- Let's get the context

1 Cor. 1:10-13 he mentioned a problem – (he wanted them to have group-think on one issue) – not to be divided by people (religious people)

1 Cor. 4:14 I do not write this things to shame you, but to warn you

1 Cor. 5:1-2 Paul was disappointed with a sinner – and the congregation

9 I wrote to you in my epistle not to keep company with sexually immoral people – (of the congregation)

2 Cor. 2:4 for out of much affliction and anguish of heart, I wrote to you (with many tears) – NOT that you might be grieved – that you might know that I love you

5-11 comfort the man

2 Cor. 7:2 open your hearts to us – we have not wronged, not corrupted, not cheated

3 I don't say these things to condemn – we die together and live together

8 even if I made you sorry with my letter, I do not regret it – although I did regret it – for I perceive that the same epistle made you sorry for a while

9 I rejoice (not that you were made sorry, but) that your sorrow led to repentance – for you were made sorry after a godly manner – and you were not harmed by us

10 godly sorrow produces repentance (leading to salvation) not to be regretted

– the sorrow of the world produces death

- Reminder about David

2 Sam. 11:2-4 David – committed adultery with Bathsheba

14-17 David – murdered Uriah

Psalms 51:1-19 psalm of repentance

1 blot out transgression

2 wash me – cleanse me

3-4 acknowledged his sins

10 a clean heart – steadfast spirit

11 cast me not from Your presence – do not take Your Holy Spirit from me

16-17 broken spirit and a contrite heart

- Two examples – Judas & Peter – demonstrate the difference

- Judas

Matt. 26:14-16 Judas traded the life of the Son of God – 30 pieces of silver

47 Judas led a great multitude  
48-49 the sign was a kiss  
50 they laid hands on the Son of God

- Peter

Matt. 14:30 when Peter saw the boisterous winds, he was afraid

Matt. 16:21 the Son of God foretold

- Suffer at the hands of elders, chief priests and scribes
- Be killed
- Be raised the 3<sup>rd</sup> day

22 Peter rebuked the Son of God

23 “Get behind Me, Satan! You are an offense to Me, for you are not mindful of the things of God, but the things of men”

Matt. 26:33 Peter – even if all are made to stumble because of You, I will never be made to stumble

34 Son of God – you will deny Me 3 times

35 Peter – even if I have to die with You, I will not deny You

John 13:8-9 “You shall never wash my feet” – “wash all of me”

Luke 22:60 the rooster crowed

61 the Lord turned and looked at Peter – Peter remembered

62 Peter wept bitterly

John 21:3 “I am going fishing”

7 when Peter heard it was the Lord, he plunged into the sea

- What happened to Judas?

Matt. 27:3-4 remorseful – returned the 30 pieces of silver

5 hanged himself
