	Three days and three nights
John 2:18	Jews asked – what sign do You show us?
19	He answered – destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up
20	Jews said – it has taken 46 years to build this temple, and will you raise it up in three days?
21	but He was speaking of the temple of His body
22	when He had risen from the dead, His disciples remembered what He said to them – and they believed the Scripture
	Later in His life, people taunted the Son of God for saying those words
Matt. 26:60	2 false witnesses came forward
61	this fellow said – I am able to destroy the temple of God and to build it in three days
Mark 14:57	some arose and bore false witness against Him
58	saying – I will destroy this temple made with hands, and within three days I will build another made without hands
59	but not even then, did their testimony agree
Matt. 27:39-40those	who passed by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads and saying – You who destroy the temple and build it in three days, save Yourself – if You are the Son of God, come down from the cross
Mark 15:29-30	those who passed by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads and saying – Aha, You who destroy the temple and build it in three days, save yourself and come down from the cross
	Sign of Jonah
Matt. 12:39	an evil and adulterous generation seeks after a sign – no sign shall be given to it, except the sign of the prophet Jonah
40	for as Jonah was 3 days and 3 nights in the belly of the great fish – so will the Son of Man be 3 days and 3 nights in the heart of the earth
Luke 11:29	this is an evil generation – it seeks a sign – no sign will be given to you,

except the sign of Jonah the prophet

	The Son of God began to tell His disciples – He would be raised 3 rd day
Matt. 16:21	"be killed and be raised the third day"
Matt. 17:23	"they will kill Him, and the third day He will be raised up"
	on of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and to the scribes –
	and they will condemn Him to death, and deliver Him to the Gentiles to mock and to scourge and to crucify – and the third day He will rise again"
Mark 8:31	"be killed and after three days rise again"
Mark 9:31	"they will kill Him; after He is killed, He will rise the third day"
Mark 10:33-34	"the Son of Man will be betrayed to the chief priests and to the scribes – and they will condemn Him to death and deliver Him to the Gentiles – and they will mock Him, and scourge Him, and spit on Him, and kill Him – and the third day He will rise again"
Luke 9:22	"be killed, and be raised the third day"
Luke 18:32-33 "He w	rill be delivered to the Gentiles and will be mocked and insulted and spit upon – they will scourge Him and kill Him – and the third day He will rise again"
	Pilate ordered the guarding of the tomb
Matt. 27:63	the deceiver said – "after 3 days, I will rise"
64	therefore, command that the tomb be made secure until the third day, lest His disciples come by night and steal Him away and say to the people, "He has risen from the dead"
65	Pilate said – go your way and make it as secure as you know how
66	they made the tomb secure – sealing the stone – setting the guard
	Scriptures – the preparation day
John 19:31	because it was the preparation day, the bodies should not remain on the cross on the Sabbath (for that Sabbath was a high day)
Luke 23:53	Joseph (of Arimathea) – took down body – wrapped in linen – in tomb
54	that day was the preparation, and the Sabbath (the high day) drew near
56	the women returned and prepared spices and fragrant oils – they rested on the (weekly) Sabbath according to the commandment
	After the empty tomb – comments about the 3 rd day
Luke 24:1-7	the third day rise again
21	today is the third day since these things happened
46	necessary to suffer & to rise from the dead 3 rd day
