John 13:1-17 washing feet
12-17 example

- John 13:18-20

John 13:18 that the scripture might be fulfilled – Psalm 41:9
19 “I tell you before it comes”
20 “he who receives whomever I send, receives Me” – “and he who receives
Me, receives Him who sent Me”

“apostolos” (Strong’s #652) – noun

“apostle, representative, messenger, envoy” – (“often used in a technical sense for the divinely appointed founders of the church”)

Luke 6:13 He called His disciples – chose 12 whom He also named apostles
Luke 11:49 will send them prophets and apostles – will kill & persecute some of them
Luke 22:14 He sat down with the 12 apostles
24 dispute among them – who should be considered the greatest?
Luke 24:10 it was women who told events of the tomb to the apostles
Acts 1:23-26 the lot fell on Matthias – he was numbered with the 11 apostles
Rom. 1:1 Paul claimed to be an apostle (in 9 letters) – also found
 1 Corinthians 1 Ephesians 1 2 Timothy 1
 2 Corinthians 1 Colossians 1 Titus 1
 Galatians 1 1 Timothy 1
1 Peter 1:1 Peter claimed to be an apostle – also found in 2 Peter 1
Acts 14:14 author of Acts (Luke) – the apostles, Barnabas and Paul – Acts 13:1-3
Acts 15:7-11 Peter spoke
12 Barnabas and Paul spoke
13-21 James summarized
1 Cor. 12:28 appointed some – first apostles
1 Cor. 15:7 seen by James, then by all the apostles
9 Paul called himself – “the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be
 called an apostle, because I persecuted the church”
2 Cor. 11:13 false apostles – transforming themselves into apostles of Christ
Rev. 2:2 have tried them who say they are apostles

Rom. 10:14-15	to call on Him How can you call on Him, if you have not believed? How can they believe in Him, if they have not heard? How can they hear, without a preacher? How shall they preach, unless they are sent?
15	gospel of peace – glad tidings of good things
	· The chief apostle
Heb. 3:1	Apostle and High Priest
	· John 13:21-30
John 13:21	“one of you will betray Me”
26	He gave the piece of bread to Judas Iscariot
27	“what you do, do quickly”
	· John 13:31-38
John 13:31	the Son of God is glorified – God is glorified in Him
32	God will also glorify Him immediately
33	“where I am going, you cannot come [yet]”
34	a new commandment – that you love one another, as I have loved you
35	by this – all will know that you are My disciples – “if you have love for one another”
Lev. 19:18	you shall love your neighbor as yourself – no vengeance – no grudge
Rom. 12:17	you are NOT repaying evil for evil – you live a life of good things
18	you are a peacemaker
19	you do NOT take vengeance – you give your wrath to God
20	you may keep your distance – but you are a giving person
21	you are NOT surrendering to evil – you are overcoming evil with good
John 13:36	Peter – where are you going? Son of God – you can’t follow Me now
37	Peter – why can’t I follow you now? – I will lay down my life for Your sake
38	Son of God – you will deny Me 3 times
