| Gen. 3:15 | the Lord God said – to the serpent <ul style="list-style-type: none">“I will put enmity between you and the woman”“I will put enmity between your seed and her seed”“Her seed shall bruise your head”“Your seed shall bruise His heel” |
| Isaiah 45:5-7 | I am the Lord |
| Dan. 10:13 | “prince of Persia withstood me for 21 days” – Michael helped me |
| 20 | I must return to fight with the prince of Persia – and then, the prince of Greece will come |
| Gen. 50:20 | “you meant evil against me, but God meant it for good” – in order to bring it about to save many people alive |
| Exod. 4:21 | I will harden his heart, so that he will not let you go |
| 22-23 | you shall tell Pharaoh – Israel is My firstborn – let My son go that he may serve Me – if you refuse, I will kill your firstborn |
| Exod. 14:13-14 | don’t be afraid – the Lord will fight for you, and you shall hold your peace |
| Num. 13:17-20 | check out the land of Canaan |
| 26-29 | their report started positive – drifted toward negative |
| 30 | Caleb (temporarily) quieted the people |
| 31-33 | the people continued to be negative |
| Num. 14:6-9 | Joshua and Caleb – kept their eyes on the promises |
| Deut. 20:1-4 | when you go into battle, the Lord your God will fight for you – to save you |

Deut. 30:15-18	love the Lord your God – walk in His ways
19-20	choose life
Josh. 1:6-7	be strong and of good courage
8	the book of the law
9	the Lord your God is with you wherever you go
1 Sam. 8:4-5	the people wanted a king
6	that displeased Samuel
7-9	the Lord – heed the voice of the people
10-21	the Lord – warn the people
22	Samuel made them a king
2 Kings 6:8	the king of Syria was making war against Israel
15	an army was surrounding the city – “what shall we do?”
16	Elisha prayed – “Lord, open his eyes that he may see”
17	the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha
2 Kings 20:1	King Hezekiah was sick and near death
2-3	Hezekiah prayed
4-6	tell Hezekiah – I will add 15 years
Job 1:12	permission – restrictions
Job 2:6	permission – restrictions
