Ephesus is mentioned in the Bible much more than the other churches

Ephesus 17 times Smyrna 2 times –

Smyrna 2 times – (both times in Revelation)
Pergamos 2 times – (both times in Revelation)
Thyatira 4 times – (3 times in Revelation)
Sardis 3 times – (all times in Revelation)
Philadelphia 2 times – (both times in Revelation)
Laodicea 6 times – (1 time in Revelation)
Laodiceans 2 times – (1 time in Revelation)

Historical reminder

Holman Bible Dictionary (page 115) – "Following the Hermus River inland from Sardis, one reaches *Philadelphia*, the name commemorating the brotherly love between Attalus Philadelphus and Eumenes. Founded during the second century B.C, the city was set amidst vast vineyards and led in the worship of Dionysius. The terrible earthquake of A.D. 17 was followed by dangerous tremors for the next 20 years, each one debilitating the city further. The apostle John's reference to giving of a 'new name' (Rev. 3:12) may be a wordplay on the proposed dedication of the city as 'Neo-Caesarea' in honor of aid Tiberius sent."

Smyrna (2nd) and Philadelphia (6th) only praise & encouragement
