The world's primary religions fall into two categories:

Abrahamic religions – Christianity, Judaism and Islam Indian religions – Hinduism, Buddhism, Sikhism and others

The largest religions:

largest groups – Roman Catholic Church, Eastern Orthodox
churches and the Protestant churches
2 main branches – Sunni are 80% – Shi'ah are 15%
primarily in India (80% of population), Nepal & Indonesia
250 million in China alone – 2 main branches
formally established in Japan
founded in India
3 primary branches – Orthodox, Conservative & Reform
also known as "Taoism" - originated in China
associated with traditional Korean culture
originated in Vietnam in 1926

Some interesting scriptures to study – before choosing my Scripture

Jer. 7:16	do not pray for this people, nor lift up a cry or prayer for them, nor make intercession to Me – for I will not hear you
17	do you not see what they do in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem?
20	therefore thus says the Lord God: "behold, My anger and My fury will be poured out on this place (on man and on beast, on the trees of the field and on the fruit of the ground; and it will burn and not be quenched"
Jer. 11:14	so, do not pray for this people, or lift up a cry or prayer for them; for I will not hear them in the time that they cry out to Me because of their

trouble

Jer. 14:11 then the Lord said to me: "do not pray for this people, for their good prophets gave words that were too positive at the moment – the Son of God said – He didn't pray for the world
