Tonight – I want focus again on the concept – "Do Not under-estimate the enemy"

·	As we begin – Let me put your mind at ease Although we are definitely going to warn about the power of the enemy – "The God of good is stronger than the enemy of evil"
Matt. 18:10	take heed that you do not despise one of these little ones – for I say to you that in heaven, their angels always see the face of My Father who is in heaven
Rev. 20:1-3	an angel puts the devil in the bottomless pit
	Do not under-estimate the enemy  Notice some direct and overt danger
Luke 11:20	finger of God
21	when a strong man (fully armed) guards his own palace, his goods are safe
22	if a stronger man comes along and overcomes him, he takes from him all his armor (and weapons in which he trusted) and divides his spoils
23	not with Me is against Me – does not gather with Me, scatters
24	when an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he wants to return
25-26	when he finds the place cleaned up, he brings 7 back with him – more

slave girl – annoyed Paul and the others

Acts 16:16-17

wicked than himself – last state of that man is worse than the first

18	Paul dealt with it
19-24	the business people – took them to the magistrates
Acts 19:11	God worked unusual miracles by the hands of Paul
12	diseased left them – evil spirits went out of them
13	the itinerant Jewish exorcists took it upon themselves – "by the Jesus
	whom Paul preaches"
14	7 sons of Sceva (a Jewish chief priest, who did so)
15	"Jesus I know and Paul I know; but who are you?"
16	spirit overpowered them and prevailed against them – they fled out of the
	house naked and wounded
17	when this became known to all the Jews and Greeks dwelling in Ephesus –
	fear fell on them all – & the name of the Lord Jesus was magnified
18	and many people who had believed – came, confessing their deeds
19	many who practiced magic – brought their books together and burned
	them in the sight of all – they counted up the value of them, and it
	totaled 50,000 pieces of silver

	the Son of God reiterated humility & service
	As we conclude – Let me <b>again</b> put your mind at ease

Luke 22:31	Satan has asked for you – that he may sift you as wheat
32	"I have prayed for you"
1 Cor. 15:24-28	the Son of God will put an end to all rule, all authority & all power
