Rev. 7:1 2-3	4 angels standing at the 4 corners of the earth – holding back the 4 winds another angel – having the seal of the living God – cried with a loud voice to the 4 angels – "do not harm the earth, the sea or the trees until we have sealed the servants of God on their foreheads"
4	I heard number of those who are sealed – 144,000 of the children of Israel
5-8	Judah – Reuben – Gad
6	Asher – Naphtali – Manasseh
7	Simeon – Levi – Issachar
8	Zebulun – Joseph [Ephraim?] – Benjamin
	Why was Dan missing? (Judges 18:14-31 – gross idolatry)
	Which tribe replaced Dan? (Genesis 48:5 – Ephraim & Manasseh)
	While the 144,000 are sealed, there is also great news for the innumerable multitude
Rev. 7:9	a great multitude (which no one could number) – all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues – standing before the throne & before the Lamb
10	crying out with a loud voice – "salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne and to the Lamb"
	Revelation 14:1-5
Rev. 14:1	a Lamb standing on Mount Zion – and 144,000 (having His Father's name written on their foreheads
2	I heard a voice in heaven – and the sound of harps
3	they sang a new song before the throne – before the 4 living creatures and

the elders – no one could learn that song except the 144,000 – who were redeemed from the earth

	3.	Those who had no deceit in their mouth – (being in a state of repentance)		
Rev. 14:5 James 3:2-18		no deceit in their mouth – (being in a state of repentance) righteousness from above		
	4.	Those who are without fault before the throne of God – (being in a state of repentance)		
Rev. 14:5 1 John 1:7 8 9 10 1 John 2:1 5 6		without fault the blood of the Son cleanses us from all sin we have sin He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us we have sinned written so that we don't sin – we have an Advocate we keep His word we seek to walk as He walked
