#1 “Exodus Lesson – Be Ready to Leave Quickly”

- Face the phrase – the “everlasting ordinance”

Exod. 12:14 this day shall be to you a memorial, and you shall keep it as a feast to the Lord throughout your generations – you shall keep it as a feast by an everlasting ordinance

17 therefore, you shall observe this day throughout your generations as an everlasting ordinance

Gen. 17:9 God said to Abraham – “As for you, you shall keep My covenant (you and your descendants after you) throughout your generations

10 “This is My covenant which you shall keep (between Me and you and your descendants after you): Every male child among you shall be circumcised”

- Some Exodus specifics

Exod. 12:15 shall remove leaven from your houses
whoever eats leavened bread – shall be cut off

18 shall eat unleavened bread

19 for 7 days, no leaven shall be found in your houses – whoever eats what is leavened shall be cut off from the congregation of Israel

20 you shall eat nothing leavened

Exod. 13:3 no leavened bread shall be eaten

6 7 days you shall eat unleavened bread

7 unleavened bread shall be eaten 7 days – no leavened bread shall be seen among you – nor shall leaven be seen among you in all your quarters

8 you shall tell your son: “this is done because of what the Lord did for me when I came up out of Egypt”

9 “It shall be as a sign to you on your hand and as a memorial between your eyes that the Lord’s law may be in your mouth, for with a strong hand the Lord has brought you out of Egypt”

Exod. 12:11 thus you shall eat it:
 with a belt on your waist
 with your sandals on your feet
 with your staff in your hand
 you shall eat it in haste – it is the Lord's Passover
34 the people took their dough before it was leavened – having their kneading
 bowls bound up in their clothes their clothes on their shoulders
39 and they baked unleavened cakes of dough which they had brought out of
 Egypt – for it was not leavened, because they were driven out of
 Egypt and could not wait, nor had they prepared provisions for
 themselves
Deut. 16:3 the bread of affliction – (for you came out in haste)
Luke 17:28-32 days of Lot – remember Lot's wife
33 whoever seeks to save His life, will lose it – whoever loses his life, will
 preserve it
36-36 lesson – two taken, the other left

#2 New Testament Lesson – “Because of Grace, Obey Your Heavenly Father”

John 5:19-30 the Son came to do the will of the Father
John 12:42-43 people want the praise of men – more than the praise of God
47-48 judged by what you know
Rom. 6:1-2 should we sin that grace may abound? – certainly not
Eph. 2:8-10 saved by grace – created in Jesus Christ for good works
Titus 3:4-8 justified by His grace – careful to maintain good works
