2	they will put you out of the synagogue – whoever kills you thinks they are serving God
Matt. 16:21	must go to Jerusalem and suffer many things
	suffer many things – elders, chief priests and scribes
	be killed and be raised the 3 <sup>rd</sup> day
Mark 9:31	the Son of God is being betrayed into the hands of men
	<ul> <li>they will kill Him</li> <li>after He is killed, He will rise on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day</li> </ul>
Mark 10:33	we are going to Jerusalem

personification of the "Spirit of truth"
"Spirit of truth" – when "he" comes – "he" will guide you into all truth –
"he" will not speak by "his" own authority, but what "he" hears –
"he" will tell you things to come
"he" will glorify Me – "he" will take of what is Mine and declare it to you
"he" will take of mine and declare it to you
"comforter" or "helper" – that will abide with you forever
"comforter" or "helper" – "he" will teach you
"comforter" or "helper" – "whom" – "he" will testify of Me
personification – written like the Spirit is talking
he who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit "says"
Revelation 2:72:112:172:293:63:133:22
"parakletos" – #3875 – John 14:16; John 14:26; John 15:26; John 16:7
"paraklesis" – #3874 – 2 Cor. 1:3
the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ – Father of mercies, God of all comfort
the Father promised the Holy Spirit – He poured it out
God has made this Jesus (whom you crucified) both Lord and Christ
has sealed us – has given us the Spirit in our hearts
sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise
people reject God – who has given us His Holy Spirit
laying on of hands – spirit of power, of love and of a sound mind
aying on or names—spirit of power, or love and or a sound inine
John 16:16-19 – The Son of God reminded – was going to Father
Joint 10.10-17 – The Soil of God Tenninded – was going to Father
