	David was chosen to be king
1 Sam. 16:1 5 10-11 12-13 14-23	the Lord told Samuel that He would provide a king from the sons of Jesse Jesse and his sons were consecrated – invited to a sacrifice Jesse made 7 of his sons pass before Samuel – before bringing youngest Samuel anointed David – in midst of his brothers Saul was troubled by a distressing spirit "from the Lord" – skillful harp
	David battled Goliath
1 Sam. 17:1-16	when the Israelits and the Philistines gathered for battle, a champion soldier (Goliath) challenged the Israelites for 40 days to produce a warrior
26	"who is this uncircumcised Philistine, that he should defy the armies of the living God?"
33-37 51	David convinced Saul – to let him challenge Goliath when the Philistines saw that their champion was dead – they fled
	Saul became jealous
1 Sam. 18:5 6-9	Saul set David over the men of war women celebrating David – jealous Saul was very angry
	Saul threw a spear at David
