- God repeated the promises to Jacob
 - Gen. 12:1-3 God gave the promises to Abraham
 - Gen. 26:2-5 God repeated the promises to Isaac
 - Gen. 28:3-4 God repeated the promises to Jacob
- Isaac instructed Jacob about marriage
 - Gen. 27:46 those wives of Esau are a weary – I don’t want Jacob taking a wife of Heth
 - Gen. 28:1-2 Isaac instructed Jacob – Padan Aram – a daughter of Laban
 - Gen. 28:5 Jacob went to Padan Aram
 - 6-9 when Esau heard what Isaac said about a wife – Esau added a new wife
 - 10-15 Jacob’s dream about a ladder – God repeated promises
 - 16-19 the stone – a pillar – poured oil on it – called the place, Bethel
 - 20-22 Jacob made a vow to God
 - Gen. 29:1-5 Jacob came to a well
 - 6-12 Jacob met Rachel – Rachel went to tell Laban about Jacob
 - 13-15 Laban came to meet Jacob
 - 16-17 Jacob had 2 daughters – Leah and Rachel
 - 18-20 Jacob loved Rachel – agreed to serve Laban for 7 years
 - 21-26 at the feast, Laban deceived Jacob – custom for the older to be married 1st
 - 27-30 Jacob agreed to serve Laban for another 7 years
 - 31 when the Lord saw that Rachel was unloved, He opened Leah’s womb
- 29:32 Leah – Reuben 30:9-11 Zilpah – Gad
 - 33 Leah – Simeon 12-13 Zilpah – Asher
 - 34 Leah – Levi 14-18 Leah – Issachar
 - 35 Leah – Judah 19-20 Leah – Zebulun
- 30:1-2 Jacob & Rachel argued 21 Leah – Dinah
 - 3-6 Bilhah – Dan 22-24 Rachel – Joseph
 - 7-8 Bilhah – Naphtali 35:16-18 Rachel – Benjamin
- Jacob agreed to stay near Laban

- Gen. 30:25-26 Jacob wanted to leave Laban
- 27-28 Laban – please stay, name your wages
 - 29-30 Jacob – the Lord has blessed since my arrival
 - 31 Laban – what shall I give you?
 - 31-43 Jacob – speckled & spotted sheep – brown lambs – speckled & spotted goats – “these shall be my wages”
- Jacob ran from Laban
- Gen. 31:1-2 Laban’s sons complained – Laban’s attitude toward Jacob changed
- 3 God to Jacob – return to the land of your father and your family
 - 4-13 Jacob told Rachel and Leah that they should leave
 - 14-18 Rachel and Leah agreed
 - 19 Rachel stole some idols
 - 20-42 Jacob snuck away – Laban pursued
 - 43-55 Jacob and Laban made an agreement
- Jacob and Esau
- Gen. 32:1-5 Jacob wanted to see Esau
- 6-8 Jacob heard that Esau was coming with 400 men
 - 9-12 Jacob asked God for deliverance
 - 13-21 Jacob sent his men to Esau – with animals (as gifts)
 - 22-32 Jacob wrestled with God – his name was changed to Israel
- Gen. 33:1-20 Jacob and Esau had a friendly encounter
- 4 Esau ran to meet Jacob – embraced and kissed
 - 8 Esau asked why Jacob sent gifts – Jacob said “to find favor”
 - 9-11 Esau said he had enough things – Jacob urged Esau to keep the gifts
- Gen. 34:1-2 Shechem (son of Hamor) raped Dinah
- 3-4 Shechem asked Hamor to arrange a marriage
 - 5-6 Jacob did not react to Hamor – until he informed his sons (her brothers)
 - 7 the brothers were furious
 - 8-10 Hamor asked the family – for Dinah to marry Shechem
 - 11-12 Shechem said – he would do anything
 - 13-24 the brothers – tricked Shechem and the other men to be circumcised
 - 25-31 3 days later – Simeon and Levi killed every man in town
- Gen. 35:1-8 Jacob returned to Bethel
- 9-15 God blessed Jacob at Bethel
 - 16-22 Benjamin was born
 - 23-26 listing of Jacob’s 12 sons
 - 27-29 Isaac died
- Gen. 36:1-43 genealogy of Esau – who is Edom
- 43 Esau was the father of the Edomites
