- Quick background

Exod. 1:8 there arose a king who did not know Joseph
 9 “the children of Israel are more and mightier than we are”
 11 “let’s set taskmasters over them to afflict them with burdens”
 13-14 the Egyptians made the children of Israel serve with rigor – hard bondage
Exod. 2:1-2 Moses was born

- God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob

Exod. 3:2 an angel of the Lord appeared to Moses in a flame of fire – middle of bush
 5 “take your sandals off your feet, for the place where you stand is holy
 ground”
 6 “I am the God of your father – the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and
 the God of Jacob”
 7 “I have surely seen the oppression of My people who are in Egypt, and
 have heard their cry because of their taskmasters – for I know their
 sorrows”
 8 “I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians – and
 to bring them up from that land to a good and large land – to a land
 flowing with milk and honey”
 9 “the cry of the children of Israel has come to Me, and I have also seen the
 oppression with which the Egyptians oppress them”
 10 “I will send you to Pharaoh that you may bring My people (the children of
 Israel) out of Egypt”
 11 Moses said: “Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh?”
 12 “I will certainly be with you”
 13 Moses asked – when I go to the children of Israel, who do I say sent me?
 14 “I AM WHO I Am”
 15 “The Lord God of your fathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac,
 and
 the God of Jacob has sent me to you”
 16 “The Lord God your Fathers, the God of Abraham of Isaac and of Jacob”
 18 to the king of Egypt – “The Lord God of the Hebrews . . .”

Exod. 4:1	Moses answered – suppose they not believe me
3-5	a rod, to a serpent, back to a rod – that they may believe that the Lord God (Abraham, Isaac and Jacob) has appeared to you
6-7	2 signs – normal hand becomes leprous – leprous hand becomes normal
8	if they don't believe either of those signs . . .
9	turn water into blood
10-13	Moses still objected
14-17	let Aaron be your spokesman
21-23	"I will harden Pharaoh's heart"

· Moses Confronted Pharaoh With 3 Approaches

1. God's Words – Exodus 5:1 to Exodus 7:7
2. God's Miracle – Exodus 7:8-13
3. God's 10 Plagues – Exodus 7:14 to Exodus 12:30

· "Shall know That I AM the Lord"
That the children of Israel shall know
That the Egyptians shall know

Exod. 6:6	say to the children of Israel – "I am the Lord; I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians; I will rescue you from their bondage, and I will redeem you with an outstretched arm and with great judgments"
7	"I will take you as My people, and I will be your God. Then you shall know that I am the Lord your God who brings you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians"
Exod. 7:1	the Lord said to Moses – "I have made you as God to Pharaoh and Aaron your brother shall be your prophet"
2	"You shall speak all that I command you. And Aaron your brother shall tell Pharaoh to send the children of Israel out of his land"
3	"And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, and multiply My signs and My wonders in the land of Egypt"
4	"But Pharaoh will not heed you, so that I may lay My hand on Egypt and bring My armies and My people (the children of Israel) out of the land of Egypt by great judgments"
5	"And the Egyptians shall know that I am the Lord, when I stretch out My hand on Egypt and bring out the children of Israel from among them"
