- For years, the Son of God served people – “relationship” ministry
- Matt. 14:14            He saw a great multitude – He was moved with compassion – He healed their sick
- 15            the disciples – wanted to send them away
- 16            “they don’t need to go away – give them something to eat”
- 17            “we only have 5 loaves and 2 fish”
- 21            5,000 men (not counting women & children)
- Matt. 15:29-31 lame, blind, mute, maimed
- 32            He had compassion, because people were hungry
- 33            disciples – where can we get enough?
- 38            4,000 men (not counting women & children)
- The religious leaders did not like Him
- Matt. 16:21            go to Jerusalem – suffer many things (elders, chief priests & scribes) – be killed – be raised the third day
- John 11:49            Caiaphas (being a high priest that year)
- 50            “you know nothing at all, nor do you consider that it is expedient for us, that one man should die for the people, and not that the whole nation should perish”
- 51-52            he did not say this on his own authority – being high priest that year, he prophesied that Jesus would die for the nation – and not only for that nation, but also that he would gather together the children of God (who were scattered abroad) in one
- 53            from that forward – they plotted to kill Him
- 54            He no longer walked openly among the Jews – wilderness
- 55            the Passover of the Jews was near – many went to Jerusalem to purify themselves
- 56            then, they sought the Son of God – the stood in the temple, “What do you think? Will He come to the feast?”
- 57            the chief priests and the Pharisees had given a command – if anyone knew where He was, they should seize Him
- Final days

John 12:1	6 days before the Passover
3-8	Mary anointed the feet of Jesus
10	the chief priests plotted to put Lazarus to death
12-15	they heard that the Son of God was coming to Jerusalem
19	the Pharisees said – “see, you are accomplishing nothing – look, the world has gone after Him”
20-21	certain Greeks came to worship at the feast – “we, wish to see Jesus”
22	Philip told Andrew – Andrew & Philip told the Son of God
23-36	the Son of God explained what was occurring
42-43	many rulers believed, but did not want to be put out of the synagogue
44-50	the Son of God said

John 13:1	before the Feast of the Passover
2	supper being ended
3-5	He began to wash their feet
6-11	Peter questioned the Son of God
12-17	the Son of God said
