- Understand the battlefield
 - The devil creates the problem – then, masquerades as the solution
 - Chaos – leading to authoritarianism.....Chaos – leading to tyranny
- 2 Cor. 4:4 the god of this age – has blinded the sight of people
- 2 Cor. 11:13-15 masquerades – as an angel of light
- Ultimate solution – Father and Son
- 1 Cor. 2:11 spirit in man – Spirit of God
- 1 Cor. 1:3 grace to you – and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ
- 1 Cor. 1:10 this verse is often used to promote universal group think – notice the specific example of unified thinking
- 11-13 not putting emphasis upon religious leaders
- 1 Cor. 3:1 I could not speak to you as mature believers – but rather as carnal and babes in Christ
- 2 milk – no solid food – not able to receive it
- 3 still carnal – envy, strife, divisions – carnal, behaving like mere people
- 4 rallying around Paul, Apollos and others
- 5-8 the men aren’t anything special
- 9 you are God’s fellow workers – God’s field – God’s building
- 10 Paul laid their foundation – others built on that foundation
- 11 the foundation is the Son of God
- 12 build with gold, silver & precious wood – build with wood, hay & straw
- 13 each one’s work will become clear – the Day will declare it, because it will
 - be revealed by fire – (the fire will test each one’s work)
- 14 if anyone’s work (which he has built) endures, he will receive a reward
- 15 if anyone’s work is burned, he will suffer loss – (but he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire)
- 16-17 you are the temple of God
- 18-20 don’t deceive yourself
- 21-22 let no one boast in men – (whether it was Paul, Apollos, Peter, or anything in this world)
- 23 you are Christ’s – and Christ is God’s
- 1 Cor. 15:24-28 the Son will deliver the kingdom to God the Father – when the Son puts an end to all rule, all authority and all power

28 Son Himself will also be subject to the Father – that God may be all in all
