Deut. 8:10-14	when you are full – beware lest you forget God	
Rev. 18:11-16	the merchants of the earth – shall weep and mourn	
17-19	in one hour – she became desolate	
Mark 10:17-22	young man kept the commandments – could not part with his possessions	
23	it is hard for those who "have" riches to enter the kingdom of heaven	
24	it is hard for those who "trust in riches" to enter the kingdom of heaven	
Luke 12:15	beware of covetousness – a person's life does not consist in the abundance
