1 Cor. 5:7 “For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us”

- Reminder – symbol of the wine

Matt. 26:27-28 then He took the cup, gave thanks and gave it to the disciples – saying
“Drink from it, all of you – for this is My blood of the new
covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins”

Mark 14:23-24 then He took the cup, gave thanks and gave it to them – and they all drank
from it – He said unto them: “This is My blood of the new
covenant, which is shed for many”

Luke 22:20 likewise He also took the cup after supper – saying “This cup is the new
covenant in My blood, which is shed for you”

1 Cor. 11:25 in the same manner, He also took the cup after supper – saying “This cup
is the new covenant in My blood; this do, as often as you drink it,
in remembrance of Me”

26 for as often as you eat this bread and drink this cup – you proclaim the
Lord’s death until He comes

- Reminder – Son of God foretold about His suffering, death & resurrection

Matt. 16:21 He must – go to Jerusalem, suffer, be killed and be raised on third day

- His death

Luke 22:1-6	chief priests & scribes – Judas agrees to betray Him
Luke 24:20	2 reported – chief priests & rulers delivered Him – condemned & crucified
Rom. 5:1	peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ
6	while we were without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly
7-8	died for us while we were sinners
Phil. 2:8	He humbled Himself – became obedient to the point of death
Heb. 2:9	He might taste death for everyone
14	through death, He might destroy him who had the power of death

· His blood

John 19:34	one of the soldiers pierced His side with a spear
Acts 20:28	to shepherd the church of God – which He purchased with His own blood
Rom. 3:25	God has set forth His Son as a propitiation for our sins – by His blood
Eph. 1:7	redemption through His blood
Eph. 2:13	brought near by the blood of Christ
Col. 1:14	redemption through His blood – the forgiveness of sins
20	having made peace through the blood of His cross
Heb. 9:11-14	not the blood of goats and calves – His own blood
18-19	first covenant dedicated – blood of calves and goats
20	Exodus 24:8 – blood of the covenant
21	blood – tabernacle and vessels
22	there is no remission – without the shedding of blood
25	the high priest entered the Most Holy Place – with blood
Heb. 10:4	the blood of bulls and goats could not take away sins
19	enter the Holiest by the blood of the Son of God
Heb. 13:11	blood was brought into the sanctuary – bodies burned outside the camp
12	the Son of God might sanctify the people with His own blood
20-21	the blood of the everlasting covenant
Rev. 1:5	He loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood
5:9	song – “You have redeemed us to God by Your blood”
Rev. 7:14	these are the ones who came out of tribulation – and washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb
Rev. 12:11	they overcame him (the accuser of the brethren) by the blood of the Lamb

· His death and resurrection

Rom. 5:9	justified by His blood – saved from wrath through Him – (His life)
10	reconciled through His death – saved by His life
Rom. 6:3-6	likeness of His death – likeness of His resurrection
Phil. 3:10	that I may know – His sufferings, His death and His resurrection
1 Pet. 1:18-19	redeemed – with the precious blood of Christ – like a lamb
21	believe in God – who raised Him from the dead
