## Deliverance From Slavery 1.

	How did Israel end up in Egypt? At this time, let's identify Israel
Gen. 32:28	God to Jacob – your name shall no longer be called "Jacob" – but "Israel"
•	Stephen told how Israel ended up in Egypt
Acts 7:8	Abraham – Isaac – Jacob (Israel) – 12 sons
9	the brothers sold Joseph into Egypt
	the brothers sold Joseph to the Midianites, who took him to Egypt
Acts 7:9-10	but God was with Joseph – God delivered him from his troubles and gave him favor with Pharaoh – (Genesis 41:37-45) – called governor
11 12	(Genesis 42:6)
11-13	a large famine came – Jacob sent his sons to Egypt to buy corn – the 2 <sup>nd</sup>
	time, Joseph revealed himself to them – and Joseph's family
1.4	became known to Pharaoh
14	Joseph sent for his father – (Genesis 45:17-20)
Gen. 46:30-34 Joseph	prepared for his family to meet Pharaoh – Joseph told them that they were going to dwell in the land of Goshen
Gen. 47:11	Joseph gave his family a possession in the best of the land of Egypt
30m 17111	(Rameses) – as Pharaoh had commanded
Acts 7:15-16	Jacob lived in Egypt, but he did not want to be buried in Egypt
	the Israelites grew in Egypt – (Exodus 1:7)
4.0	

another king arose, who did not know Joseph – (Exodus 1:8)

Gen. 50:13-14 after Jacob was buried, Joseph & the other sons of Israel returned to Egypt

15-21	after Jacob died, the brothers were afraid that Joseph would seek revenge
24	against them Joseph told his brothers that God would bring them to the land that He promised to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob
Exod. 1:1-6	the names of the children of Israel in Egypt
5	the descendants of Jacob were 70 people – Joseph was in Egypt already
6	Joseph died
7	fruitful and increased abundantly – multiplied and grew exceedingly
8	a new king – who did not know Joseph
	Notice a few scriptures about the slavery of the children of Israel
Exod. 1:11	they set taskmasters over them – to afflict them
12	they made the children of Israel serve with rigor
13	they made their lives bitter with hard bondage
	Notice a few scriptures about the promise of deliverance
Exod. 3:7	the Lord said – I have seen the oppression – and have heard the cry of their
	taskmasters – for I know their sorrows
8	I have come down to deliver them out of the hands of the Egyptians
9	I have seen the oppression
10	I will send you to Pharaoh
19	I am sure that the king of Egypt will not let you go
20	I will stretch out My hand and strike Egypt with all My wonders – after that, he will let you go
Exod. 4:21	I will harden his heart, so that he will not let the people go
22	tell him – "if you refuse to let [Israel, My firstborn] go, indeed I will kill your son, your firstborn
Exod. 12:29-31	go and serve the Lord (as you have said)
Exod. 14:4	I will harden Pharaoh's heart – that he will pursue them
21	Moses stretched forth his hand over the sea – the waters divided
27	Moses stretched out his hand over the sea – the waters returned
Acts 13:16-17	Paul stood up and motioned to speak – men of Israel, and you who fear
	God, listen – the God of this people Israel chose our fathers, and
	exalted the people when they dwelt as strangers in the land of
	Egypt – and with an uplifted arm, He brought them out of it
18-22	(Paul also mentioned Samuel and David)
23-41	then, Paul talked about the Son of God – (who delivers us from slavery)
Heb. 3:1	Apostle and High Priest of our confession – Christ Jesus
2	the Son was faithful to Him (Father) who appointed Him (Son)
3	considered worthy of more honor than Moses
4	God builds all things
5-6	Moses was faithful – Christ over His own house
