Acts 7:8-18	Stephen told how Israel ended up in Egypt
8	Abraham – Isaac – Jacob (Israel) – 12 sons
9	the brothers sold Joseph – Joseph ended up in Egypt first, in the pit – Genesis 37:18-24 second, sold him – Genesis 37:25-36
9-10	but God was with Joseph favor and wisdom with Pharaoh – Genesis 41:37-45 made him governor over Egypt – Genesis 42:6
11	a large famine came – Genesis 41:56
12	Jacob sent his sons to Egypt to buy corn – Genesis 42:1-2
13	the 2 nd time, Joseph revealed himself to them (Genesis 45:1-4) – and Joseph's family became known to Pharaoh (Genesis 45:16)
14	Joseph sent for the family (Pharaoh: "bring your father") – Genesis 45:18 and they lived in the land of Goshen (Genesis 47:1-2)
15	Jacob died in Egypt – Genesis 49:33
16	Jacob was carried back to Shechem – Genesis 50:4-13
Gen. 50:14-21	after Jacob died, the brothers were afraid of Joseph – expecting revenge
24	Joseph told his brothers that God would bring them to the land promised to Abraham, to Isaac and to Jacob
Acts 7:17	the people grew in Egypt – Exodus 1:7
18	a new king arose – Exodus 1:8
19	the new king oppressed the people – Exodus 1:9-14
20	Moses was born – Exodus 2:2

- Promise of deliverance

Exod. 3:6 God of Abraham, God of Isaac and God of Jacob
7-8 saw the oppression – I will deliver them
9-10 saw the oppression – I will send you

- Moses confronted Pharaoh

Exod. 5:1-3 Moses confronted Pharaoh with words
Exod. 7:8-13 Moses confronted Pharaoh with a miracle
Exod. 7:14–12:30 Moses confronted Pharaoh with plagues

- Quoted – “Let My people go” – Exodus 5:1
- Quoted – “Shall know that I Am the Lord your God” – Exodus 6:7

- God foretold Moses what was going to occur

Exod. 4:21 I will harden his heart, that he shall not let you go
22 Israel is My son
23 If you refuse to let him go, I will kill your firstborn

- Protection from 10th plague

Deliverance involved a lamb without blemish

Exodus 12:5 – Exodus 12:21

Deliverance involved being covered by the blood of the lamb

Exodus 12:7 – Exodus 12:13 – Exodus 12:22-23
