- Psalm 110:1

Psalm 110:1 The Lord said to my Lord, “Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool”

- 6 New Testament references – Psalm 110:1

Matt. 22:41-42 while the Pharisees were gathered together, Jesus asked them: “what do you think about the Christ? Whose Son is He?” – they replied: “The Son of David”

43-44 He said to them: “How then does David in the Spirit call Him ‘Lord’ – ‘the Lord said to my Lord, “Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool” ’ ”

45 If David then calls Him “Lord,” how is He his Son?
Mark 12:35-36 then Jesus answered and said (while He taught in the temple): “How is it that the scribes say that the Christ is the Son of David? For David himself said by the Holy Spirit: “The Lord said to my Lord, ‘Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool.’ ”

37 “Therefore David himself calls Him ‘Lord’ – how is He then his Son?”
Luke 20:41-43 He said to them: “How can they say that the Christ is the Son of David? Now David himself said in the Book of Psalms – The Lord said to My Lord, ‘Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool.’ ”

44 “Therefore David calls Him ‘Lord’ – how is He then his Son?”
Acts 2:32 God raised up this Jesus – we are witnesses
33 therefore – being exalted to the right hand of God and having received (from the Father) the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out that which you now see and hear

34-35 David did not ascend into the heavens – “The Lord said to my Lord, ‘Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool’ ”
Heb. 1:13 to which of the angels has God ever said – “Sit at My right hand, till I make Your enemies Your footstool?”

Heb. 10:12-13 this Man (after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever) sat down at the right hand of God – from that time waiting till His enemies are made His footstool

- 3 gospel writers – wrote about the Son of God’s statement

Matt. 26:64 “As you said – I say to you, hereafter you will see the Son of Man sitting at
 the right hand of the Power, and coming on the clouds of heaven”
 Mark 14:62 “I am – And you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right hand of the
 Power, and coming with the clouds of heaven”
 Luke 22:67-70 “If You are the Christ, tell us” – “If I tell you, you will by no means
 believe. And if I also ask you, you will by no means answer Me or
 let Me go. Hereafter the Son of Man will sit on the right hand of
 the power of God – “Are You then the Son of God?” – “You
 rightly say that I am.”

· Book of Acts

Acts 5:31 Him God has exalted to His right hand to be Prince and Savior – to give
 repentance to Israel and forgiveness of sins
 Acts 7:55-56 Stephen gazed into heaven and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing at
 the right hand of God – and said: “Look, I see the heavens opened
 and the Son of Man standing at the right hand of God”

· Romans, Ephesians and Colossians

Rom. 8:34 Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also
 risen (who is even at the right hand of God), who also makes
 intercession for us.
 Eph. 1:20-21 He worked in Christ, when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him
 at His right hand in the heavenly places – far above all principality,
 power, might, dominion, and every name that is named
 Col. 3:1 if you were raised with Christ, seek those things which are above – where
 Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God

· Hebrews

Heb. 1:1-3 God previously worked through prophets – has now spoken to us by His
 Son – who purged our sins, sat down at the right hand of the
 Majesty on high
 Heb. 8:1 this is the main point – we have such a High Priest, who is seated at the
 right hand of the throne of the Majesty in the heavens
 Heb. 12:2 Jesus (the author and finisher of our faith) endured the cross, despising the
 shame and has sat down at the right hand of the throne of God

· 1 Peter

1 Peter 3:22 Jesus Christ has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God – angels,
 authorities and powers have been made subject to Him
