessment in the NIH National Library of Medicine states. "Besides the risk of infections owing to lowered immune functions, there is a possible risk of unknown organ damage caused by the vaccine that has remained hidden without apparent clinical presentations, mainly in the circulatory system."

Last year the Biden administration, under advisement from Dr. Anthony Fauci and CDC Director Rochelle Walensky, engaged in a government wide campaign urging Americans to obtain a booster shot.
