

## BOOK OF REVELATION – Part 11

Revelation 22:10-11

- Today – Opportunity to give a Bible study
  - Reminder – this series started with 9 Bible studies – but expanded to 12 Bible studies
  - Reminder – I will continue to focus upon Christian living – not predictions
  - Title – “Book of Revelation – Part 11”
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- Let’s start with Revelation 22:10

Rev. 22:10	then he said to me.....(who is the “he”?)
8	an angel
10	do not seal the words of the prophecy of this book – for the time is at hand

The Amplified New Testament – “Do not seal up the words of the prophecy of this book and make no secret of them; for the time when things are brought to a crisis and the period of their fulfillment is near.”

Contemporary English Version – “Don’t keep the prophecies in this book a secret. These things will happen soon.”

- Before we go to verse 11, let’s read verses 18-19

Rev. 22:18	if you add to the book = plagues
19	if you take away from the book = take away your part in the Book of Life and away from the holy city

- Therefore – reminder about 2 goals  
Don’t keep these teachings a secret  
But don’t alter the Biblical teachings

- Now – verse 11

Rev. 22:11	concentrating upon behavior
	He who is unjust = let him be unjust still
	He who is filthy = let him be filthy still
	He who is righteous = let him be righteous still
	He who is holy = let him be holy still

- Let’s notice a few Biblical examples

Deut. 3:25	Moses – “let me cross over and see the good land beyond the Jordan (those
	pleasant mountains and Lebanon)”
26	but the Lord was angry with me
27	go up to the top of Pisgah – look west, north, south & east – see it with your eyes, for you are not crossing over the Jordan
2 Sam. 12:13-14	David said: “I have sinned against the Lord” – Nathan said: “You will not die, but your child shall die”
2 Cor. 12:7-8	Paul said: “I pleaded with the Lord 3 times for the thorn in the flesh to depart from me”
9	the Lord said: “My grace is sufficient for you, My strength is made perfect in [your] weakness”
Job 1:8	“have you considered My servant Job?”
2:3	“have you considered My servant Job?”
38:3	“I will question you, and you shall answer Me”
40:4	“I am vile”
7	“I will question you, and you shall answer Me”
42:5	now, my eye sees You
6	I repent
John 12:47	don’t understand = “I do not judge”
48	understand = “the word that I have spoken will judge him in the last day”
Matt. 23:4-15	form of religion
Luke 23:27-28	mourning for family, friends – even the world
42	“remember me when You come into Your kingdom”
Rev. 22:10-11	unjust, filthy, righteous, holy
