	Cunning serpent
Gen. 3:1	the serpent was more cunning than any beast of the field – asked: "has God indeed said that you shall not eat of every tree in the garden?"
2-3	women – "we may eat of all the trees, except the one in the middle"
4-5	serpent replied – "you will not die; for God knows that if you eat of it, your eyes will be opened, and you will be like God – knowing good and evil"
11	Lord God – "have you eaten from the tree of which I commanded you not to eat?"
12	the man blamed the woman
13	the woman blamed the serpent
14-15	the Lord God – announced a penalty for the serpent
16	the Lord God – announced a penalty for the woman
17-19	the Lord God – announced a penalty for the man
	Reminder of the penalty for the serpent
Gen. 3:14-15	notice the curses  cursed more than all cattle & more than every beast of the field – on your belly, you shall go you shall eat dust all the days of your life I will put enmity between you and the woman I will put enmity between your seed and her Seed He shall bruise your head And you shall bruise His heel
	Christ Shall Bruise the Serpent's Head
Heb. 2:9	we see the Son of God (who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death) – crowned with glory and honor – that He (by the grace of God) might taste death for everyone
. 14	the Son of God was a partaker of flesh and blood – that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death (that is, the devil)  The Son of God gives victory through the angels – (history and prophecy)

Luke 10:18 John 12:31	the Son of God said – "I saw Satan fall like lightning from heaven" the Son of God said – now is the judgment of the world – now the ruler of this world will be cast out
Rev. 12:7-8	war broke out in heaven – Michael and his angels fought with the dragon – and the dragon and his angels fought – but they did not prevail, nor was there a place found for them in heaven any longer
9	so the great dragon was cast out (that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan – who deceives the whole world – he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him
Rev. 20:1	an angel coming down from heaven – having a key to the bottomless pit – and a great chain in his hand
2	he laid hold of the dragon – (that serpent of old, the devil and Satan) – and bound him for 1,000 years
3	the angel – cast him into the bottomless pit – set a seal on him – that he would not deceive the nations until the 1,000 years were finished – then, he would be released for a little while
Rev. 20:7-8	when the thousand years had expired, Satan will be released from his prison and will go out to deceive the nations which are on the four corners of the earth
9	they surrounded the camp of the saints and the beloved city – fire came down from heaven and devoured them
10	the devil (who deceived them) was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone (where the beast and false prophet were) – and they will be tormented day and night forever and ever
	The Son of God gives victory through the saints
Job 1:1 blame	less and upright
8	the Lord said – "have you considered My servant Job?"
9-10 11	Satan – "you have put a hedge around him"  Satan – "touch all that he has"
12	the Lord – you may touch his possessions, but you may not touch him
Job 2:3 Satan	- "have you considered My servant Job?"
4-5	Satan – "touch his bone and his flesh"
6	the Lord – he is in your hand, but spare his life
Job 40:1-2	the Lord – "shall the one who contends with the Almighty correct Him?  He who rebukes God, let him answer it"
Job 42:5	"I have heard of You by the hearing of the ear, but now my eye sees You"
	Reminder – Victory comes through the Son of God
Matt. 27:51 1 Cor. 15:24-28	the veil of the temple was torn in two – from top to bottom all things subject to the Son
