- Today – is the Seventh Day of Unleavened Bread
  - Title – “Quick Glimpse at the Book of 1 Corinthians”
- 
- As we start, let’s look at some facts
    - Fact – the Bible teaches that we are saved by grace
    - Fact – Many religious people (who espouse the view that people are saved by grace) – teach that God has removed ALL expectations of obedience upon a “believer”
    - Fact – Some religious people (who espouse the view that people are saved by grace) – still inadvertently (and maybe subconsciously) still seek to earn salvation from the Father and Son
  - Your pastor’s opinion
    - Opinion – I believe that some of the strongest preaching in the church should be done during the Days of Unleavened
    - Opinion – While I strongly support using the time before the Passover to stress the remarkable mercy and grace of the Father, I believe that the Days of Unleavened Bread are an important time to focus upon
      - His expectations
      - How we fall short of His expectations – (our sins)
      - Our need to repent of those sins
  - With that in mind – I am going to embark upon the ambitious & the impossible

| 1 Cor. 1:2  | to the church in Corinth – those sanctified in Christ Jesus – called to be saints – like people in every place (around the world) – call on the name of our Lord |
| 1 Cor. 1:10 | not speak the same thing – except in an important matter   |
| 11-15       | do not elevate into the place of Christ  |
| 1 Cor. 3:1  | it is carnal to elevate people into the place of Christ  |
| 2           | elevating people into the place of Christ = is for babies  |
| 3           | elevating people into the place of Christ = creates envy, strife & division  |
| 4           | elevating people into the place of Christ = downright carnal   |
| 5-8         | people can serve – God gives the increase  |
| 9-11        | the Son of God is the foundation   |
| 12-15       | each person’s attempt to build = will be evaluated   |
| 1 Cor. 4:3  | “It is a very small thing that I should be judged by you or by a human court”  |
| 4           | “He who judges me is the Lord”   |
| 5           | “Therefore, judge nothing before the time, until the Lord comes, who will  |

	both bring to light the hidden things of darkness and reveal the counsels of the hearts”
1 Cor. 5:1-6	sexual immorality – removed from a congregation – the sin & the “glorying” – (an example of “mercy” not helping the congregation)
7-8	Christ is our Passover – unleavened bread of sincerity and truth
9-13	there is a time to remove someone from a congregation
John 8:3-11	scribes and Pharisees – testing Him (verse 6)
1 Cor. 14:18-19	Paul spoke in tongues more than anybody – but not in the congregation
1 Cor. 6:9-10	naming sins
11	some of you with those sins were washed, sanctified & justified
1 Cor. 7:8-16	three categories
8-9	recommendation – remain single
10-11	command – stay married – if divorced, do not remarry
12-16	recommendation – about remarriage
1 Cor. 8:9-13	do not let your liberty become a stumbling block
1 Cor. 9:19-23	be a servant – know your audience
1 Cor. 10:31-33	do not let your liberty become a stumbling block
1 Cor. 11	Passover
1 Cor. 12	gifts
1 Cor. 13	power of love
1 Cor. 14:33	God is not the author of confusion – but of peace
1 Cor. 15:1-2	hold fast to good preaching
3-4	the Son of God died for our sins (according to the Scriptures), was buried and rose again the third day (according to the Scriptures)
12-20	how can you say that there is no resurrection?
24-28	the entire world shall be subject to the Son of God – and He will subject is to the Father
·	Read 1 Corinthians
·	Recognize what scriptures you would have chosen for this presentation
·	Analyze that you could have picked better scriptures than I chose
·	Then recognize, that I (as your friend) – I am nudging you to study the Word of God – because we are saved by grace – and the Father has expectations of us
