Gal. 1:1	Paul, an apostle – (not from men nor through man, but through Jesus Christ and God the Father, who raised Him from the dead)
Eph. 1:20-21	He worked in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places – far above all principality, power, might, dominion, and every name that is named
22-23	He put all things under His feet – and gave Him to be head over all things to the church – which is His body
Phil. 3:10-11	know Him – power of His resurrection – fellowship of His sufferings – being conformed to His death – attain the resurrection from dead
Col. 2:12	buried with Him in baptism – raised with Him through faith in the working of God – who raised Him from the dead
1 Thes. 1:10	to wait for His Son from heaven, whom He raised from the dead
2 Tim. 2:8	remember that Jesus Christ (of the seed of David) was raised from dead
1 Cor. 6:14	God both raised up the Lord and will also raise us up by His power
1 Cor. 15:1-2	I declare the gospel to you
	1 – which I preached to you 3 – in which you stand
	2 – which you received 4 – and by which you are saved
3-4	Christ died for our sins (according to the Scripture), was buried and rose again the third day (according to the Scripture)
5-6	He was seen by Peter, then the 12 and then by over 500 brethren at once – most of them remain alive, but some have died
7-8	He was seen by James – then by all the apostles – then by Paul
9-11	I am the least of the apostles
12	how can some among you say that there is no resurrection of the dead?
13	if there is no resurrection – Christ is not risen
14	if Christ is not risen – our preaching is empty & your faith is empty
15	if Christ is not risen – we are false witnesses
16	if the dead do not rise – Christ is not risen
17	if Christ is not risen – your faith is futile & you are still in your sins
18	those who have fallen asleep in Christ – have perished
19	if in this life only we have hope in Christ – we are most pitiful
20	Christ is risen – has become the first-fruit of those who have fallen asleep
21	death came by a man – resurrection came by a Man
22	as in Adam, all die – even so in Christ, all shall be made alive
23	each one in his own order – Christ – those who are Christ’s at His coming

24-28 powerful section
 24 the Son will put down all rule, authority and power
 25 He must reign until He has put all enemies under His feet
 26 the last enemy = death
 27-28 all under His feet, with one exception – that God may be all in all
 29 why would people be baptized for the dead (if the dead don't rise)?
 (being baptized – expecting to see the dead)
 30 why do we stand in jeopardy?
 31 Paul – I die daily
 32 why fight with beasts? – why not eat and drink?
 33 evil company corrupts good habits
 34 awake to righteousness & do not sin – some do not have the knowledge of
 God – I speak this to your shame
 35 “how are the dead raised up?”
 36-37 what you sow does not make alive – unless you die
 38 God gives it a body as it pleases Him
 39 all flesh is not the same – animals, fish, birds
 40 difference – celestial (heavenly) bodies – terrestrial (earthly) bodies
 41 even a difference among – sun, moon, stars
 42-44 so also is the resurrection of the dead
 sown in corruption – raised in incorruption
 sown in dishonor – raised in glory
 sown in weakness – raised in power
 sown a natural body – raised a spiritual body
 45 the first man Adam became a living being – the last Adam became a life-
 giving spirit
 46 the natural is first – then the spirit
 47 the first man was of the earth, made of dust – the second Man is the Lord,
 from heaven
 48 made like the 2 of them – made of dust and heavenly
 49 image like the 2 of them – of the man of dust – image of the heavenly Man
 50 flesh & blood cannot inherit the Kingdom of God – corruption cannot
 inherit incorruption
 51-52 mystery – all shall not sleep, but all will be changed
 twinkling of an eye – at the last trumpet
 the dead will be raised incorruptible – we shall be changed
 53 corruption puts on incorruption – mortal puts on immortality
 54 death is swallowed up in victory
 55 where is your sting? – where is your victory
 56 the sting of death is sin – the strength of sin is the law
 57 thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through the Son
 58 therefore – be steadfast and immovable – always abounding in the work of
 the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain
 2 Cor. 1:9 trust in the God, who raises the dead
 2 Cor. 4:14 knowing that He who raised up the Lord Jesus will also raise us up with
 Jesus – and will present us with you
