Same old, Same old: Target Trump

At the White House Correspondents’ Dinner, President Donald Trump was the target of yet a third assassination attempt—this time in full view of the Washington press corps.

The event was presented as a spirited night with Trump. After 11 years of avoiding the predominantly left-wing media event, he decided to revisit the dinner. He anticipated that he would be the object of ridicule inside the hall—and that he might see possible violence outside it.

Indeed, protesters ringed the hotel. In grimly prescient fashion, the usual sort of crowd that night was channeling John Wilkes Booth – sic semper tyrannis – with placards reading “Death to Tyrants.” They again almost got their wish.

All three of the would-be Trump shooters (along with Charlie Kirk’s murderer) fit the predictable profile of arrested-development, deranged leftists. They apparently sought to reify the popular Democrat hatred of Trump and his supporters, thereby imagining themselves entering the pantheon of revolutionary heroes.

So too, not long ago, did the would-be killer of Trump, Austin Tucker Martin, storm Mar-a-Lago in search of the absent president.

This time, the latest assassin, Cole Tomas Allen, left a manifesto repeating the old saw of Trump as “Hitler” and sought to kill the president and his cabinet members. Indeed, his incoherent screed read like a Petri dish of all the supposed sins of Trump.

- Lawfare myths
- Epstein files

Allen’s attempt was another fantasy of mass murdering, not unlike that of former Bernie Sanders campaign volunteer James T. Hodgkinson. He tried to take out Republican congressional leaders—wounding four, including House Republican Majority Whip Steve Scalise—in a baseball game in Washington.

Other than the fact that the shooter nearly reached the doors to the auditorium, the Secret Service performed brilliantly – despite the Democratic effort to shut down the Department of Homeland Security.

Apparently, the Left’s mind-set is that the security of elected officials – Trump especially – and of American citizens is not nearly as important as ensuring that foreign nationals who entered the country illegally are not legally returned to their countries of origin.

Assassins are motivated by all sorts of impulses, but certainly they do not act in a void.

From the trickle-down world of social media, the internet, and street theater, would-be killers absorb elite signals. This messaging becomes especially baleful when celebrities, governors, senators, and politicians amplify the claim that Trump is the following.

- A fascist
- A Nazi
- A monster who is destroying the country
- He must be stopped “by any means necessary.”

Late-night comedians joke about past assassinations or assassination attempts; others have even claimed that Trump staged his first assassination attempt—and this one too!

So deep runs their hatred.

For over a decade, the Left has escalated its rhetoric of violence against Trump. Each politico, actor, celebrity, or billionaire seems to vie with the next in imagining new ways to kill or assault him.

Had that sort of rhetoric been directed at former presidents Barack Obama or Joe Biden, it would likely have put many of them in jail.

Count the Ways of Ending Trump?

So, how many ways have our elite leftists dreamed of beating up or murdering Trump?

- Gavin Newsom, Nancy Pelosi, and Robert De Niro all preferred punching him out. The now-infamous Kathy Griffin opted for beheading. So did Marilyn Manson.
- The New York actors of Shakespeare in the Park turned Julius Caesar into Trump and staged his mass stabbing.
- Mickey Rourke fancied clubbing; Snoop Dogg, shooting.
- The late celebrity chef Anthony Bourdain's choice, predictably, was poisoning.
- "Comedian" George Lopez seconded the Iranian idea of a bounty killing. Pearl Jam offered the macabre vision of a bald eagle feeding on Trump's corpse.
- Larry Wilmore dreamed of suffocating Trump.
- Do we remember Moby and Madonna, who opted for blowing up Trump?
- Rosie O'Donnell tried to be original by envisioning Trump being thrown off a cliff.
- Johnny Depp joked about a John Wilkes Booth-style Trump assassination.
- Epstein friend and billionaire Reid Hoffman preened, "Yeah, I wish I had made him an actual martyr."
- Do we recall Biden's boast to his donors: "So, we're done talking about the debate. It's time to put Trump in a bullseye."
- In that regard, he-man Biden simply reverted to his earlier bullyboy boasts: "If we were in high school, I'd take him behind the gym and beat the hell out of him," and "The press always asks me, 'Don't I wish I were debating him? No, I wish we were in high school – I could take him behind the gym. That's what I wish.'"

For all the praise of the Secret Service's quick reaction, there is no excuse for the shooter having pranced into his hotel room with weapons and then meandering through the lobby armed. During the Biden presidency, the Secret Service was derelict in the first two close-call Trump assassination attempts.

Do we even remember that Biden denied Secret Service protection to candidate Robert Kennedy Jr. out of pique that his original Democrat challenger might weaken him and help put Trump back in the White House?

In 2024, January 6 Committee Rep. Bennie Thompson, D-Miss., crafted a law—ridiculously entitled the “Denying Infinite Security and Government Resources Allocated toward Convicted and Extremely Dishonorable (DISGRACED) Former Protectees Act”—to strip away Secret Service protection for then-former President Trump?

What was Thompson’s wish?

Hitler Trump?

- Do we remember the New Republic cover where Trump was photo-shopped as Adolf Hitler?
- When called out, The New Republic doubled down, offering no apologies for its sick messaging: “Today, we at The New Republic think we can spend this election year in one of two ways. We can spend it debating whether Trump meets the nine or 17 points that define fascism. Or we can spend it saying, ‘He’s damn close enough, and we’d better fight.’ ”

And so you encourage fellow leftist comrades like Cole Tomas Allen, Ryan Wesley Routh, and Thomas Matthew Crooks to “fight” – to eliminate your Trump-Hitler, allegedly another mass murderer of six million.

- The now media-orphaned Joy Reid repeatedly and ad nauseam invoked Trump-Hitler memes: “Then let me know who I got to vote for to keep Hitler out of the White House.” Rachel Maddow sermonized that she was studying Hitler in order to understand Trump.
- Those who tried to kill Trump – and murdered Charlie Kirk – likely assumed they would eventually be canonized for ending the “Nazi” threat.
- Indeed, Trump is now the only U.S. president in history to be the target of three assassination attempts involving gunfire – with more than two years to go in his tenure as a target.
- Since the Trump inauguration, ritualized left-wing street violence has become the norm – torching Tesla dealerships and cars, swarming ICE officers and facilities, and violent campus demonstrations on behalf of Hamas, usually characterized by overt antisemitic rhetoric and harassment of Jews.
- ICE officers are routinely attacked, pelted with rocks and bottles, and doxxed – the street-level version of the Democrat-elected officials who slander them as Nazis and fascists and

promise to arrest them for the crime of enforcing federal immigration law, deliberately undermined by the Biden administration.

Piker Sickness

- The latest left-wing heartthrob podcaster (the affluent Hasan Piker) just gave a gushing interview to affluent New York Times reporter Nadja Spiegelman and affluent New Yorker writer Jia Tolentino. The two adoringly nodded as Piker matter-of-factly declared it was perfectly fine to rob stores – and anyone and anything that he arbitrarily defined as part of the oppressor class. “Yeah, I think it’s cool. We gotta get back to cool crimes like that. Bank robberies. Stealing priceless artifacts, things of that nature.” So spoke the multimillionaire Piker.
- More disturbingly, Piker has more or less suggested that the cold-blooded assassin of UnitedHealthcare CEO Thompson, Brian Luigi Mangione, had understandable cause to kill—under the Marxist defense of “social murder” against purported enemies of the people.
- I mention Piker because, earlier in 2025, at a public event, he referred – with a wink and nod – to killing Trump. Indeed, he declared, “Someone has to do it. See, when I say that, everyone knows exactly what I mean.”
- Of course, they did on cue. His giddy interviewer, Taylor Lorenz, later highlighted Piker’s Trump threat in a video.

The Democrat Addiction

Post facto, House Minority Leader Hakeem Jeffries commendably urged lowering the political temperature. One good way would have been for Jeffries not to have attacked Trump’s prior “Big Beautiful Bill” while posing with a baseball bat.

Or Jeffries might have politely advised congressional Democrat women not to cut a “Choose Your Fighter” video in which they shadowbox and throw punches to stop Trump. Or he might have advised his Democrat colleagues, such as Hillary Clinton, Kamala Harris, Tim Walz, Bernie Sanders, and Jasmine Crockett, to stop smearing Trump as a fascist.

- For years, we were lectured by the Left that “words matter,” in defense of their efforts to censor “misinformation,” “disinformation,” and “hurtful language.”
- But all that now appears to be abject projection, since it is the Left’s verbiage that has lowered the bar on the violence and encouraged killers to come out of the shadows to save us from supposed “fascists” and “Hitler” types.
- Do we also recall the would-be assassin Nicholas John Roske, who was planning to kill Justice Brett Kavanaugh, the perennial target of hysterical left-wing attacks?

- Left-wing protestors had also crowded the homes of conservative Supreme Court justices — a felony.
- Not long ago, Minnesota governor and former vice-presidential candidate Tim Walz flew, in a time of war, to address a socialist, anti-American audience of Trump haters in Barcelona. Once there, Walz trashed Trump as a fascist— for the sixth time.
- On two occasions, Walz’s running mate Kamala Harris referred to Trump as a fascist – this from Harris, who, in 2020, live on television and in the midst of the George Floyd riots in Washington, encouraged the demonstrations by saying, “They’re not gonna stop, and everyone beware, because they’re not gonna stop . . . They’re not gonna stop before Election Day in November, and they’re not gonna stop after Election Day . . . Everyone should take note of that, on both levels, that they’re not going to let up—and they should not. And we should not.”

And they never did stop, Kamala.

- In the last 22 months, Trump has survived three assassination attempts. At the present rate, sadly, we should expect another three or four efforts before he leaves office.

Why?

Easier than an actual agenda

The hardcore left-wing establishment believes this sort of Hitler/Trump rhetoric, combined with the normalization of street violence, generates ever more protests, fuels anti-ICE fury, unites congressional Democrats, and – most importantly – drives down Trump poll numbers. In their view, it is a lot more effective than merely outlining an alternative agenda.

So expect far more, not less, of this left-wing violent madness to come.

The ranks of would-be presidential assassins are a cavalcade of losers, yet the latest shooter who set out to murder President Donald Trump — the man who opened fire at the White House Correspondents Dinner on Sunday — turns out to have an elite educational background.

Cole Allen is a graduate of CalTech, the prestigious California Institute of Technology.

In the most recent City Journal college rankings, CalTech took the top spot for “value added to career,” but languished at a dismal 95th place for “student ideological diversity.”

The rankings noted the school’s “disproportionately large Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion bureaucracy” — with “roughly ten DEI staff members per 1,000 students” — and its “overwhelmingly liberal” student body, “16 liberal students for every conservative.”

Even by the sagging standards of 21st-century American universities, CalTech is politically monolithic, but is that enough to radicalize someone like Cole?

Unfortunately, recent studies suggest our institutions of higher ed actually increase their students’ acceptance of political violence.

Some 23% of Americans with a high-school diploma or less endorse the statement “Violence is often necessary to create social change,” according to the Skeptic Research Center’s 2025 American Political Perspective Survey.

- After four years of college, the proportion who find political violence “often necessary” rises to 26%.
- But then the numbers explode — among those holding graduate or professional degrees, fully 40% agree political violence is “often” required for “social change” to occur.

Cole earned a master’s degree at California State University, Dominguez Hills, just last year.

His murder manifesto makes his political objectives perfectly clear — he intended to bring about social change through violence: “Administration officials . . . are targets, prioritized from highest-ranking to lowest.”

His colleges taught him everything from engineering to self-expression, but didn’t teach him that slaughtering elected officials is wrong.

In a republic like the United States, political violence is not “often necessary,” and even during the American Revolution, the point was precisely that we didn’t have representation: Faced with British force and denied their traditional rights as English subjects, Americans took up arms as a last resort. Once independence was won, Americans worked to put an end to political violence — and when it did break out, in Shays’ Rebellion or the Whiskey Rebellion, the armed mobs found the American people, as well as the forces of law, solidly against them.

It’s true that Thomas Jefferson sympathized with the bloody French Revolution, but he learned a painful lesson as what purported to be a violent uprising for liberty wound up paving the way to Napoleon’s dictatorship.

As for the change that assassins can bring about, any college graduate ought to know what the slaying of Austrian Archduke Franz Ferdinand in 1914 accomplished.

That political murder directly gave us World War I and set in motion a series of conflicts and revolutions that led to World War II as well.

By coincidence, the night before the White House Correspondents' Dinner, I saw a production of Stephen Sondheim's "Assassins" in a small town outside Washington, DC.

The controversial musical, first staged off-Broadway in 1990, showcases the insanity and vanity of presidential assassins, successful and not, from John Wilkes Booth to John Hinckley.

They're a tragically recurrent feature of American politics — and if we're not on our guard, we're sure to get more of them.

That makes the inability, or unwillingness, of our colleges and universities to teach the bitter truth about political violence a dereliction of civic duty, and of basic human decency.

Young men like Cole Allen shouldn't emerge from years of "liberal" education more ready to accept, or commit, political violence.

Yet the effect of higher education is now the opposite of what it should be, moving graduates, and especially graduate students, in the direction of radicalism.

The effects aren't always as dramatic as Allen's murder attempt, but they're pervasive, and they also include the rising tolerance at The New York Times and other left-of-center outlets for the criminal activity promoted by progressive online influencers like Hasan Piker.

For now, the likes of Piker rant like revolutionaries while making political excuses for property crimes.

But if stealing is acceptable in response to a supposedly wicked capitalist, racist American system, it won't be long before classrooms and opinion pages start filling up with rationalizations for those, like Cole Allen and Luigi Mangione, who employ personal violence in the name of fighting the system.

This moral rot should be arrested, not promoted, by higher education.

It's not enough if CalTech doesn't radicalize a Cole Allen.

Our schools and universities, privileged as they are by taxpayers' dollars, should deradicalize them — and teach them to do good, not violence, to their country and countrymen.

But there’s no doubt China is actively working to magnify social, political and racial divisions in this country and does so in part by seeding psychologically manipulative narratives through social media influence operations. What better venue than the Trump-deranged niche asylum of Blue Sky?

You just have to look at peer-reviewed analysis by Rutgers University of Chinese manipulation on TikTok to see how determined the influence operations are.

So when we look for overseas influences on the left-wing young men who have become assassins, or aspired to murder conservative bogeymen, we shouldn’t ignore the malign foreign operations on the gaming platforms and social media networks they use.

Which brings us to another troubling point: the danger of President Trump traveling to China next month. Optically, it’s a win for President Xi, with Trump the biggest prize in a conga line of world leaders paying their respects to the Chinese autocrat.

But this is the country that gave us COVID-19, hid the evidence, and got away with it.

Trump is the only obstacle between Xi and world domination. China has every motivation in the world to do our president harm and is clever enough to do it with plausible deniability.

As Dr. Anthony Fauci’s right-hand man, David Morens, was charged this week with conspiracy and destruction of federal records in the COVID-19 cover-up, another scandal over the vaccine was unfolding on Capitol Hill.

According to a new Senate report and congressional testimony on Wednesday, Biden administration health officials deliberately ignored warning signs of possible serious reactions to the COVID-19 vaccine, including heart attacks, strokes, Bell’s palsy and sudden cardiac death.

Within three months of the vaccines being rolled out, in March 2021, red flags were fluttering out of the weekly data dumps from doctors and patients reporting health problems after the shots, according to internal emails and meeting notes provided by the Department of Health and Human Services to Sen. Ron Johnson’s Homeland Security Permanent Subcommittee on Investigations.

But when the FDA’s senior medical officer, Dr. Ana Szarfman, whose job was to monitor the vaccine data for warning signs, repeatedly raised the alarm throughout 2021, she was ignored, and emails show her colleagues tried to stop her from using a newer, more accurate statistical methodology to investigate the data.

Finally, in September 2021, the same month that President Joe Biden announced vaccine mandates for all federal workers and large companies, she was told to “cease and desist” her analysis.

On Sept. 9, 2021, Biden announced his vaccine mandates, with an implied threat to the roughly 80 million Americans who had not taken the COVID jab and whom he accused of prolonging the pandemic and putting everyone at risk, even though the vaccine did not stop transmission of the disease.

“We’ve been patient, but our patience is wearing thin,” Biden said. “And your refusal has cost all of us.”

On Sept. 16, Dr. Peter Marks, a staunch supporter of the COVID-19 vaccines who at the time led the FDA’s Center for Biologics Evaluation and Research, told another senior FDA official in an email that Szarfman (who has since retired) “has been asked to cease and desist, because the strategy that she is using could create erroneous conflicts that feed in to anti-vaccination rhetoric.”

Avoiding email trail

Marks also complained that Szarfman’s work has “become a major distraction.”

The documents uncovered by Johnson’s investigation staff point to the same alarming secrecy and efforts to avoid accountability that landed Fauci’s adviser, Morens, in trouble.

The secrecy included instructions from FDA officials to discuss findings in person rather than over email and stopping or limiting the distribution of the weekly vaccine safety reports with the alleged intent of avoiding FOIA requests.

On March 26, 2021, Szarfman shared with colleagues her analysis of COVID-19 vaccine adverse events using the superior, newer “data mining” methodology that had found more than 20 statistically significant “safety signals” or potential red flags associated with the COVID-19 vaccines that were not previously detected by FDA’s current methodology, “including sudden cardiac death, Bell’s palsy and pulmonary infarction.”

Her analysis was conducted with Dr. William DuMouchel, then the chief statistician at Oracle and the inventor of the data-mining algorithm.

However, “rather than warn the public or hold distribution of the vaccines for further investigation, records appear to indicate that Biden health officials ignored the statistically significant safety signals uncovered through the new methodology and were more concerned about Dr. Szarfman’s efforts rather than her troubling findings,” the interim report found.

In April 2021, after Szarfman emailed colleagues with another data-mining analysis that apparently underscored the limitations of the FDA’s current system, one senior FDA official wrote to his colleagues, “[b]efore we potentially reach out to Ana, we should meet internally — many considerations not suited to email ...”

Szarfman continued to bring her reports to colleagues, but they were ignored.

In August 2021, about a month before Szarfman was directed to “cease and desist,” Dr. David Menschik, a senior FDA colleague of Marks, told a CDC official that the FDA planned to limit

distribution of its weekly vaccine data-mining reports, which used to be sent around the FDA and CDC, citing “data-security reasons.”

But emails among CDC officials uncovered by Johnson’s investigators point to a potentially more nefarious reason for the FDA’s decision to stop distributing its data-mining reports.

In a November 2022 email, one CDC official noted, “I think that because of the FOIAs [Freedom of Information Act requests] we may have asked FDA to stop sending these weekly data-mining outputs.”

The damage was done

According to Johnson’s staff report, “in the months and weeks leading up to the FDA’s decision to discontinue its distribution of the weekly data-mining reports, there were several public requests made to CDC and FDA for that information.

“On May 9, 2022, about two months before the FDA stopped sending CDC its weekly data-mining reports, Children’s Health Defense sent a FOIA request to CDC for the [vaccine] data-mining analyses.

“On June 23, 2022, 19 days before FDA sent its final weekly data mining report, Sen. Johnson wrote to then-CDC Director Dr. Rochelle Walensky requesting the same information.

“Then, on June 30, 2022, 12 days before FDA’s last distribution, the Informed Consent Action Network submitted a FOIA request to FDA for the [vaccine] data-mining records.

“In light of these public and congressional requests, the timing of the FDA’s decision to end the distribution of its weekly data-mining reports seems particularly suspect.

“The notion that Biden health officials took steps to limit the distribution of COVID-19 vaccine safety data in order to avoid more internal review or public scrutiny, it is completely unacceptable.”

Democrats on the subcommittee, like Sen. Richard Blumenthal (D-Conn.), were at pains to point out during the hearing that COVID-19 itself caused serious injury and death, calling as their witness a 41-year-old woman, Maria Young, who was hospitalized for two months and almost died in the months before the vaccines were developed.

Of the 8 billion vaccine doses administered worldwide, multiple large studies suggest there has been no increase in long-term mortality among vaccinated people.

However, the damage was done by the COVID cover-up and lies.

They have driven widespread distrust of vaccination, including tried-and-true lifesaving vaccines.
