\*The Passover began as a "domestic" event -- in the home

Exod. 12:1-20      the Lord spoke -- Moses and Aaron  
3      a lamb for a household  
4      household -- and neighbor next to his house  
7      2 doorposts of the houses where you eat  
13      blood on houses -- don't go out of your house  
20-27      Moses spoke -- elders  
22      two doorposts  
28-42      the events occurred  
34,39      making bread

\*The Passover became a "sanctuary" event -- at the tabernacle

Exod. 12:43-49      ordinance of the Passover  
48      "let him come near"  
Exod. 25:21      mercy seat on top of the ark  
22      "I will meet with you there"  
Exod. 29:42      "where I will meet with you to speak with you"  
43      "there I will meet with the children of Israel"  
44      Aaron and sons as priests  
45      I will dwell among the children of Israel"  
Num. 9:2      keep the Passover at its appointed time  
3      14th day of this month -- at twilight  
4      Moses told the children of Israel that they  
should keep the Passover  
5      14th day of first month -- at twilight  
7      defiled -- kept from presenting the offering  
--(dealing with the sanctuary)  
Deut. 16:1      keep the Passover  
2      "in the place where God chooses"  
5      "not within your gates"  
6      "at the place where God chooses to make His name abide"  
7      "in the place where God chooses"

\*The Passover continued as a "sanctuary" event -- at the temple

2 Chron. 30:26      Hezekiah -- there had been nothing like this in  
Jerusalem, since the time of Solomon  
2 Chron. 35:18      Josiah -- there was no passover kept in Israel  
like this, since the days of Samuel

2 Kings 23:21 as it was written in the book of the covenant  
           24 words of the law -- written in the book  
           25 according to all the law of Moses  
 2 Chron. 30:24 Hezekiah gave animals to the congregation  
                   \* 1,000 bullocks  
                   \* 7,000 sheep  
           others gave animals to the congregation  
                   \* 1,000 bullocks  
                   \* 10,000 sheep  
 2 Chron. 35:7 Josiah gave animals for the passover offering  
                   \* 30,000 sheep and goats  
                   \* 3,000 bullocks  
           8 leaders gave animals for the passover offering  
                   \* 2,600 sheep  
                   \* 300 bullocks  
           9 others gave animals for the passover offering  
                   \* 5,000 sheep  
                   \* 500 cattle

\* Christ is our Passover

1 Cor. 3:16-17 we are the temple  
 1 Cor. 5:7 Christ our Passover was sacrificed for us

\* Timing and Symbols

1 Cor. 11:23 on the same night in which He was betrayed  
 24-25 broken bread and wine

I love the timing -- night He was betrayed  
 I love the symbols -- footwashing, bread and wine  
 This is my 51st year to keep the Commemoration  
     of the Suffering and Death of Our Lord --  
     picturing the night He was betrayed -- and  
     with the New Testament symbols
