Part 1 – Unleavened Bread = “Being Ready to Leave in Haste”

Exod. 12:11	and thus you shall eat it – with a belt on your waist – your sandals on your feet – your staff in your hand – you shall eat it in haste
Exod. 12:14-15	7 days shall you eat unleavened bread – on the first day, you shall remove leaven from your houses
17	for I have brought you out of the land of Egypt
18	you shall eat unleavened bread
19-20	for 7 days, no leaven shall be found in your houses – don’t eat that which is leavened – you shall eat nothing leavened
33-34	shall leave in haste – before your bread has time to rise
39	because they were driven out of Egypt and could not wait
Exod. 13:3	the Lord brought you out – no leavened bread shall be eaten
6-7	7 days shall you eat unleavened bread – no leaven in your quarters
8-9	when the Lord brought you out of Egypt
Exod. 23:15	you shall eat unleavened bread 7 days – you came out of Egypt
Exod. 34:18	7 days, you shall eat unleavened bread
Lev. 23:6	7 days, you must eat unleavened bread
Deut. 16:3-4	7 days, you shall eat unleavened bread – bread of affliction – came out in haste – remember you came out of Egypt, all the days of your life – no leaven in your territory for 7 days
8	6 days, you shall eat unleavened bread – 7 th day is a sacred assembly
2 Chron. 30:13	Hezekiah – kept the Feast in the second month
21	7 days with great gladness
2 Chron. 35:17	Josiah – kept the Feast for 7 days
Ezra 6:22	7 days with joy – the Lord made them joyful – turned their heart toward
Ezek. 45:21	Feast for 7 days – unleavened bread shall be eaten
Matt. 24:17-18	not from the housetop to your house – not from the field (to get clothes)
40-41	field and mill – one taken, one left
Mark 13:15-16	not from the housetop to your house – not from the field (to get clothes)
Luke 17:31	not return from the housetop to your house – not return from the field
32	remember Lot’s wife
34	2 people sleeping in one bed – one taken, the other will be left
35	2 people grinding wheat together – one taken, the other will be left
36	2 people in field – one taken, the other will be left

Part 2 – Unleavened Bread = “Follow Your Father’s Expectations”

(I realize that the common phrase disciples say is – “Put Sin Out of Your Life”)

(There is nothing wrong with that phrase)

(I prefer to frame it in positive message – “Follow Your Father’s Expectations”)

- Let's begin with the foundational concept
Children of God are saved by grace – blessed by works

Titus 3:4-8 saved by grace – constantly affirm, maintain good works

- ## “Sinner Saved by Grace”

Exod. 20:1-17	since God brought them out of Egypt – 10 commandments
John 5:19-20	what He saw the Father do – (to us – watch what the Father does)
John 8:28-29	what the Father taught Him – (to us – respond to what the Father teaches)
Matt. 16:5-12	leaven of Pharisees and Sadducees – their doctrine
1 Cor. 5:7-8	truly unleavened – not malice & wickedness – sincerity & truth

- “You’ll Never Walk Alone”

Heb. 1:3	Son purged our sins – sat at the right hand of the Majesty on high
Heb. 2:9	a little lower than the angels – might taste death for everyone
14	partaker of flesh and blood – to destroy him who had the power of death
Heb. 9:11-14	blood of Christ

- ## “Watch the Lamb”

1 Peter 1:3	blessed be the Father and Son – He has begotten us to a living hope – through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead
18-19	redeemed by the precious blood of the Lamb
21	raised Him from the dead and gave Him glory – so that your faith and hope are in the Father
