 - 16 suffer as a Christian power leaving to help people

	Positive Energy Leaving Us – to help people
Mark 5:25-27	a certain woman had a flow of blood for 12 years
28	"if only I may touch His clothes, I shall be made well"
29	she felt in her body that she was healed
30	the Son of God – immediately knowing in Himself that power had gone
	out of Him, turned around and asked: "Who touched My clothes?"
31-33	the woman – fear and trembling
34	the Son of God reassured her
Luke 6:17-18	a great multitude – sought to touch Him – power went out from Him to heal them and relieve torment from unclean spirits
19	they sought to touch Him – power went out from Him
Luke 8:43-48	same account as Mark 5:25-34 above

Psalm 51:1-10 David Matt. 26:75 Matt. 27:3-5	 reacting to his sin Peter – wept bitterly Judas – hanged himself
	Sin – committed against you
Psalm 6:1-10 Psalm 18:1-6 Psalm 55:1-7 Psalm 57:1-4	David – "workers of iniquity" – (v-8) David – "my enemies" – (v-3) David – "oppression of the wicked" – (v-3) David – "among lions" – (v-4)
	Observing Sin – committed against others (Mourning – the plight of other people)
Neh. 1:2-3	concerning the Jews – who returned to Jerusalem after the Babylonian exile – survivors are in great distress
4 Prov. 29:2	wept and mourned when a wicked man rules, the people groan – (King James says "mourn")
Rom. 9:1-5	Paul – sorrow for "my countrymen" – $(v-3)$
Heb. 4:15	the Son of God was tempted in all points
Luke 19:41-44 the Son of God wept over Jerusalem	
Luke 23:27	a multitude lamented over the Son of God
28	He was concerned about them
