- At the end of the last Wednesday-night presentation that I gave (on April 9), I discussed two separate subjects – because I was not available to speak on April 2
In that presentation, I mentioned how the apostle Paul introduced a different lesson about leaven in the New Testament
Paul focused upon a different lesson
He likened “leaven” to sin
He encouraged people to put out sin
Putting out sin = a reaction to grace
Putting out sin = a response to grace

- Escaping Through Water

Exod. 12:29 it came to pass at midnight, that the Lord struck all the firstborn in the land of Egypt – from the firstborn of Pharaoh (who sat on the throne) to the firstborn of the captive (who was in the dungeon) and all the firstborn of livestock

30 when Pharaoh, his servants and all the Egyptians rose in the night – there was a great cry in Egypt – for there was not a house where there was not one dead

31 Pharaoh – “go and serve the Lord as you have said”

32 Pharaoh – “also, take your flocks & your herds – be gone – and bless me”

Exod. 13:3 Moses said to the people – “remember this day in which you went out of

Egypt, out of the house of bondage – for by strength of hand, the Lord brought you out of this place – no leavened bread should be eaten”

- 9 Moses – “it shall be a sign to you on your hand and a memorial between your eyes, that the Lord’s law may be in your mouth – for with a strong hand the Lord has brought you out of Egypt”
- 17 it came to pass – when Pharaoh had let the people go, God did not lead them by the way of the land of the Philistines (although that was near) – the Lord said: “Lest perhaps the people change their minds when see war, and return to Egypt”
- 18 God led the people around by way of the wilderness of the Red Sea
- 21 the Lord went before them by day in a pillar of cloud to lead the way – and
- by night in a pillar of fire to give them light
- 22 He did not take away the pillar of cloud by day or the pillar of fire at night
- Exod. 14:1-4 the Lord spoke to Moses
- 5-9 Pharaoh pursued the children of Israel – 600 choice chariots (verse 7)
- 10-12 when Pharaoh’s army drew near, the Israelites complained
- 13-14 Moses encouraged the people
- 15-18 the Lord said to Moses
- 15 go forward
- 16 stretch out your hand over the sea – go on dry land in middle of sea
- 17 God said to Moses: “I indeed will harden the hearts of the Egyptians and they shall follow you”
- 18 “then the Egyptians shall know that I am the Lord, when I have gained honor for Myself over Pharaoh, his chariots and his horsemen”
- 19-20 the Angel of God
- 21-25 Moses stretched forth his hand over the sea
- 26-28 Moses stretched forth his hand over the sea
- 29-31 recap

· “I brought you out of the land of Egypt”

Exod. 16:2-3 the whole congregation of the children of Israel complained against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness

Exod. 20:2 “I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt (out of the house of bondage)”
