- Tonight – Opportunity to give a Bible study – (Last week – John 16)
  - Title tonight – John 17
    - Privilege to “eavesdrop” on a prayer – from the Son of God – to the Father
    - Question – Is eavesdrop the right word? – Eavesdrop implies “secretly” listening
    - Now – prayer of John 17 – is in the Bible – for all to read

· John 17:1-3 – The Father and the Son

John 17:1	“glorify Your Son, that Your Son also may glorify You”
2	“as You have given Him authority over all flesh, that He should give eternal life to as many as You have given Him
3	“this is eternal life, that they may know You (the only true God) and Jesus Christ Whom You have sent”
Matthew 1:18	birth of Jesus Christ – child of the Holy Spirit – (power of the Holy Spirit)
Mark 1:1	the beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God
Luke 1:35	Holy Spirit come upon you – power of the Highest – called the Son of God
John 1:1	beginning – the Word was with God and the Word was God
Acts 2:36	God made this Jesus (whom you crucified) both Lord and Christ
Romans 1:7	peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
1 Corinthians 1:3	peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
2 Corinthians 1:2	peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
Galatians 1:3	peace from God our Father and “our” Lord Jesus Christ
Ephesians 1:2	peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
Philippians 1:2	peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
Colossians 1:2	peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
1 Thes. 1:1	peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
2 Thes. 1:2	peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
1 Timothy 1:2	peace from God our Father and Jesus Christ our Lord
2 Timothy 1:2	peace from God our Father and Christ Jesus our Lord
Titus 1:4	peace from God “the” Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior
Philemon 1:3	peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
Hebrews 1:1-2	God has spoken to us by His Son
James 1:1	bond-servant of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ
1 Peter 1:3	blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ
2 Peter 1:2	knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord
1 John 1:3	fellowship with the Father and with His Son Jesus Christ
2 John 1:3	peace from God the Father & from the Lord Jesus Christ – Son of Father
3 John	(no reference to Father and Son)
Jude 1:1	sanctified by God the Father – preserved in Jesus Christ
Revelation 1:1	revelation of Jesus Christ, which God gave Him to show

· John 17:4-5 – Before the world was

John 17:4 “I have glorified You on the earth” – “I have finished the work which You have given Me to do”  
5 “and now, Oh Father, glorify Me together with Yourself, with the glory which I had with You before the world was”  
(Ephesians 1:4 – 1 Peter 1:20 – Revelation 13:8 – Revelation 17:8)

· John 17:6-8 – The Son wanted them to know – that the Father sent the Son

John 17:6 “I have manifested Your name to the men whom You have given Me out of the world” – “they were Yours, You gave them to Me” – “and they have kept Your word”  
7 “have known that all things (which You have given to Me) are from You”  
8 “I have given to them the words which You have given Me” – “they have surely known that I came forth from You, and they have believed that You sent Me”

· John 17:9-26 – The Son prayed for the disciples

John 17:9 “I pray for them” – “those whom You have given Me” – “they are Yours”  
10 “all Mine are Yours” – “Yours are Mine” – “I am glorified in them”  
11 “I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world” – “I come to You Holy Father, keep through Your name those whom You have given Me, that they may be one as We are [One]”  
John 5:16-18 claiming God was His Father  
1 Cor. 15:24-28 the Son is subject to the Father – that God may be all in all  
John 17:12 “kept them in Your name” – none lost except son of perdition  
13 speak – that they might have joy  
14 Your word – world has hated them – not of world, as I am not of the world  
15 should keep them from the evil one  
16 they are not of the world  
17 “sanctify them by Your truth” – “Your word is truth”  
18-19 sent into the world – sanctified by truth  
20 pray also – for those to come  
21 they all may be one (as Father & Son) – “one in Us” – “that the world might believe that You sent Me”  
22-23 glory that Father gave the Son – given to them – that they might be one – I in Them and You in me – perfect in one – that the world may know that God sent the Son  
24 desire that they might be with Me – behold My glory  
25 the world doesn’t know God – the Son knew God – the disciples knew that the Father sent the Son  
26 have declared Your name to them – that the love which the Father had toward the Son may be in them
