  - Title – “Conviction and Compassion in 1 Corinthians”
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- Do you remember the two great commandments?
    - “You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength – this is the first commandment”
    - “And the second, like it, is this: ‘You shall love your neighbor as yourself’ ”
  - Pastor’s opinion – Loving God = easier than loving people
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- For your notes – Scriptures About Conviction

1 Sam. 26:21-23	Saul wanted a relationship with David – David rejected the offer
Matt. 4:3,6,9	the devil tried to set the terms – the Son rejected those terms
Acts 5:29	we ought to obey God – rather than men

- For your notes – Our Compassion is a Sign of Being Christ’s Disciples

John 13:34	a new commandment – that you love one another – as I have loved you
35	by this shall all men know, that you are My disciples

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1 Cor. 1:10	Paul showed them one concept – where they should have group think
11	a specific approach – was causing contentions
12	we should NOT be rallying around a special physical person
1 Cor. 3:15	if anyone’s work is burned, he will suffer loss – but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire

- Some people have doubts about their standing with God
  - Such people often tend – to question other peoples’ standing with God
- Some people do not properly love themselves
  - Such people often have trouble loving other people

1 Cor. 4:2	we should be found faithful
3	don’t be consumed by people’s opinion of you
4	“He who judges me is the Lord”
5	judge nothing before the time
1 Cor. 5:6	a little leaven, leavens the whole lump

7 purge out old leaven – Christ (our Passover) was sacrificed for us  
 8 not malice & wickedness – rather, sincerity & truth  
 9-13 a time to avoid sinners  
 1 Cor. 6:12 all things are lawful for me – but all things are not helpful  
 9-10 the unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God  
     fornicators – idolaters – adulterers – homosexuality – sodomy –  
     thieves – covetous – drunkards – revilers – extortioners  
 11 such were some of you – washed, sanctified, justified  
 18 flee sexual immorality  
 1 Cor. 8:1 knowledge puffs up, but love edifies  
 2 we do not know it all  
 3-6 this subject – concerning the eating of things offered to idols  
 7 not in everyone that knowledge – their conscience (being weak) is defiled  
 8 food does not commend us to God  
 9-10 do not let your liberty be a stumbling block to those who are weak  
 11 because of your knowledge shall the weak brother perish? – (Lord died)  
 12 when you sin against the brethren and wound their weak conscience, you  
     sin against Christ  
 13 if food makes my brother stumble, I will never again eat meat – lest I  
     make  
         my brother stumble  
 1 Cor. 9:19 “though I am free from all men, I have made myself a servant to all – that  
     I might win the more”  
 20-22 to the Jews I became as a Jew – that I might win Jews  
     to those who are under that law, I became as one under the law – that I  
         might win those who are under the law  
     to those who are without law, I became as one without law – that I might  
         win those who are without law  
     to the weak, I became as weak – that I might win the weak  
     I have become all things to all men – that I might by all means save some  
 1 Cor. 10:23 all things are lawful – not all things are helpful – not all things edify  
 24 let no one seek his own – but each one the other’s well-being  
 25-26 ask no questions about what is sold in the meat market  
 27-30 ask no question for conscience sake  
 31 whatever you do, do for the glory of God  
 32 no offense to the Jews, to the Greeks or to the Church of God  
 33 not seeking my own profit, but the profit of many  
  
     · When you have time, consider some verses in Romans  
         Romans 12:17-21 – Romans 14:1-23 – Romans 15:1  
  
 1 Cor. 15:24 the Son of God will deliver the Kingdom to God the Father – when He  
     puts an end to all rule, all authority and power  
 28 then the Son Himself will also be subject to the Father (who put all things  
     under the Son) – that God may be all in all
