  - Title tonight – John 16
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· John 16:1-4 – Warning in advance

John 16:1	told you – to help you not to stumble
2	they will put you out of the synagogue – whoever kills you thinks they are serving God
Matt. 16:21	must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things
	· suffer many things – elders, chief priests and scribes
	· be killed and be raised the 3 <sup>rd</sup> day
Mark 9:31	the Son of God is being betrayed into the hands of men
	· they will kill Him
	· after He is killed, He will rise on the 3 <sup>rd</sup> day
Mark 10:33	we are going to Jerusalem
	· will be betrayed to chief priests and scribes
	· condemned to death – delivered to the Gentiles
34	· to mock, scourge, spit on and kill
	· on 3 <sup>rd</sup> day, He will rise again
Luke 9:21-22	He strictly warned them, and told them not to tell anyone
	· suffer many things
	· be rejected by the elders, chief priests and scribes
	· be killed, and be raised on 3 <sup>rd</sup> day
John 16:3	they do these things to you – because they do not know the Father or Son
4	advance notice – remember that you were told

· John 16:5-15 – The Son of God promised the power of the Holy Spirit

John 16:5	now, I go to Him that sent Me – none of you ask, “where are you going?”
6	because I have told you – sorrow has filled your heart
7-8	personification of the “comforter” or “helper” – I will send “him” – when “he” has come, “he” will convict the world.....
(13-15)	FYI – more scriptures about personification – involving “Spirit of truth”
8-11	but first – let’s mention verses 8-12
	God will convict the world of sin, righteousness & judgment
	· of sin – because they do not believe in the Son
	· of righteousness – because the Son goes to the Father
	· of judgment – because the ruler of this world is judged
12	I still have many things to say – but you can not bear them now

- 13-15 personification of the “Spirit of truth”  
 13 “Spirit of truth” – when “he” comes – “he” will guide you into all truth –  
     “he” will not speak by “his” own authority, but what “he” hears –  
     “he” will tell you things to come  
 14 “he” will glorify Me – “he” will take of what is Mine and declare it to you  
 15 “he” will take of mine and declare it to you  
 John 14:16 “comforter” or “helper” – that will abide with you forever  
 26 “comforter” or “helper” – “he” will teach you  
 John 15:26 “comforter” or “helper” – “whom” – “he” will testify of Me  
 Rev. 2 & 3 personification – written like the Spirit is talking  
     he who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit “says”  
     Revelation 2:7.....2:11.....2:17.....2:29.....3:6.....3:13.....3:22
- “parakletos” – #3875 – John 14:16; John 14:26; John 15:26; John 16:7  
 “paraklesis” – #3874 – 2 Cor. 1:3
- 2 Cor. 1:3 the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ – Father of mercies, God of all comfort  
 Acts 2:33 the Father promised the Holy Spirit – He poured it out  
 36 God has made this Jesus (whom you crucified) both Lord and Christ  
 2 Cor. 1:21-22 God – has sealed us – has given us the Spirit in our hearts  
 Eph. 1:13-14 sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise  
 1 Thes. 4:8 people reject God – who has given us His Holy Spirit  
 2 Tim. 1:6-7 laying on of hands – spirit of power, of love and of a sound mind
- John 16:16-19 – The Son of God reminded – was going to Father
- John 16:16-19 a little while, you will not see Me – a little while, you will see Me
- John 16:20-22 – Sorrow comes before rejoicing
- John 16:20-22 analogy of childbirth
- John 16:23-24 – Whatever you ask?
- John 16:23-24 whatever you ask?  
 James 4:2-3 you do not have, because you do not ask – you ask and do not receive,  
     because you ask amiss (to spend it on your pleasures)
- John 16:25-33 – Figurative language and plain language
- John 16:25-28 I will tell you plainly about the Father  
 29-30 we believe that you came from God  
 31-32 you will be scattered and leave Me alone – but the Father will be with Me  
 33 I have said these things that you will have peace – in the world, you will  
     have tribulation – but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world
