- Since “I brought you out of the land of Egypt”
- Exod. 20:2 “I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt (out of
of
the house of bondage)” – therefore, the 10 Commandments
3-17 the 10 Commandments
- “Reminder of Expectations” implies – expectations were already known
Were the 10 Commandments mentioned before Exodus 20?
 - A Few General Comments about Sin
- Gen. 26:4-5 blessings to Abraham – “because Abraham obeyed My voice and kept My
charge, My commandments, My statutes, and My laws”
- Gen. 13:13 the Bible reported: “The men of Sodom were exceedingly wicked and
sinful against the Lord”
- Gen. 18:20-21 the Lord said: “Because the sin of Sodom and Gomorrah is very grave, I
will go down now . . .”
- Gen. 50:17 a messenger from the brothers said to Joseph: “Please forgive the trespass
of your brothers and their sin, for they did evil to you”

First and Second

Gen. 35:1-4 make an altar to God – put away the foreign gods from among you

Third

Job 1:5 Job – my sons have my have sinned & cursed God in their hearts

Fourth	Gen. 2:3	God blessed the 7 th day and sanctified it
Fifth	Gen. 28:6-7	Esau say that Jacob obeyed his father and his mother
Sixth	Gen. 4:7 8-11	the Lord said to Cain: "If you do not do well, sin lies at the door" Cain rose up and killed Abel
Seventh	Gen. 19:4-5 8 Gen. 39:7 8-9	men of Sodom – "bring out the two men to us" Lot's solution – "I have two daughters" Potiphar's wife approached Joseph Joseph replied: "How can I do this great wickedness and sin against God?"
Eighth	Gen. 44:1-9 2 9	Joseph's ploy to detain his brothers plant the silver cup in the sack of the youngest brother penalty = "let him die, and we also will be my lord's bondmen"
Ninth	Gen. 37:29-36 Gen. 42:22	the brothers' deception about Joseph to their father (Jacob) Reuben told his brothers: "Did I not speak to you saying, 'Do not sin against the boy' and you would not listen?"
Tenth	Gen. 3:6 16 17-19 Job 31:9,11	good for food, pleasant to the eyes, desirable to make one wise Eve's penalty Adam's penalty Job – coveting a woman or neighbor's possessions = wickedness

· The 2 Great Commandments

Matt. 19:16	"Good Teacher, what good thing shall I do that I may eternal life?"
17	"If you want to enter into life, keep the commandments"
18	conversation "Which ones?" reply = 6 th – 7 th – 8 th – 9 th – 5 th – summarized as "You shall love your neighbor as yourself"

· Did our Savior only want us to keep 5 of the 10 Commandments?

Matt. 22:37-38	"You shall love the Lord with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind" – this is the first and great commandment
39	"You shall love your neighbor as yourself"
40	"On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets"
