- “New covenant in My blood”

1 Cor. 11:23-25 on the night He was betrayed – He took the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood”

Jer. 9:23 do not glory – wisdom, might or riches

 24 glory in this – that you understand and know the Lord

Heb. 2:6-8 a little lower than angels

 9 everything will be put under Him

 10 in bringing many sons to glory

 14 partaker of flesh and blood – power over death

 17 made like His brethren – High Priest

 18 He suffered – being tempted

Heb. 4:14 we have a great High Priest

 15 in all points tempted as we are – yet, without sin

 16 boldly before the throne of grace

Heb. 7:23 there were many priests – because they kept dying

 24 the Son of God continues forever – an unchangeable priesthood

 25 He lives to make intercession for people

 26 our High Priest – holy, harmless, undefiled, separate from sinners and higher than the heavens

 27 He does not need to offer up sacrifices – He offered Himself, once

 28 old system, high priests with weaknesses – Son perfected forever

Heb. 8:1 the main point = we have a High Priest who is seated at right hand of God

 2 a minister of the true sanctuary

 6 a Mediator of a better covenant – which was established with better promises

Heb. 9:11 Christ came as High Priest of good things to come

 12 not with the blood of goats and calves – His own blood

 13-14 if the blood of bulls and goats purified, how much more shall blood of Christ – who offered Himself without spot to God

Heb. 10:19 boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of Christ

20 which He consecrated for us, through the veil (that is, His flesh)
 21 having a High Priest over the house of God
 Heb. 12:1 let us lay aside every weight and the sin that so easily ensnares us
 2 looking to the Son of God – the author and finisher of our faith – He
 endured the cross – and sat down on the right hand of the throne of
 God
 7 endure chastening
 12 strengthen the hands that hang down – and the feeble knees
 14 pursue peace with all people
 22-24 the Son of God = the Mediator of the new covenant
 Heb. 13:20-21 may the God of peace make you complete
 Rom. 5:6 when we were still without strength (in due time), Christ died for ungodly
 8 He died for us, while we were still sinners
 9 justified by His blood – saved from wrath
 10 reconciled through His death – saved by His life
 Rom. 8:31 if God is for us, who can be against us?
 32 He did not spare His own Son = He will freely give us all things
 33 who shall bring a charge against God's elect?
 34 the Son of God is risen – sitting at the right hand of God – making
 intercession
 35 what shall separate us from the love Christ?
 · tribulation?
 · distress?
 · persecution?
 · famine?
 · nakedness?
 · peril?
 · sword?
 37 we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us
 38-39 nothing can separate us from the love of God (through Christ)
 · neither death or life
 · not angels
 · not principalities or powers
 · not things present or things to come
 · not height or depth
 · not any other created thing
