- To start off this presentation – I want to mention 2 major approaches about trying to help people
  - First – Treat People as You Want to Be Treated
    - Matt. 7:12 whatever you want people to do to you – do to them
    - Rom. 2:21 you who teach another, do you not teach yourself?
    - 21-23 examples
      - if you preach that a person should not steal – don’t steal
      - if you say “do not commit adultery” – don’t commit adultery
      - if you abhor idols – do not rob temples
      - if you boast in the law – do you dishonor God by breaking the law?
  - Second – Treat People as They Want to Be Treated
    - Phil. 2:3 in lowliness of mind, esteem others better than yourself
    - 4 look not “only” at your interests – look after the interests of others
    - Psalm 145:15 needs – You give them their food
    - 16 desires – You satisfy the desires
