- Exodus 4:21 “I will harden his heart, so that he will not let the people go”
22-23 “if you refuse to let him go, indeed I will kill your son, your firstborn”
- Briefly mentioned – Moses Confronted Pharaoh With 3 Approaches
 - God’s Words – Exodus 5:1 to Exodus 7:7
- Exod. 5:1 Moses and Aaron told Pharaoh – the Lord God of Israel said: “Let My people go, that they may hold a feast to Me in the wilderness”
2 Pharaoh – “Who is the Lord, that I should obey His voice to let Israel go? I do not know the Lord, nor will I let Israel go”
3 Moses & Aaron said: “The God of the Hebrews has met with us. Please, let us go 3 days’ journey into the desert and sacrifice to the Lord our God, lest He fall upon us with pestilence or with the sword”
4-19 gathered straw for themselves
20-21 the people complained to Moses and Aaron
22-23 Moses complained to the Lord
- Exod. 6:1 the Lord said: “You shall see what I will do to Pharaoh” – “he will let you go and he will drive you out of his land with a strong hand”
2-8 God instructed Moses to tell the people about the covenant
10-11 God – “tell Pharaoh to let the children of Israel go”
12 Moses – “the children of Israel have not listened to me, why should Pharaoh listen to me?”
14-25 a listing of families
- Exod. 7:4 the Lord – “Pharaoh will not heed you” – “Egyptians shall know”
- God’s Miracle – Exodus 7:8-13
- Exod. 7:8-12 Aaron’s rod – sorcerers’ rod – Aaron’s rod swallowed up their rods
13 Pharaoh’s heart grew hard
- God’s 10 Plagues – Exodus 7:14 to Exodus 12:30

Exod. 7:14-25	FIRST plague – water became blood
14	God said – Pharaoh’s heart is hard, he refuses to let the people go
22	Pharaoh’s heart grew hard
Exod. 8:1-15	SECOND plague – frogs
8	Pharaoh – “I will let the people go, that they may sacrifice to the Lord”
15	when Pharaoh saw relief, he hardened his heart – and did not heed them
Exod. 8:16-19	THIRD plague – lice
19	when Pharaoh’s heart grew hard – he did not heed them
Exod. 8:20-32	FOURTH plague – swarm of flies
28	Pharaoh – I will let you go (but not very far) – intercede for me
32	Pharaoh hardened his heart at this time also – not let them go
Exod. 9:1-7	FIFTH plague – livestock disease
7	the heart of Pharaoh became hard
Exod. 9:8-12	SIXTH plague – boils
12	the Lord hardened the heart of Pharaoh – he did not listen to them (just as God had told Moses)
Exod. 9:13-35	SEVENTH plague – hail
27-28	Pharaoh – I have sinned – I am wicked – I will let you go
34-35	when the rain, hail & thunder ceased – Pharaoh sinned yet more – he and his servants hardened their hearts
Exod. 10:1-20	EIGHTH plague – locusts
1	God – go to him, for I have hardened his heart
8	Pharaoh – go serve your God
10	Pharaoh – God had better be with you, when I let you (and little ones) go
11	Pharaoh – go now & serve God – (only the men)
16-17	Pharaoh – please forgive my sin
20	God hardened Pharaoh’s heart – and he did not let them go
Exod. 10:21-29	NINTH plague – darkness
24	Pharaoh – go serve the Lord – (but leave your flocks and herds)
27	the Lord hardened Pharaoh’s heart – and he would not let them go
Exod. 11:1-10	WARNING OF TENTH plague
1	Lord – I will bring one more plague, then Pharaoh will let you go
9-10	Lord to Moses – Pharaoh will not listen – My wonders will be magnified
Exod. 12:29-39	TENTH plague – death of firstborn
31	Pharaoh – go serve the Lord as you have said
32	Pharaoh – take your flocks & herds as you have said – be gone – bless me
33	Egyptians – urged the people to leave
Exod. 13:15	it came to pass, when Pharaoh was stubborn about letting us go
Exod. 14:1-13	AFTER the Israelites left Egypt
4	Lord – I will harden Pharaoh’s heart, so that he will pursue them
8	the Lord hardened the heart of Pharaoh
17	Lord – I will harden the hearts of the Egyptians, and they shall follow them
18	Lord – then, the Egyptians shall know that I am the Lord
