Rev. 18:1 an angel coming down from heaven -- having great authority and the earth was illuminated with his glory angel -- cried mightily with a loud voice 2-3 "Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen" * A dwelling place of demons * A prison for every foul spirit * A cage for every unclean & hated bird * All nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication * Kings of the earth have committed fornication with her * And the merchants of the earth have become rich through the abundance of her luxury
