- Do you know how many times the word “Messiah” is found in the Bible?

“masiah” – (#4899) – anointed (one)
Messiah – 2 times
anointed – 37 times

Dan. 9:25 to restore and build Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince
26 Messiah shall be cut off, but not for Himself

“Messias” – (#3323) – Anointed One
Messias – 2 times
“Christos” – (#5547) – Christ, Anointed One, Messiah,
the Greek translation of the Hebrew (#4899)
Christ – 553 times
Christ’s – 16 times

John 1:41 “we have found the Messiah” (which is translated, the Christ)
John 4:25 the woman said: “I know that Messiah is coming” (who is called Christ)

Gen. 3:15 enmity between you the woman – enmity between your seed and her Seed
Gen. 12:2 to Abram – I will make you a great nation – I will bless you
Gen. 16:1-4 Sarai wanted a child
5 Sarai – “I became despised in her eyes”
11-12 his name shall be Ishmael
Gen. 17:16 I will give Sarah a son – mother of many nations
18 “can’t the promise just come through Ishmael?”
20 “I have heard you” – “I have blessed Ishmael”
Isaiah 7:14 the Lord Himself will give you a sign – behold, a virgin shall conceive and
 bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel
Matt. 1:23 repeated the promise of Isaiah 7:14
John 1:19 testimony of John – “who are you?”
20 “I am not the Christ”
21 “Are you Elijah?” – “Are you the Prophet?”
22 “who are you (so that we may give an answer)?”
John 1:29 “behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sins of the world”

John 1:41 “we have found the Messiah”
 49 “Rabbi, You are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel”
Matt. 16:21 began to tell them
 go to Jerusalem
 suffer many things from the elders, chief priests and scribes
 be killed
 raised the third day
 22 Peter – “far be it from you, Lord; this shall not happen”
Luke 22:31-32 the Lord said to Simon – “Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as
 wheat – “but I have prayed for you, that your faith should not fail,
 and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren”
Luke 22:41-44 the Son prayed earnestly
Luke 23:28 “do not weep for Me, but weep for yourselves and your children”
John 16:33 “these things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace” – “in
