 - Comment – This study will focus upon some statements by Paul
(Book of Acts – what Paul said and what Luke wrote about Paul)
(Book of Romans – what Paul wrote)

Acts 13:16-41	Paul spoke in the synagogue
27	the voices of the prophets were read every Sabbath – condemned Him
28	though they found no cause for death – they asked Pilate put Him to death
29	they took Him down from a tree and laid Him in a tomb
30	but God raised Him from the dead
31	He was seen by witnesses from Jerusalem to Galilee
32-33	glad tidings of the promise made to the fathers – God has fulfilled this promise for us (their children) – in that He has raised up Jesus – written in Psalm 2:7
34-35	and that He raised Him from the dead, He will not return to corruption – written in Isaiah 55:3 and Psalm 16:10
36	David fell asleep and saw corruption
37	He whom God raised up – saw no corruption
38-39	let it be known, that through this Man is preached to you the forgiveness of sins – and by Him (everyone who believes) is justified from all things (from which you could not be justified) by the law of Moses
40-41	beware of the warning spoken in the prophets – Habakkuk 1:5
Acts 17:18	people called Paul a babbler and a proclaimer of foreign gods – because he preached to them Jesus and the resurrection
32	when they heard talk about the resurrection of the dead, some mocked and others said they would talk about it later
Acts 23:6-8	the Pharisees taught a resurrection – the Sadducees said no resurrection
Acts 24:15	Paul proclaimed – there will be a resurrection of the dead, both of the just and the unjust
21	Paul said – “concerning the resurrection of the dead, I am being judged by you this day”
Rom. 1:4	declared to be the Son of God – with power – by the resurrection from the dead
Rom. 4:20-22	Abraham did not waver in faith
23-25	these words were not written for Abraham sake alone – but also for us – it shall be imputed to us, who believe in Him who raised up Jesus our Lord from the dead – who was delivered for our offenses and was raised because of our justification

Rom. 5:9 having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath
 through Him
 10 when we were enemies, we were reconciled to God through the death of
 His Son – much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved
 by His life
Rom. 6:3-4 we were buried with Him through baptism into death – just as Christ was
 raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, we should walk in
 newness of life
 5 likeness of His death – likeness of His resurrection
 9 we shall live with Him – knowing that Christ was raised from the dead, He
 dies no more – death no longer has dominion over Him
 10 the death that He died, He died to sin for all – but the life that He lives, He
 lives to God
Rom. 7:4 my brethren, you have become dead to the law through the body of Christ,
 that you may be married to another – married to Him who was
 raised from the dead (that we should bear fruit to God)
Rom. 8:11 if the Spirit of God (who raised Jesus from the dead) dwells in you, He
 who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal
 bodies – through His Spirit that dwells in you
Rom. 10:9 if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus Christ and believe in your
 heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved
