| Exodus 12:1-20 | message from the Lord to Moses   |                                       |
| 3              | on the 10 <sup>th</sup> of the month – every man shall take for himself a lamb |                                       |
| 5              | lamb – without blemish   |                                       |
| 6              | on the 14 <sup>th</sup> of the month – kill the lamb at twilight               |                                       |
| 7              | take some blood – put it on the two doorposts                                  |                                       |
| 21-27          | message from Moses to the elders   |                                       |
| 21             | kill the Passover lamb   |                                       |
| 22             | blood in a basin – put it on the two doorposts                                 |                                       |
| 28-39          | the actual events  |                                       |
| 28             | the people followed instructions   |                                       |
| 29             | the Lord struck the firstborn of Egypt   |                                       |
| 31             | Pharaoh called for Moses and Aaron   |                                       |
| 2 Chron. 30:1  | King Hezekiah  |                                       |
| 2              | agreed to keep it in the second month  |                                       |
| 15             | they slaughtered the Passover lambs in the second month                        |                                       |
| 16             | sprinkled the blood  |                                       |
| 18-20          | not cleansed – Hezekiah prayed – the Lord listened                             |                                       |
| 2 Chron. 35:1  | King Josiah  |                                       |
| 7-9            | many animals – lot of blood  |                                       |
| 7              | Josiah   | 30,000 lambs and goats – 3,000 cattle |
| 8              | other leaders  | 2,600 sheep and 300 cattle            |
| 9              | leaders of Levite  | 5,000 sheep and 500 cattle            |
| John 1:29      | John – “behold, the Lamb of God”   |                                       |
| John 19:30     | “it is finished”   |                                       |

31 the bodies should not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (a High Day)  
 32-33 the soldiers broke the legs of the other 2 men on the cross  
 34 a soldier pierced His side with a spear – blood and water came out  
 Rom. 5:6 Christ died for the ungodly  
 7-8 while we were sinners  
 9 justified by His blood – saved from (ultimate) wrath  
 10 reconciled to God through His death – saved by His life  
 1 Pet. 1:19 redeemed by the precious blood of Christ – a lamb without blemish  
 Rev. 5:12 millions of voices said: “Worthy is the Lamb who was slain.”  
 Rev. 13:8 those who worship the Beast do not have their names written in the Book  
 of Life of the Lamb – slain from the foundation of the world

· Sandals on Your Feet

Exodus 12:1-20 message from the Lord to Moses  
 11 thus shall you eat  
     with a belt on your waist  
     your sandals on your feet  
     your staff in your hand  
 so, you shall eat it in haste  
 14 this shall be a memorial  
 28-39 actual events  
 34 the people took their dough before it was leavened  
 39 they baked unleavened cakes of dough – because they were driven out  
     Egypt  
 Exod. 13:3 remember this day in which you went out of Egypt – no leavened bread  
 Luke 17:31-36 remember Lot’s wife

· Paul focused upon a different lesson  
     He likened “leaven” to sin  
     He encouraged people to put out sin  
     Putting out sin = a reaction to grace  
     Putting out sin = a response to grace

1 Cor. 5:6 don’t you know that a little leaven, leavens the whole lump  
 7 purge out the old leaven – since you are truly unleavened  
 8 keep the feast – physical leaven is not the most important item – avoid  
     malice and wickedness – receive from God, sincerity and truth
