- Subtitle – “The Suffering of the Passover Lamb”

- Keynote scripture for the series = 1 Corinthians 5:7

1 Cor. 5:7 “For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us”

- Reminder – symbol of the broken bread

Matt. 26:26	as they were eating, the Son of God took bread, blessed it, broke it and gave it to the disciples – saying “Take, eat, this is My body”
Mark 14:22	as they were eating, the Son of God took bread, blessed it, broke it and gave it to them – saying “Take, eat; this is My body”
Luke 22:19	He took bread, gave thanks, broke it and gave it to His disciples – saying “This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me”
1 Cor. 11:23-24	He took bread, had given thanks, broke it – saying “Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me”

- Reminder – about some suffering experienced by the Son of God

Matt. 16:21	from that time, the Son of God began to show His disciples that He must <ul style="list-style-type: none">· go to Jerusalem· suffer many things from the elders, chief priests & scribes· be killed· raised on the third day
John 11:45	some of the Jews (who had come to Mary) – had seen what He did and

	believed in Him
46	some of them went away to the Pharisees and told them the things He did
47-48	the chief priests and the Pharisees gathered a council and said – “If we let Him alone like this, everyone will believe in Him, and the Romans will come and take away both our place and our nation”
49-50	Caiaphas (a high priest that year) – it is expedient for us that one man should die for the people, instead of the whole nation perishing
53	from that day on, they plotted to kill Him
54	the Son of God did not walk openly – went near the wilderness – to a city called Ephraim – remained with His disciples
55	Passover of Jews was near – many went to Jerusalem – purify themselves
56	talking in the temple – do you think He will come to the Feast?
57	chief priests and Pharisees – arranged spies
Matt. 26:31	all of you will stumble – “I will strike the Shepherd, and the sheep of the flock will be scattered”
37-46	prayer in Gethsemane
47-56	the soldiers took Him – the disciples forsook Him
57	took Him to the high priest (where the scribes and elders were assembled)
59-63	chief priests, elders and council sought false testimony
64	the Son of God said – you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the Power, and coming on the clouds of heaven
65-66	“He has spoken blasphemy” – “He is deserving of death”
67-68	they spit in His face and beat Him – slapped Him and mocked Him
Matt. 27:1	when morning came, all the chief priests and elders plotted to kill Him
3-10	30 pieces of silver
11-14	while they accused Him – He said nothing
15-25	the people wanted Barabbas to be released
26	he scourged the Son of God, and delivered Him to be crucified
27-28	soldiers stripped Him – put on a scarlet robe
29	a crown of thorns on His head – a reed in His right hand – bowed the knee, mocking Him
30-31	they spit on Him – hit Him on the head – mocked Him
39-40	those who passed by – taunted Him
41-43	chief priests and elders – taunted Him
44	even the robbers reviled Him
2 Cor. 1:3-4	blessed be the God & Father of our Lord – who comforts us
8-10	Paul – burdened beyond measure
2 Tim. 3:12	all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus – shall suffer persecution
Heb. 5:8	He learned obedience by the things which He suffered
1 Pet. 2:19	endures grief – suffering wrongfully
20-22	when you do good & suffer – Son of God suffered & left us an example
23	did NOT revile in return – did NOT threaten
1 Pet. 3:14	suffer for righteousness sake
1 Pet. 4:12-16	partaker of Christ’s suffering
