Trouble – Patience – Experience – Hope

Acts 14:22	we must through many tribulations (#2347) enter the kingdom of God
2 Cor. 1:4	God comforts us in all our tribulation (#2347)
8	we don't want you ignorant of our trouble (#2347)
9-10	trusted in God – has delivered – does deliver – will deliver
2 Cor. 4:17	our light affliction (#2347) – which is for a moment – works a far more

	exceeding and eternal weight of glory
18	we should NOT focus on the physical things which are seen – rather, we
	should focus on the spiritual things which are not seen
1 Thes. 3:1-2	when we could no longer forbear, we sent Timothy
3	that no person should be moved by these afflictions (#2347)
4	we told you before that we should suffer tribulations (#2347)
2 Thes. 1:4	we glory in you in the churches of God – for your patience and faith – in all your persecutions and tribulations (#2347) that you endure
	• Do you remember "experience" was "dokime" (#1382)?
	• A variation = "dioko" ($\#1377$) – verb
	to pursue, persecute, oppress, harass
	3 times – "suffer persecution"
	• Notice one particular time
2 Tim. 3:12	all who desire to live godly in Christ Jesus – will suffer persecution
	· Combination of faith and hope
Acts 24:14	I worship the God of my fathers – believing things which are written in the Law and in the Prophets
15	I have hope in God – that there will be a resurrection of the dead – both of the just and the unjust
